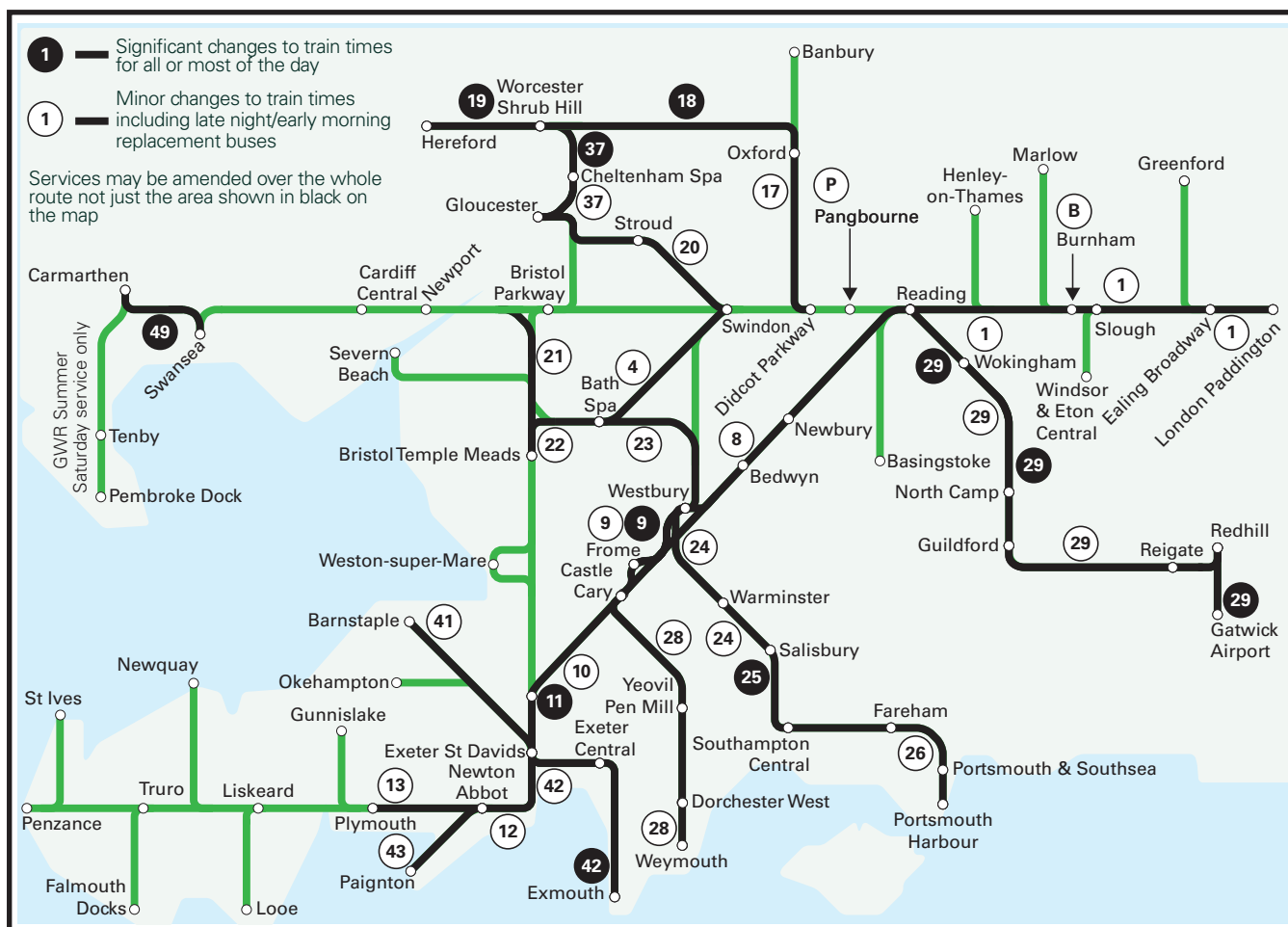

①	Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service - Trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings.
① ⑧ ⑨ ⑩ ⑪ ⑫ ⑬ ④⑩ ④③	Tuesday to Thursday - Trains between London Paddington / Reading and the West of England will be revised and there will be fewer direct trains between London Paddington / Reading and Exeter St Davids / Plymouth / Penzance than usual . Some trains will be diverted via an alternative route between Castle Cary and Exeter St Davids and journey times will be extended. Some trains will only run between London Paddington and Taunton or between Exeter St Davids / Plymouth and Penzance. Direct trains between London Paddington / Reading and Paignton will not run. There will only be a VERY limited direct service between London Paddington and Penzance - in most cases, passengers will need to change trains at Plymouth. Trains between Cardiff Central / Bristol Temple Meads and Exeter St Davids will not run between Taunton and Exeter St Davids. A few trains between Exeter St Davids, Newton Abbot and Paignton will be retimed. Replacement buses will run between Taunton, Tiverton Parkway and Exeter St Davids. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
④ ②⑩ ②② ③⑦	Saturday - The 0846 Cheltenham Spa to Bristol Temple Meads (via Swindon) will not run. Passengers should use alternative scheduled services, changing en-route where necessary to complete their journey.
