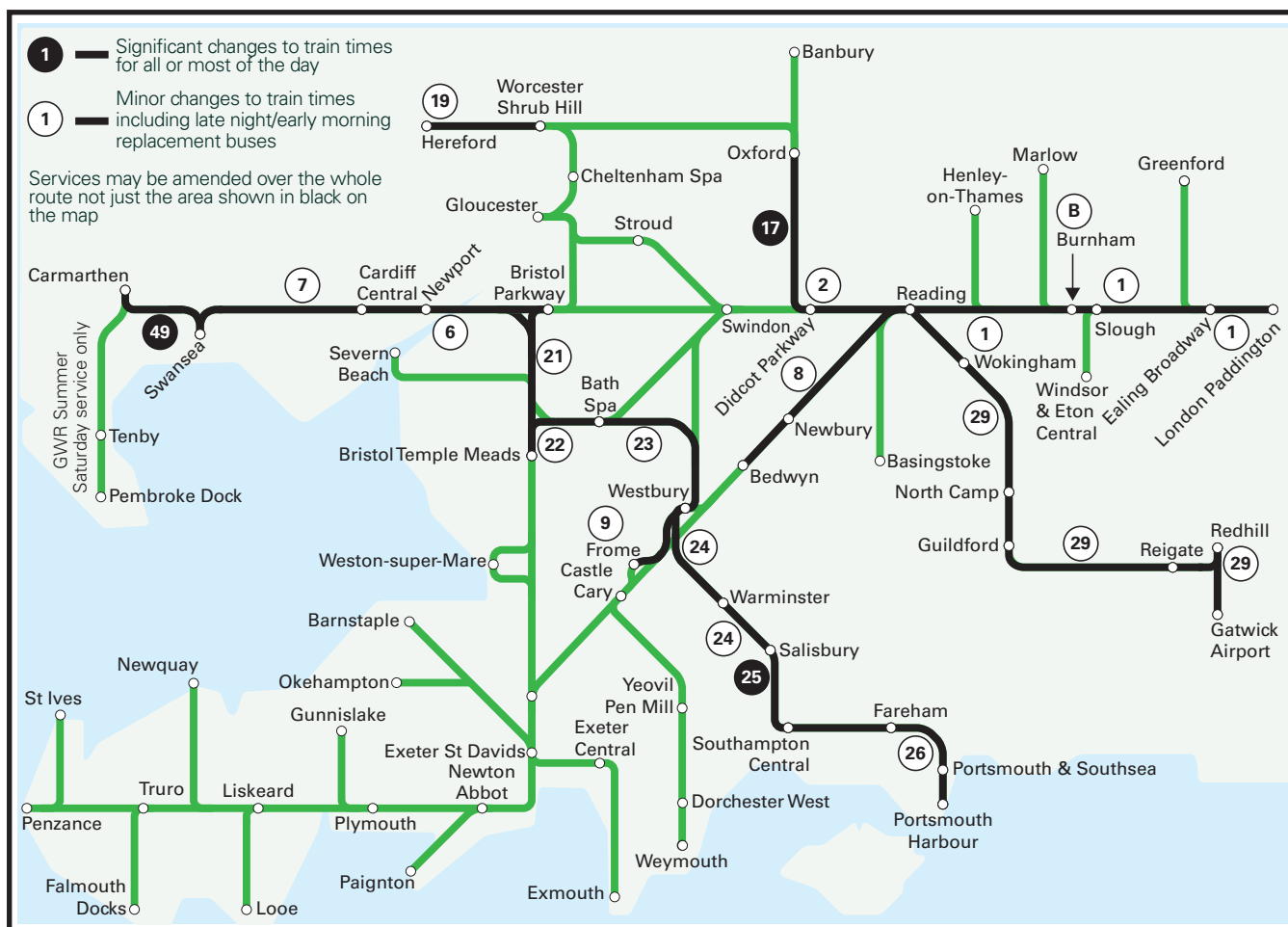


Summary of timetable changes

①	<p>Saturday - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will finish its journey at Ealing Broadway. Sunday - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start from Ealing Broadway. Passengers should use TfL Central line services to complete their journey to / from central London, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. Sunday - The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will run later throughout.</p> <p>Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service - Trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings.</p>
① ② ①⑦	<p>Saturday - The 2333 London Paddington to Oxford will finish its journey at Didcot Parkway. Passengers for Oxford should use local bus service NX2 from Didcot Parkway to Oxford city centre, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.</p> <p>Sunday - All day, buses will replace trains between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. A revised service will run between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway.</p>
⑥ ②①	<p>Monday and Tuesday - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will be slightly retimed after Newport.</p> <p>Monday to Thursday - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will not call at Stapleton Road and Lawrence Hill. A replacement bus will run from Filton Abbey Wood to Stapleton Road, Lawrence Hill and Bristol Temple Meads.</p>
⑦	<p>Sunday - The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Replacement buses will run from Swansea and intermediate stations to Cardiff Central, departing EARLIER than usual.</p> <p>Monday to Thursday - The 2148 & 2246 London Paddington to Swansea will finish their journeys at Neath. Replacement buses will run from Neath to Swansea.</p> <p>Tuesday to Friday - The 0338 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Neath. A replacement bus will run from Swansea to Neath.</p>
⑧	<p>Monday to Thursday from approximately 2130 until end of service - Buses will replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn. A few other trains will either not run, or will be retimed, in some cases, EARLIER than usual.</p> <p>Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will be slightly retimed and will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington.</p>
⑨	<p>Tuesday to Friday - The 0612 Frome to Paddington will start from Westbury. An EARLIER rail connection will be available from Frome to Westbury.</p>
①⑨	<p>Sunday - The 1739 Bristol Temple Meads to Worcester Foregate Street will finish its journey at Worcester Shrub Hill. Passengers travel forward on the next available service. The 1941 Worcester Foregate Street to Bristol Temple Meads will start back from Great Malvern, calling at Malvern Link.</p>
②② ②③ ②④ ②⑤ ②⑥	<p>Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Salisbury and Southampton Central. Romsey will only be served by SWR rail / replacement bus services. On Sunday, a reduced service will run between Bristol Temple Meads, Westbury and Salisbury. A few trains will not run at all and other trains will make additional stops instead. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.</p>
②⑨	<p>Monday to Thursday - The 2322 Gatwick Airport to Reading will finish its journey at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Reading.</p> <p>Tuesday to Friday - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport and the 0500 Reading to Redhill will both start from Guildford. Replacement buses will run EARLIER from Reading to Guildford to connect into the trains. The 0531 Reading to Gatwick Airport will depart slightly EARLIER and call additionally at Crowthorne, Sandhurst, Farnborough North and Ash.</p> <p>Friday - The 2022 Reading to Gatwick Airport and the 2201 Gatwick Airport to Reading will not run. Passengers should travel on an alternative earlier or later service. The 2054 Reading to Gatwick Airport will call additionally at Shalford and Gomshall.</p>
④⑨	<p>Sunday - All day, buses will replace trains between Swansea, Llanelli and Carmarthen.</p>
⑧	<p>Saturday - The 0045 London Paddington to Reading will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow</p>
