



**Sunday until approximately 1100** - No GWR services will run to / from London Paddington. Elizabeth line services will run between London Paddington and Hayes & Harlington, and GWR services will run between Maidenhead and Reading. Replacement buses will run between Hayes & Harlington and Maidenhead. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.** 

**Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service** - Some trains will be subject to minor retimings between London Paddington and Reading.

- **Saturday** All day, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) will be reduced to an hourly frequency, and will be diverted to run non-stop between Reading and Bath Spa, not calling at Didcot Parkway, Swindon or Chippenham. Trains between London Paddington and Cheltenham Spa will only run between Swindon and Cheltenham Spa. Replacement buses will run between Reading and Swindon, between Didcot Parkway and Swindon and between Swindon and Chippenham. Additional trains will run between Chippenham, Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling**.
- Saturday All day, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be reduced in frequency, and will be diverted between Reading and Bristol Parkway to call additionally at Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads, not calling at (Didcot Parkway) or Swindon. Replacement buses will run between Reading and Swindon and between Swindon and Bristol Parkway. A few other trains will not run, or will only run for part of their journey. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
- 3 4 Saturday The 0846 Cheltenham Spa to Bristol Temple Meads (via Swindon), the 1018 & 1518 Bristol Temple Meads to Oxford and the 1202 & 1702 Oxford to Bristol Temple Meads will not run. Passengers should use alternative services, changing en-route where necessary, to complete their journey.
- Saturday All day, trains between London Paddington and Newbury will not run. Passengers should travel on alternative services, changing at Reading where necessary, to complete their journey.
- Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service Buses will replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn. Tuesday to Friday The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will not run. Passengers should use alternative earlier or later services.
- **Tuesday to Friday** The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. A connecting rail service will be available from Frome to Westbury, departing slightly EARLIER than usual.

**Saturday** - All day, most trains between London Paddington and Weston-super-Mare (or beyond) will only run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers should use other scheduled rail services to travel between Bristol Temple Meads and Weston-super-Mare / Taunton.

- Monday to Thursday from approximately 2200 until end of service Trains between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton will either be diverted to run non-stop between Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton, or will either only run for part of their journey, or will not run at all. Buses will run between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton / Exeter St Davids, in place of diverted or cancelled trains.
- Sunday The 2350 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive slightly later at Exeter St Davids. The 2115 Penzance to London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER from Exeter St Davids.
- Monday to Friday All week, trains between Penzance / St Erth and St Ives will not run. Passengers should use local bus services 17 / 17A, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. Other trains will continue to run normally between Penzance and St Erth.
