


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday 6 to Friday 12 December 2025

Saturday - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will finish its journey at Ealing Broadway. Passengers should use TfL Central line services to complete their journey to central London, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.

Sunday - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will not run. Passengers should travel on the next available service. The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will run later throughout.

Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service - Trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings.

- Sunday until approximately 1830 Some High Speed services will depart from London Paddington slightly EARLIER than usual. Local stopping services from Didcot Parkway to Reading and London Paddington will run slightly later from Didcot Parkway to Reading.
- Sunday All day, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) will be revised. Some trains will not run at all, and some trains that would normally run beyond Bristol Temple Meads to / from Weston-super-Mare and Taunton (or beyond) will only run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers should use alternative scheduled rail services between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton. Some trains from London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will call additionally at Didcot Parkway, in place of trains that will no longer run.
- Monday to Thursday The 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading to run non-stop to Bath Spa. Passengers travelling to Didcot Parkway should use the 2314 London Paddington to Oxford service which will call at Didcot Parkway to drop off as well as pick up passengers.

 A replacement bus will connect out of this service at Didcot Parkway, running to Swindon and Chippenham. Passengers travelling from Didcot Parkway, Swindon and Chippenham to Bath Spa should use an EARLIER service.
- Monday to Thursday The 2246 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Swindon and will run later from Bristol Parkway to Swansea.

 Monday to Thursday The 2048, 2148 & 2246 London Paddington to Swansea will be subjected to minor retimings at stations west of Cardiff Central.
- Monday to Friday All week, trains between London Paddington / Reading and the West of England will be revised. Some trains will be diverted via Bristol Temple Meads, not calling at Newbury, Hungerford, Pewsey, Westbury or Castle Cary. Trains will depart EARLIER from London Paddington and Reading on journeys towards the West of England and arrive later at Reading and London Paddington on journeys from the West of England. Some trains will only run between London Paddington / Reading and Westbury / Castle Cary, and a few trains will not run at all. Replacement buses will run between Castle Cary and Taunton. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
- Sunday The 0804 (departing 0759) London Paddington to Penzance will not call at Newbury or Pewsey. The 0844 (departing 0835) London Paddington to Penzance will call additionally at Newbury and Pewsey. The 0806 Reading to Newbury will not run and the 0833 Reading to Bedwyn will start from Newbury and run slightly later throughout. A replacement bus will run EARLIER from Reading to Newbury, to connect into the train.
- Monday to Friday The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. A connecting rail service will run EARLIER from Frome to Westbury. The 1808 London Paddington to Frome will be extended to Castle Cary.

Sunday - The 2350 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive later at Exeter St Davids. The 2115 Penzance to London Paddington will depart EARLIER from Exeter St Davids.

Monday to Thursday - The 2305 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will finish its journey at Taunton. The 2348 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will be replaced by a bus. The 2345 London Paddington to Penzance and the 2145 Penzance to London Paddington will not call at Taunton. Passengers travelling to / from Taunton should travel on earlier services.

Monday to Friday - The 1030 & 1430 London Paddington to Weston-super-Mare will not run from Bristol Temple Meads to Weston-super-Mare. The 1326 & 1728 Weston-super-Mare to London Paddington will start from Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers should travel on alternative scheduled rail services between Bristol Temple Meads and Weston-super-Mare. 1730 London Paddington to Taunton will finish its journey at Weston-super-Mare and the 1935 Exeter St Davids to London Paddington will start from Weston-super-Mare. Passengers should travel on alternative scheduled rail services between Weston-super-Mare and Taunton / Exeter St Davids.

Saturday - The 0515 Penzance to Truro will not run. Passengers should travel on a later service. The 0612 & 0710 Penzance to London Paddington will start from

Plymouth. Alternative EARLIER rail connections will be available from Penzance to Plymouth. **Sunday until approximately 1100** - Trains between Plymouth and Penzance will either not run or will be replaced by buses between Plymouth and Liskeard.

Menheniot will be served by a separate minibus service to / from Liskeard.

Saturday - The 2030 Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour will finish its journey at Southampton Central. Alternative rail connections will be available from Southampton Central to Fareham and Fareham to Portsmouth Harbour.

Sunday - All day, buses will replace trains between Southampton Central and Portsmouth Harbour. Passengers travelling between Fratton, Portsmouth & Southsea and Portsmouth Harbour should use other operators' services, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. Some other trains between Bristol Temple Meads, Westbury and Salisbury will not run and other trains will make additional stops (and be retimed as a consequence). **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling**.

Monday - The 0450 Fratton to Bristol Temple Meads will start from Southampton Central. Passengers travelling from stations east of Southampton Central should use an alternative service.

Saturday - The 2335 Reading to Gatwick Airport will finish its journey at Redhill. Analternative rail connection, operated by Southern, will be available from Redhill to Gatwick Airport, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.

Sunday - All day, buses will replace trains between Guildford and Redhill / Gatwick Airport. Buses will not serve Dorking Deepdene, but will instead call at Dorking station, approximately 5 minutes walk away. Passengers travelling between Redhill and Gatwick Airport should use alternative services provided by other operators. A few other trains will not run.

- **Sunday** The 0737 & 0837 Reading to Basingstoke and the 0806 Basingstoke to Reading will not run. Replacement buses will run at 0737 from Reading to Basingstoke and at 0745 from Basingstoke to Reading. These buses will not call at Reading West, and passengers travelling to / from Reading West should use alternative services running between Reading and Newbury.
- **Sunday** The 0007 Marlow to Maidenhead will finish its journey at Bourne End. A replacement bus will run from Bourne End to Maidenhead.
- Monday to Friday All week, direct trains between London Paddington / Reading and Paignton will not run. Passengers should use alternative services, changing en-route where required, to complete their journey.
- **Sunday** -The 0903 Plymouth to Gunnislake and the 1011 Gunnislake to Plymouth will not run. Replacement buses will run instead, although not all intermediate journeys will be possible. Passengers should travel on a later rail service if possible.
- Monday to Friday All week, buses will replace trains between Liskeard and Looe. Please see local publicity for details of alternative stopping points as not all intermediate stations will be served.
- **Sunday** The 1027 Swansea to Carmarthen will not run. The 1125 Carmarthen to London Paddington will start from Swansea. Replacement buses will run between Swansea, Llanelli and Carmarthen, in some cases running EARLIER than usual.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow: Saturday - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading, 0019 Reading to London Paddington and 2345 Didcot Parkway to Ealing Broadway; **Sunday** - 0034 London Paddington to Reading; In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: Sunday - 0620 (departing 0636) Reading to London Paddington and 2350 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

Sunday until approximately 1915 and from 2230 until end of service - Trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