④ ②②	Monday to Thursday - The 2228 (Monday to Wednesday) & the 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Swindon to run non-stop to Bristol Temple Meads. Replacement buses will serve Chippenham and Bath Spa.
⑧	Saturday until approximately 0700 - Trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn will be revised. Some trains will be replaced by buses for all or part of their journey, departing EARLIER than usual. Sunday - The 2333 Newbury to Reading will be replaced by a bus.
⑨	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains will not call at Frome. Replacement buses will run between Frome and Westbury.
⑨ ②② ②③	Monday to Thursday - The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will not run. Replacement buses will run from Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury and Frome. The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Temple Meads will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Bristol Temple Meads.
⑨ ②⑧	Tuesday to Thursday - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, some trains to / from Weymouth will be retimed. In a few cases, passengers may need to change trains to complete their journey.
⑪	Monday to Wednesday - The 2345 London Paddington to Penzance and the 2145 Penzance to London Paddington will not call at Taunton. Passengers travelling to / from Taunton should use alternative EARLIER rail or replacement bus services. Also see item above.
⑪ ①⑦ ①⑧ ①⑨	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between London Paddington and the North Cotswolds will be replaced by buses between Worcestershire Parkway and Great Malvern. A few other trains will not run at all or will only run for part of their journey. On Saturday , the 2242 Great Malvern to Evesham will be replaced by a bus. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling. Monday - The 0643 Worcester Shrub Hill to London Paddington will start from Oxford. Passengers travelling to / from stations west of Oxford should travel on an alternative earlier or later service.
②⑩ ③⑦	Monday to Thursday - The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will be diverted to run non-stop from Swindon to Gloucester, where it will finish its journey. A replacement bus will run from Swindon to Cheltenham Spa, serving stations via Stroud.
②① ②② ②③ ②④ ②⑤ ②⑥	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Salisbury and Southampton Central. Romsey will only be served by SWR rail services (to /from Southampton Central) or replacement bus services (to / from Salisbury). In addition, some other trains between Cardiff Central / Bristol Temple Meads and Westbury / Salisbury will either not run or will only run for part of their journey, with other trains making additional stops. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
②①	Monday and Tuesday - 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will run slightly later from Patchway onwards.

	<p>Sunday - All day, trains will be reduced to an hourly frequency and will only run between Guildford and Redhill / Gatwick Airport. Replacement buses will run between Reading and Guildford. Passengers travelling between Reading and Wokingham should use alternative scheduled SWR rail services, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.</p> <p>Monday to Thursday - The 2333 Reading to Gatwick Airport will finish its journey at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Gatwick Airport. The 2322 Gatwick Airport to Reading will finish its journey at Redhill. A replacement bus will run from Redhill to Guildford, with a connecting rail service running from Guildford to Reading.</p> <p>Tuesday to Friday - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport will run later from Guildford and finish its journey at Redhill. The 0559 Gatwick Airport to Reading will start from Redhill. Alternative rail connections, operated by Southern, will be available between Redhill and Gatwick Airport, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.</p>
37	<p>Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street will be replaced by buses between Gloucester and Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street. A few other trains will not run at all. Other trains between Gloucester and Cheltenham Spa will continue to run. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.</p>
41	<p>Monday to Wednesday - The 2054 Exmouth (2129 Exeter St Davids) to Barnstaple will finish its journey at Crediton. A replacement bus will run from Crediton to Barnstaple and a taxi from Crediton to Yeoford. The 2241 Barnstaple to Exeter St Davids will not run. A replacement bus will run from Barnstaple to Exeter St Davids. Yeoford will be served by a separate taxi service to / from Crediton.</p>
42 42	<p>Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Exeter Central and Exmouth. Trains between Exeter St Davids and Exeter Central will run to a revised timetable. Some trains will run slightly EARLIER than usual.</p> <p>Tuesday to Thursday - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, some trains between Exeter St Davids and Exeter Central will either be slightly retimed, or will not run at all.</p>
49	<p>Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Swansea, Llanelli and Carmarthen.</p>
B	<p>Saturday - The 0045 London Paddington to Reading will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.</p>
P	<p>Friday - The 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.</p>
