


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday 15 to Friday 21 November 2025

- Saturday from approximately 2145 until end of service Trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings. A few trains FROM London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual. The 2200 Oxford to London Paddington will not call at Twyford or Maidenhead. The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will finish its journey at Slough. A replacement bus will run from Slough to London Paddington.

 Sunday The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will not run. Passengers should travel on the next available service. The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will depart at 0636 and will run later throughout.
- Saturday The 2333 London Paddington to Oxford will finish its journey at Didcot Parkway. Passengers travelling to Oxford should use local bus service NX2 from Didcot Parkway to Oxford city centre (Westgate), on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.
 - Sunday All day, buses will replace trains between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. A revised service will run between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway.
- Sunday All day, High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be revised. Most trains from London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual and most trains TO London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later than usual. The 1700 Cheltenham Spa to London Paddington will finish its journey at Swindon. Passengers should travel forward on the next available service.
- Sunday All day, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) will be revised. Some trains will not run at all, and some trains that would normally run beyond Bristol Temple Meads to / from Weston-super-Mare and Taunton (or beyond) will only run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers should use alternative scheduled rail services between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton. Some trains from London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will call additionally at Didcot Parkway, in place of trains that will no longer run.
- Monday to Thursday The 2048, 2148 & 2246 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run later from Bridgend to Swansea.
- Sunday All day, most trains from London Paddington to the West of England will depart from London Paddington slightly EARLIER than usual. The 1032 Paignton to London Paddington will not run and the 0918 Penzance to London Paddington will call additionally at Castle Cary. The 1436 London Paddington to Exeter St Davids will not run and the 1503 London Paddington to Plymouth will call additionally at Pewsey, Westbury and Castle Cary, then will run later from Taunton to Plymouth. The 0759 London Paddington to Exeter St Davids and the 1630 London Paddington to Plymouth will both finish their journeys at Bristol Temple Meads. The 1800 London Paddington to Plymouth (via Bristol Temple Meads) will not run. The 1322 & 1732 Exeter St Davids to London Paddington and the 1502 Plymouth to London Paddington will all start from Bristol Temple Meads.
- Sunday The 0804 (departing 0757) London Paddington to Penzance will not call at Newbury or Pewsey. The 0844 (departing 0831) London Paddington to Penzance will call additionally at Newbury and Pewsey. The 0806 Reading to Newbury will not run and the 0833 Reading to Bedwyn will start from Newbury and run slightly later throughout. A replacement bus will run EARLIER from Reading to Newbury, to connect into the train.
- **Tuesday to Friday** The 0612 Frome to Paddington will start from Westbury. An EARLIER rail connection will be available from Frome to Westbury. The 0618 Yeovil Pen Mill to Filton Abbey Wood will start from Castle Cary. Passengers from Yeovil Pen Mill should travel on the next available service.
- Sunday All day, trains between Plymouth (or beyond) and Penzance will be reduced in frequency, and will terminate at / start from St Austell. Replacement buses will run between St Austell and Truro. A rail shuttle service will run between Truro and Penzance. The Night Riviera Sleeper service will start from Plymouth. Passengers travelling from stations in Cornwall will need to travel earlier and use alternative rail / bus services to join the Sleeper at Plymouth. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
- Tuesday to Friday The 0355 Oxford to Reading will depart EARLIER from Oxford. Normal timings departing Didcot Parkway onwards.
- Sunday The 1739 Bristol Temple Meads to Worcester Foregate Street will finish its journey at Worcester Shrub Hill. Passengers travel forward on the next available service. The 1941 Worcester Foregate Street to Bristol Temple Meads will start back from Great Malvern, calling at Malvern Link.

Saturday - All day, buses will replace trains between Salisbury and Southampton Central. A few other trains will either not run at all or will only run for part of their journey.



Sunday - All day, buses will replace trains between Warminster, Salisbury and Southampton Central. Romsey will only be served by SWR rail / replacement bus services. A reduced service will run between Bristol Temple Meads, Westbury and Warminster. A few trains will not run at all and other trains will make additional stops instead.

Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.

Saturday - The 2335 Reading to Gatwick Airport will finish its journey at Redhill. An alternative rail connection, operated by Southern, will be available from Redhill to Gatwick Airport, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.



Sunday - All day, trains will run between Reading and Ash only. Replacement buses will run between North Camp, Guildford and Redhill / Gatwick Airport. Passengers should interchange between trains and buses at North Camp. Passengers travelling between Redhill and Gatwick Airport should use other operators' scheduled rail services, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.

- **Sunday** -The 0737 & 0837 Reading to Basingstoke and 0806 Basingstoke to Reading will not run. Replacement buses will run at 0737 from Reading to Basingstoke and at 0745 from Basingstoke to Reading. These buses will not call at Reading West, and passengers travelling to / from Reading West should use alternative services running between Reading and Newbury.
- **Sunday** The 0007 Marlow to Maidenhead will finish its journey at Bourne End. A replacement bus will run from Bourne End to Maidenhead.
- Tuesday to Friday The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.
- Monday to Friday The 2340 (Monday to Thursday) Exeter St Davids to Exmouth and the 0019 (Tuesday to Friday) Exmouth to Exeter St Davids will not run. Replacement buses will run instead, extending journey times.
- Saturday to Monday All day on all three days, trains between Par and Newquay will not run. Replacement buses will run between St. Austell and Newquay, except, for the first bus towards Newquay which, on Sunday and Monday, will start from Par (and not serve St. Austell). At all other times, passengers travelling from / to Par should change at St. Austell.
- **Sunday** The 1027 Swansea to Carmarthen will not run. The 1125 Carmarthen to London Paddington will start from Swansea. Replacement buses, running at different times, will run between Swansea, Llanelli and Carmarthen.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:

Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to Slough;

Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading;

(B) Tuesday to Friday - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington;

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: Sunday - 0620 (departing 0636) Reading to London Paddington and 2350 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

The following trains will not call at Pangbourne:

Sunday - 0738, 2233 & 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 0818 & 2350 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

Monday to Thursday - 2236 & 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2326 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

Tuesday to Friday - 0355 (departing 0346) Oxford to Reading (no replacement transport provided - passengers should travel on the next available service); **Friday** - 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway;

Unless otherwise shown, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
