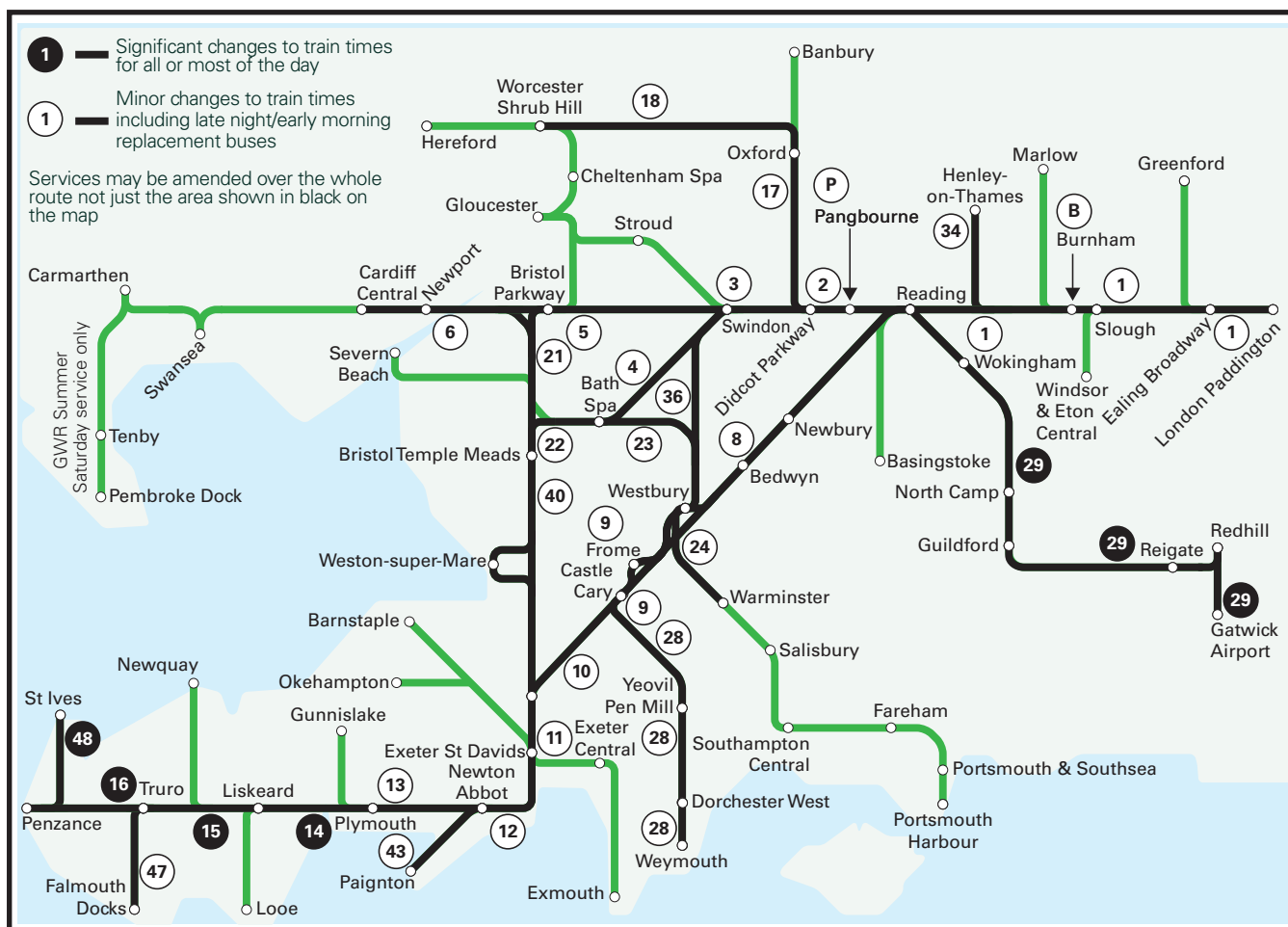


Summary of timetable changes

①	Saturday - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will finish its journey at Ealing Broadway. Sunday - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start from Ealing Broadway. Passengers should use TfL Central line services to complete their journey to / from central London, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. Sunday - The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will run later throughout. Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service - Trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings.
① ② ③ ⑤	Sunday - All day, High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be revised. Most trains from London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual and most trains TO London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later than usual. The 1700 Cheltenham Spa to London Paddington will finish its journey at Swindon. Passengers travel forward on the next available service. Trains between London Paddington and Swindon (occasionally beyond) will be revised, and will call additionally at Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford, in place of local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway, which will mostly only run between Reading and Didcot Parkway.
① ② ③ ④ ②② ④①	Sunday - All day, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) will be revised. Some trains will not run at all, and some trains that would normally run beyond Bristol Temple Meads to / from Weston-super-Mare and Taunton (or beyond) will only run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers should use alternative scheduled rail services between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton. Some trains from London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will call additionally at Didcot Parkway, in place of trains that will no longer run. The 2300 & 2333 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading to run non-stop to Bath Spa. Replacement buses will run from Reading to Swindon and Chippenham. Passengers travelling to Didcot Parkway should travel on an alternative local service from Reading.
⑥ ⑨ ②① ②② ②③ ②④ ②⑧ ③⑥	Saturday - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Frome. Sunday - The 0806 Warminster to Swindon and the 0908 Swindon to Westbury will be replaced by buses between Warminster / Westbury and Chippenham. Alternative rail connections will be available between Chippenham and Swindon. The 0839 Westbury to Bristol Temple Meads will depart at 0921 and will run later throughout, not calling at Avoncliff or Freshford. The 0900 Westbury to Weymouth will depart at 0938 and run later throughout and the 0908 Bristol Temple Meads to Weymouth will run later from Yeovil Pen Mill onwards. The 0922 Frome to Cardiff Central will depart at 0939 and run later throughout. The 1038 Weymouth to Swindon will depart at 1114 and run later to Chippenham where it will finish its journey. The 1332 Swindon to Weymouth will start its journey from Chippenham. Alternative rail connections will be available between Chippenham and Swindon. Monday to Thursday - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury and the 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will both finish their journeys at Bath Spa. Replacement buses will run from Bath Spa to Westbury and Frome. The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Temple Meads will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Bath Spa, with a connecting rail service from Bath Spa to Bristol Temple Meads.
⑧	Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will be slightly retimed and will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington.
