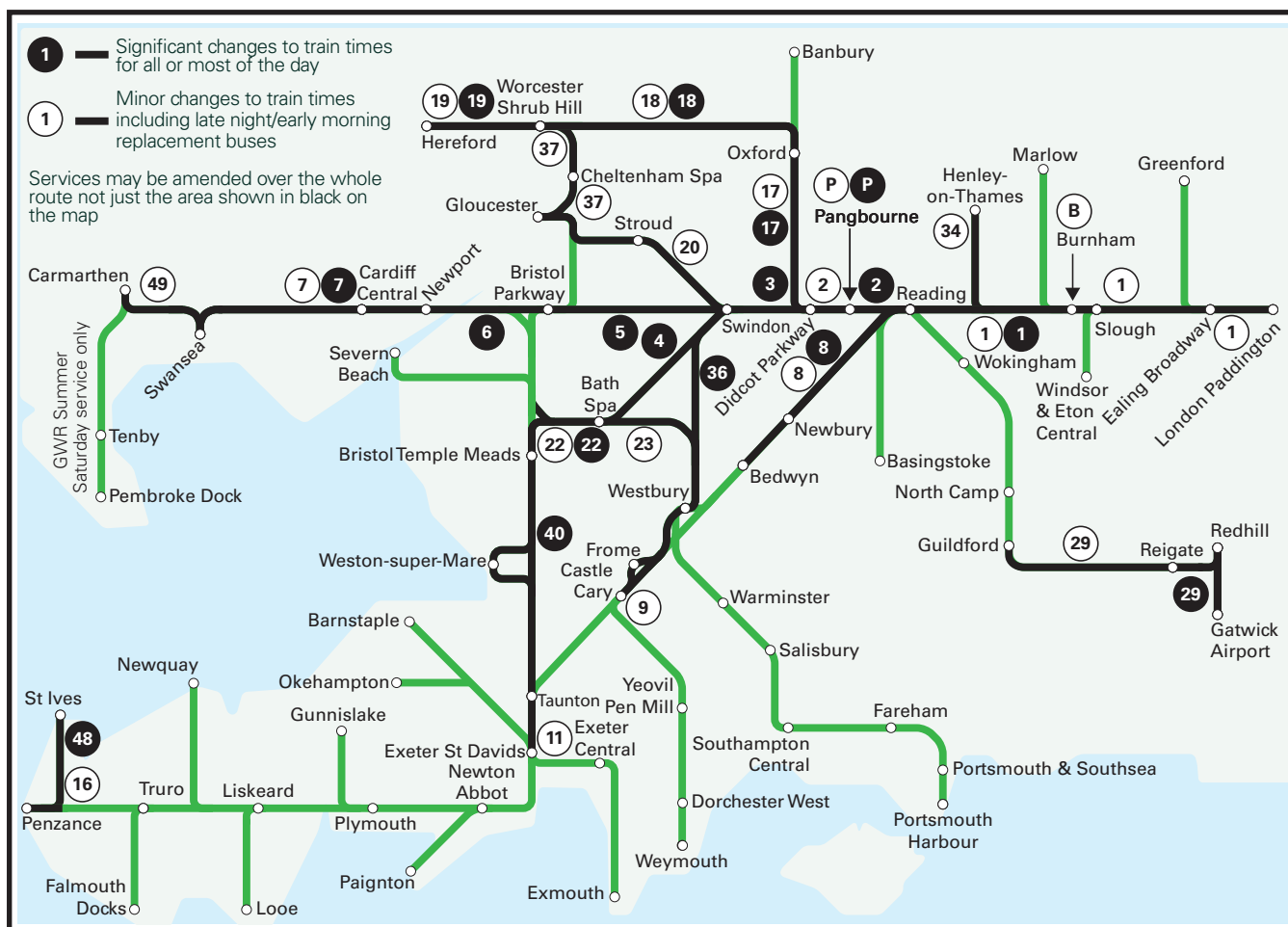


Summary of timetable changes

①	Saturday - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will finish its journey at Maidenhead. A replacement bus will run from Maidenhead to London Paddington. Sunday - The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will finish its journey at Maidenhead and 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start from Maidenhead. No replacement transport will be provided between Maidenhead and London Paddington - passengers should travel on the next available service.
① ② ①⑦	Saturday from approximately 2300 to Sunday until approximately 0930 - Trains between London Paddington and Reading / Didcot Parkway / Oxford will be retimed, in some cases EARLIER than usual. Replacement buses will run between Reading and Didcot Parkway / Oxford. A few trains will not run. Monday to Thursday from approximately 2300 until end of service - Trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings.
① ② ③ ④ ⑤ ⑥ ⑦ ⑧ ①⑦ ②⑦ ②② ③⑦ ④⑦ ④⑨	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, all High Speed services between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) and between London Paddington and South Wales will be completely revised and reduced in frequency. Trains will not call at Didcot Parkway, Swindon and Chippenham. Most trains FROM London Paddington and Reading will depart MUCH earlier than usual. Most trains running beyond Bristol Temple Meads to / from Weston-super-Mare, Taunton or Exeter St Davids will not run. Trains between London Paddington and South Wales will call additionally at Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads. Trains between London Paddington and Cheltenham Spa will only run between Swindon and Cheltenham Spa. On Saturday, trains between London Paddington and Newbury and direct services between Bristol Temple Meads and Oxford will not run. Some trains will not run at all or will only run for part of their journey. Additional trains will run between London Paddington and Reading (on Saturday, extended to / from Didcot Parkway) and between Chippenham, Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads. Replacement buses will run between Reading and Swindon, between Didcot Parkway and Swindon and between Swindon and Bristol Parkway. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling, especially when travelling later in the day.
① ② ①⑦ ①⑧ ①⑨	Sunday - All day, trains between London Paddington and Oxford / North Cotswolds will be retimed beyond Didcot Parkway (towards Oxford and beyond) or beyond Oxford (towards London Paddington). Trains between London Paddington and Oxford will not call at Slough. Most local trains from Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will be retimed slightly later than usual.
⑦	Monday to Thursday - The 2048, 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run later from Bridgend to Swansea.
⑧	Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will be slightly retimed and will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington.
