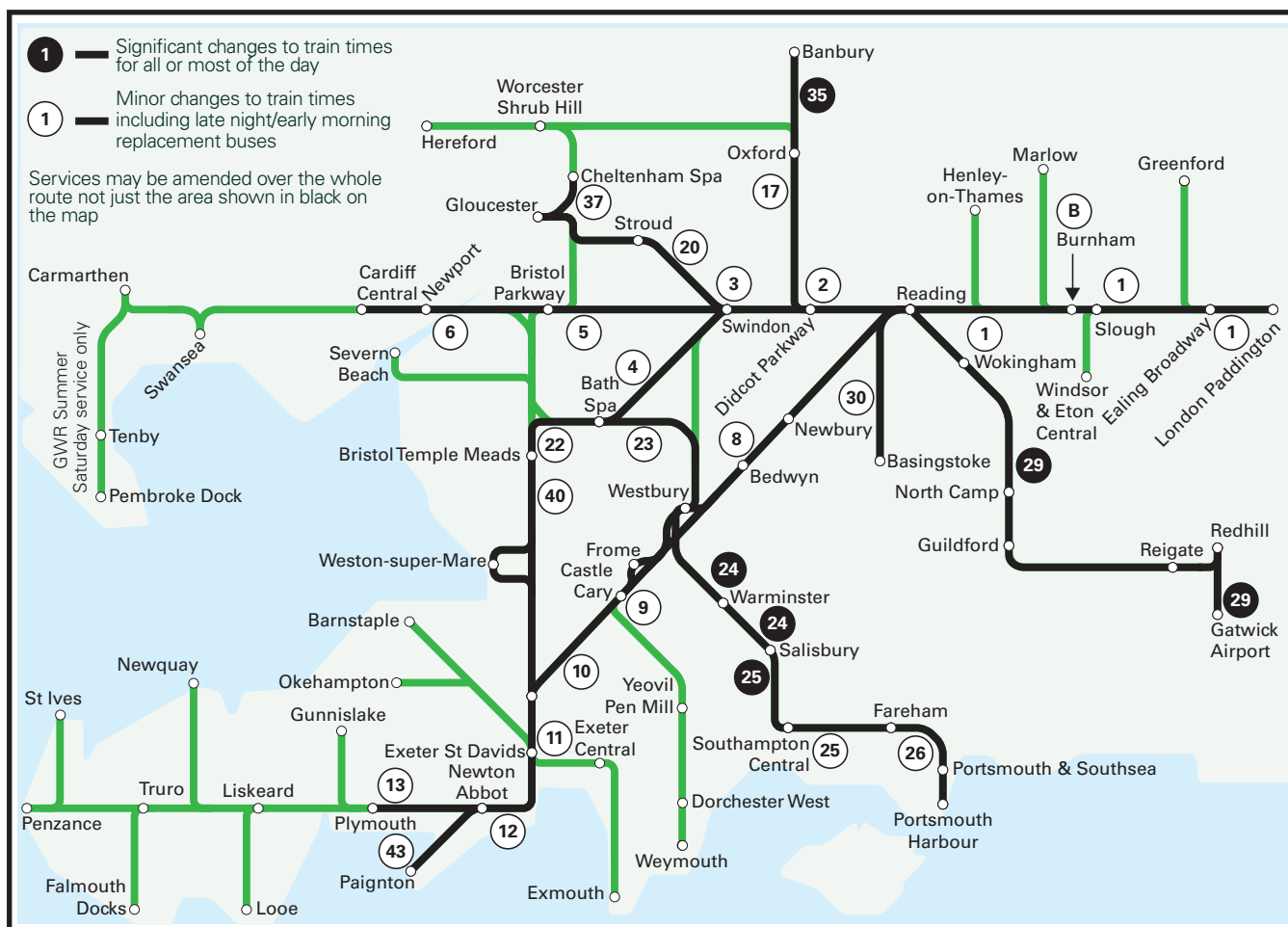

①	Saturday from approximately 2145 until end of service - Trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings. A few trains FROM London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual. The 2200 Oxford to London Paddington & the 2300 Oxford (starting 2352 from Didcot Parkway) to London Paddington will not call at Twyford or Maidenhead. 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will finish its journey at Slough. A replacement bus will run from Slough to London Paddington.
	Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service - Trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings.
① ②	Saturday from approximately 2230 until end of service - Trains between London Paddington / Didcot Parkway and Oxford will be replaced by buses between Oxford and Didcot Parkway.
①⑦	Sunday - The 0754 Oxford to Basingstoke will start from Didcot Parkway. Passengers from Oxford should travel on the next available service.
① ②	Sunday - All day, High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be revised. Some trains from London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual and most trains TO London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later than usual. Some trains between London Paddington and Swindon / Bristol Parkway / Cardiff Central will be retimed, or will not run. The 1700 Cheltenham Spa to London Paddington will finish its journey at Swindon. Passengers travel forward on the next available service. Local stopping trains between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will be retimed, in some cases, running EARLIER than usual.
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① ②	Sunday - All day, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) will be revised. Some trains will not run at all, and some trains that would normally run beyond Bristol Temple Meads to / from Weston-super-Mare and Taunton (or beyond) will only run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers should use alternative scheduled rail services between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton. Some trains from London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will call additionally at Didcot Parkway, in place of trains that will no longer run.
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⑤ ⑥	Monday to Thursday - The 2246 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Swindon and will run later from Bristol Parkway to Swansea.
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⑥	Saturday - The 1923 Portsmouth Harbour (starting 2102 from Warminster) to Cardiff Central will finish its journey at Newport. An alternative rail connection, operated by Transport for Wales, will be available from Newport to Cardiff Central, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.
⑧	Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service each evening - Buses will replace trains between Newbury and Bedwyn.
	Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will be slightly retimed and will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington.
⑧ ⑨	Sunday - All day, some trains from London Paddington to the West of England will depart from London Paddington slightly EARLIER than usual. The 1032 Paignton to London Paddington will not run and the 0918 Penzance to London Paddington will call additionally at Castle Cary. The 1436 London Paddington to Exeter St Davids will not run and the 1503 London Paddington to Plymouth will call additionally at Pewsey, Westbury and Castle Cary, then will run later from Taunton to Plymouth. The 0759 (departing 0747) London Paddington to Exeter St Davids and the 1630 (departing 1633) London Paddington to Plymouth will both finish their journeys at Bristol Temple Meads. The 1800 London Paddington to Plymouth (via Bristol Temple Meads) will not run. The 1322 & 1732 Exeter St Davids to London Paddington and the 1502 Plymouth to London Paddington will all start from Bristol Temple Meads.
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⑨	Tuesday to Thursday - The 0612 Frome to Paddington will start from Westbury. An EARLIER rail connection will be available from Frome to Westbury.
②① ③⑦	Monday to Thursday - The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will depart EARLIER and will be diverted to run non-stop to, and finish its journey at, Gloucester. A replacement bus will run from Swindon to Cheltenham Spa, calling at stations via Stroud.

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22 23	Saturday - All day, buses will replace trains between Warminster and Salisbury. A reduced service will run between Westbury and Warminster. A few trains will not run at all.
24 25	Sunday - All day, buses will replace trains between Warminster, Salisbury and Southampton Central. Romsey will only be served by SWR rail / replacement bus services. A reduced service will run between Bristol Temple Meads, Westbury and Warminster. A few trains will not run at all.
26	Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
29	Sunday - All day, trains will be reduced to an hourly frequency and will only run between Guildford and Redhill / Gatwick Airport. Replacement buses will run between Reading and Guildford. Passengers travelling between Reading and Wokingham should use alternative scheduled SWR rail services, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.
30	Sunday - The 0737 Reading to Basingstoke will not run. Passengers should travel on the next available service.
35	Saturday - All day, buses will replace trains between Oxford and Banbury. (Note, this will also affect Crosscountry services on both Saturday and Sunday).
	<i>The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:</i>
	Saturday - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading, 0019 Reading to London Paddington and 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington (which will finish its journey at Slough);
B	Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading; In both cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
	<i>The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: Sunday</i> - 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 (departing at 0625) & 0742 Reading to London Paddington, 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2350 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.
