


## Summary of timetable changes

Saturday - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will finish its journey at Ealing Broadway. Sunday - The 0034 London Paddington to Reading will start from Ealing Broadway. Passengers should use TfL Central line services to complete their journey to / from central London, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. Sunday - The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will run later throughout.

Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service - Trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings.

Sunday - All day, High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be revised. Most trains from London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual and most trains TO London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later than usual. The 1700 Cheltenham Spa to London Paddington will finish its journey at Swindon. Passengers travel forward on the next available service. Most local stopping trains between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will only run between Reading and Didcot Parkway. Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford will be served by additional calls in fast trains running between London Paddington and Swindon (occasionally beyond).

**Sunday** - All day, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) will be revised. Most trains from London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual. Some trains will not run at all, and some trains that would normally run beyond Bristol Temple Meads to / from Weston-super-Mare and Taunton (or beyond) will only run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers should use alternative scheduled rail services between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton. Some trains from London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will call additionally at Didcot Parkway, in place of trains that will no longer run.

In addition, **until approximately 1100**, trains will be diverted between Swindon and Bristol Temple Meads, not calling at Chippenham or Bath Spa. Replacement buses will run between Swindon, Chippenham and Bath Spa.

Monday to Thursday - Trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) will either be diverted to run non-stop between Swindon and Bristol Temple Meads, not calling at Chippenham or Bath Spa, or will only run between London Paddington and Bath Spa. Replacement buses will run between Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads. A few late evening services will also be replaced by buses between Swindon, Chippenham and Bath Spa. Trains between Cardiff Central / Bristol Temple Meads and Westbury / Frome / Weymouth / Warminster / Salisbury / Southampton Central / Portsmouth Harbour will all be revised, with some trains not running at all and others only running for part of their journey. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Temple Meads and Bath Spa. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.

**Saturday** - The 0846 Cheltenham Spa to Bristol Temple Meads (via Swindon) will not run. Passengers should use alternative scheduled services, changing en-route where necessary to complete their journey.

Monday to Thursday - Local stopping services between Bristol Temple Meads and Filton Abbey Wood will not run. Some trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Filton Abbey Wood / Cardiff Central will call additionally at Lawrence Hill, Stapleton Road and Ashley Down, and will be retimed. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.

**Sunday** - The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Replacement buses will run from Swansea and intermediate stations to Cardiff Central, departing EARLIER than usual.

Monday to Thursday - The 2048, 2148 & 2246 London Paddington to Swansea will be subject to minor retimings at stations west of Cardiff Central.

**Sunday** - All day, most trains from London Paddington to the West of England will depart from London Paddington slightly EARLIER than usual. The 1032 Paignton to London Paddington will not run and the 0918 Penzance to London Paddington will call additionally at Castle Cary. The 1436 London Paddington to Exeter St Davids will not run and the 1503 (departing 1501) London Paddington to Plymouth will call additionally at Pewsey, Westbury and Castle Cary, then will run later from Taunton to Plymouth. The 0759 (departing 0753) London Paddington to Exeter St Davids and 1630 London Paddington to Plymouth will both finish their journeys at Bristol Temple Meads. The 1800 London Paddington to Plymouth (via Bristol Temple Meads) will not run. The 1322 & 1732 Exeter St Davids to London Paddington and 1502 Plymouth to London Paddington will all start from Bristol Temple Meads.

- Monday to Thursday The 0838 London Paddington to Westbury will not run. Passengers should travel on alternative earlier or later services. The 0934 London Paddington to Paignton will call additionally at Pewsey. The 2230 London Paddington to Bedwyn will start from Reading. An alternative rail (8) connection will be available from London Paddington (departing at 2230) to Reading. Monday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will be slightly retimed and will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington. (9) Friday - The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Frome. Monday to Thursday - The 2305 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will finish its journey at Taunton and the 2348 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will be replaced by a bus. The 2345 London Paddington to Penzance and the 2145 Penzance to London Paddington will not call at Taunton. Passengers travelling to / from Taunton should travel on an EARLIER service. Monday to Thursday - All day, direct trains between London Paddington and Weston-super-Mare / Taunton will either not run at all, or will only run between Bristol Temple Meads and Weston-super-Mare / Taunton. Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between London Paddington and the North Cotswolds will be replaced by buses between Worcestershire Parkway and Great Malvern. A few other trains will not run at all or will only run for part of their journey. On Saturday, the 2242 Great Malvern to Evesham will be **(17) 18** replaced by a bus. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling. Monday - The 0643 Worcester Shrub Hill to London Paddington will start from Oxford. Passengers travelling to / from stations west of Oxford should travel on an alternative earlier or later service. Friday - The 2251 London Paddington to Worcestershire Parkway will finish its journey at Oxford. A replacement bus will run from Oxford to Worcestershire Parkway. Sunday - The 0806 Warminster to Swindon will be replaced by a bus from Warminster to Chippenham, departing EARLIER than usual. The 0908 Swindon to (24) (36) Westbury will be replaced by a bus from Chippenham to Westbury. Alternative rail connections will be available between Chippenham and Swindon. Monday to Thursday - Some trains between Westbury and Swindon will either not run, or will be retimed. Saturday, Sunday and Monday - All day on these three days, trains between Reading and Redhill / Gatwick Airport will be replaced by buses between Reading and Wokingham. A revised, hourly service will run between Wokingham and Redhill / Gatwick Airport. On Sunday, the 2305 Gatwick Airport to Reading will finish its journey at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Reading. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling. Tuesday - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport will depart EARLIER and call at all stations from Wokingham to Gatwick Airport. The 0500 Reading to Redhill will Wednesday to Friday - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport will start from Guildford. A replacement bus will run EARLIER, non-stop from Reading to Guildford. Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street will be replaced by buses between Gloucester and Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street. 37 A few other trains will not run at all. Other trains between Gloucester and Cheltenham Spa will continue to run. Passengers are strongly advised to check their
