


Summary of timetable changes



Saturday to Tuesday - All day on all four days, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be reduced in frequency and will only run between London Paddington and Cardiff Central, and between Bridgend and Swansea / Carmarthen. Most trains will depart EARLIER from London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Cardiff Central and Bridgend. A few early morning and late evening buses will be extended to run between Cardiff Central and Swansea. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.

Wednesday and Thursday - All day on both days, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be reduced in frequency. Most trains from London Paddington will depart EARLIER than usual.

Friday - All day, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be reduced in frequency, and will be diverted between Reading and Bristol Parkway to call additionally at Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads, not calling at (Didcot Parkway) or Swindon. Replacement buses will run between Reading and Swindon. Passengers travelling between Swindon and Bristol Parkway should use alternative services and change at Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.

- The Night Riviera Sleeper service this service will run this week only on the night of Friday 2 January 2026.
- 1 11 12 13 14 15 16 3 4 22 40 Saturday to Thursday - Most trains from London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) will be retimed, in some cases, EARLIER than usual. Some trains will call additionally at Didcot Parkway. Except on Sunday, trains between London Paddington and Cheltenham Spa will only run between Swindon and Cheltenham Spa. A few other trains will not run. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
 - Thursday The 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will both finish their journey at Port Talbot Parkway. Replacement buses will run from Port Talbot Parkway to Swansea. Friday - The 0338 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Port Talbot Parkway. A replacement bus will run from Swansea to Port Talbot Parkway.
 - Saturday All day, trains between London Paddington and Newbury will not run. Passengers should use alternative services, changing at Reading where necessary, to complete their journey.
 - services to travel between London Paddington and Reading. Friday - All day, trains between London Paddington and Newbury will not run. Some trains between Newbury and Bedwyn will be retimed, in some cases, EARLIER than usual.

Monday to Thursday - All day, trains between London Paddington and Newbury will only run between Reading and Newbury. Passengers should use alternative

- Sunday The 0804 (departing 0800) London Paddington to Penzance will not call at Newbury or Pewsey. The 0844 (departing 0833) London Paddington to Penzance will call additionally at Newbury and Pewsey and will run slightly later from Westbury onwards. The 0806 Reading to Newbury will not run and the 0833 Reading to Bedwyn will start from Newbury and run slightly later throughout. A replacement bus will run EARLIER from Reading to Newbury, to connect into the train.
 - **Monday and Tuesday** The 2130 Cardiff Central to Frome and the 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will both finish their journeys at Westbury. Replacement buses will run from Westbury to Frome. **Monday to Wednesday and Friday** The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. **Thursday** The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will not
- run. Westbury. Passengers should use the next available service.

 Monday to Thursday The 0618 Yeovil Pen Mill to Filton Abbey Wood will start from Castle Cary. Passengers travelling from Yeovil Pen Mill should use the next available service.
 - Monday to Friday The 0642 Frome to Cardiff Central will start from Westbury. Passengers travelling from From should use the next available service.
- Saturday and Monday to Friday All day on these days, most local stopping trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Filton Abbey Wood will not run. Some trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Gloucester will call additionally at Lawrence Hill, Stapleton Road and Ashley Down. The 1412 Bristol Temple Meads to Avonmouth will not run and the 1446 Avonmouth to Weston-super-Mare will start from Bristol Temple Meads.
 - Saturday The 2335 Reading to Gatwick Airport will finish its journey at Redhill. An alternative rail connection, operated by Southern, will be available from Redhill to Gatwick Airport, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.

The 2305 Gatwick Airport to Reading will depart slightly EARLIER from Gatwick Airport.
- Sunday The 0837 Basingstoke to Reading will not run. A replacement bus will run EARLIER instead. This bus will not call at Reading West, and passengers travelling to / from Reading West should use an alternative service.
- 33 34 Sunday The 0007 Marlow to Maidenhead will finish its journey at Bourne End. A replacement bus will run from Bourne End to Maidenhead.

 Tuesday The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.
- **Friday** A few trains between Westbury and Swindon will be retimed.
- Monday to Wednesday The 2340 (Monday and Tuesday) Exeter St Davids to Exmouth and the 0019 (Tuesday and Wednesday) Exmouth to Exeter St Davids will not run. Replacement buses will run instead, extending journey times.
- The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow: Saturday 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington; Sunday 0034 London Paddington to Reading; Tuesday 0001 London Paddington to Reading; In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

 The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: Sunday 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 (departing 0623) Reading to London Paddington and 2352 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.
- The following trains will not call at Pangbourne: Sunday 0738, 2233 (departing 2238) & 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 0818 (departing 0809) & 2352 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington; Friday 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway; In all cases, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