⑧ ⑨ ⑩ ⑪ ⑫ ⑬ ④③	Sunday - All day, most trains from London Paddington to the West of England will depart from London Paddington slightly EARLIER than usual. The 1032 Paignton to London Paddington will not run and the 0918 Penzance to London Paddington will call additionally at Castle Cary. The 1436 London Paddington to Exeter St Davids will not run and the 1503 (departing at 1501) London Paddington to Plymouth will call additionally at Pewsey, Westbury and Castle Cary, then will run later from Taunton to Plymouth. The 0759 (departing at 0753) London Paddington to Exeter St Davids and the 1630 London Paddington to Plymouth will both finish their journeys at Bristol Temple Meads. The 1800 London Paddington to Plymouth (via Bristol Temple Meads) will not run. The 1322 & 1732 Exeter St Davids to London Paddington and the 1502 Plymouth to London Paddington will all start from Bristol Temple Meads.
⑪	Sunday - The 2350 London Paddington to Penzance (also finishing its journey at Truro) will arrive later at Exeter St Davids. The 2115 Penzance to London Paddington will depart EARLIER from Exeter St Davids and will arrive earlier at Reading. Monday and Thursday - The 2345 London Paddington to Penzance (also finishing its journey at Truro) will arrive later at Exeter St Davids. Monday - The 2348 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will arrive later at Exeter St Davids.

14 15 16	Sunday - The 1603 & 1803 London Paddington to Penzance will both finish their journeys at Plymouth. Alternative rail connections will be available from Plymouth to Penzance. The 2350 London Paddington to Penzance will finish its journey at Truro. Replacement buses will run from Truro to Penzance. Monday to Friday - All week, buses will replace trains between Truro and Penzance. Passengers travelling between St Erth and Penzance should use local bus services 17 / 17A, on which valid GWR rail tickets will be accepted. Some other trains will either not run between Plymouth and Truro, or will not run at all. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
17 18	Monday to Thursday - The 2153 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill will call additionally at Didcot Parkway then be diverted to run non-stop to Worcester Shrub Hill. An alternative rail connection will be available from Didcot Parkway to Oxford with a replacement bus from Oxford to Worcester Shrub Hill. The 2251 London Paddington to Worcestershire Parkway will finish its journey at Oxford. A replacement bus will run from Oxford to Worcestershire Parkway. The 2200 Hereford to London Paddington will finish its journey at Worcester Shrub Hill and restart from Oxford. A replacement bus will run from Worcester Shrub Hill to Oxford, but will not connect into the train at Oxford. Passengers travelling from Cotswolds stations to stations beyond Oxford should travel on an EARLIER service.
29	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Reading and Guildford. On Saturday, passengers travelling between Reading and Wokingham should use alternative rail services provided by SWR. A few trains on Saturday and all trains on Sunday will also not run between Redhill and Gatwick Airport. Passengers travelling between Redhill and Gatwick Airport should use alternative services provided by other operators. A few other trains will not run at all. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling. Monday - The 0628 Reading to Gatwick Airport will depart EARLIER and call at all stations (except Wanborough) from Wokingham to Gatwick Airport. The 0651 Reading to Redhill will not run. The 0720 Reading to Gatwick Airport will call additionally at Chilworth and Dorking West.
34	Tuesday to Thursday - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.
47	Monday to Friday - All week, the 2256 Truro to Falmouth Docks and the 2322 Falmouth Docks to Truro will both run 10 minutes later throughout.
48	Monday to Friday - All week, trains between St Ives and St Erth / Penzance will not run. Passengers should instead use local bus services 17 / 17A, on which valid GWR rail tickets will be accepted.
B	The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow: Tuesday to Thursday - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington; Friday - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington; In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
P	Friday - The 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