⑨ ②② ②③ ③⑥	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between Swindon and Westbury (and beyond) will only run between Chippenham and Westbury. Some trains will be retimed. Replacement buses will run between Swindon and Chippenham. In addition, the 0750 Warminster to Swindon and the 0908 Swindon to Westbury will be replaced by buses throughout, running EARLIER than usual. Monday to Thursday - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury and the 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will both finish their journeys at Bath Spa. Replacement buses will run from Bath Spa to Westbury and Frome. The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Temple Meads will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Bath Spa, with a connecting rail service from Bath Spa to Bristol Temple Meads.
⑪	Sunday - The 2350 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive slightly later at Exeter St Davids. The 2115 Penzance to London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER from Exeter St Davids. Monday and Tuesday - The 2348 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will arrive later at Exeter St Davids. Monday to Thursday - The 2345 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive slightly later at Exeter St Davids.
①⑥ ④⑧	Saturday to Friday - All week, trains between Penzance / St Erth and St Ives will not run. Passengers should use local bus services 17 / 17A, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. Other trains will continue to run normally between Penzance and St Erth.

17 18 19	Monday to Thursday from approximately 2100 until end of service - Buses will replace trains between Moreton-in-Marsh and Worcester Shrub Hill. Some journeys will no longer be possible and passengers may need to travel EARLIER than usual to complete their journey. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
	Tuesday to Friday - The 0516 Worcester Shrub Hill to London Paddington will start from Moreton-in-Marsh. A replacement bus will run from Worcester Shrub Hill to Moreton-in-Marsh, departing EARLIER than usual.
29	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between Reading and Gatwick Airport will only run between Reading and Reigate. Replacement buses will run between Reigate and Redhill and between Reigate and Gatwick Airport. On Sunday , the 2305 Reading to Gatwick Airport and the 2305 Gatwick Airport to Reading will be replaced by buses between Guildford and Gatwick Airport.
34	Tuesday to Friday - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.
37	Sunday - The 1139, 1339, 1538 & 1739 Bristol Temple Meads to Worcester Foregate Street will all finish their journeys at Worcester Shrub Hill. Alternative rail connections will be available from Worcester Shrub Hill to Worcester Foregate Street.
B	The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:
	Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to Maidenhead; Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading; Tuesday, Thursday and Friday - 0001 & 0049 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington; In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
P	Sunday - All day, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
P	The following trains will not call at Pangbourne:
	Monday - 0410 Oxford to Reading (no replacement transport provided - passengers should travel on the next available service);
	Monday to Thursday - 2236 & 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2326 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington; Tuesday to Friday - 0355 Oxford to Reading (no replacement transport provided - passengers should travel on the next available service); Unless otherwise shown, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
