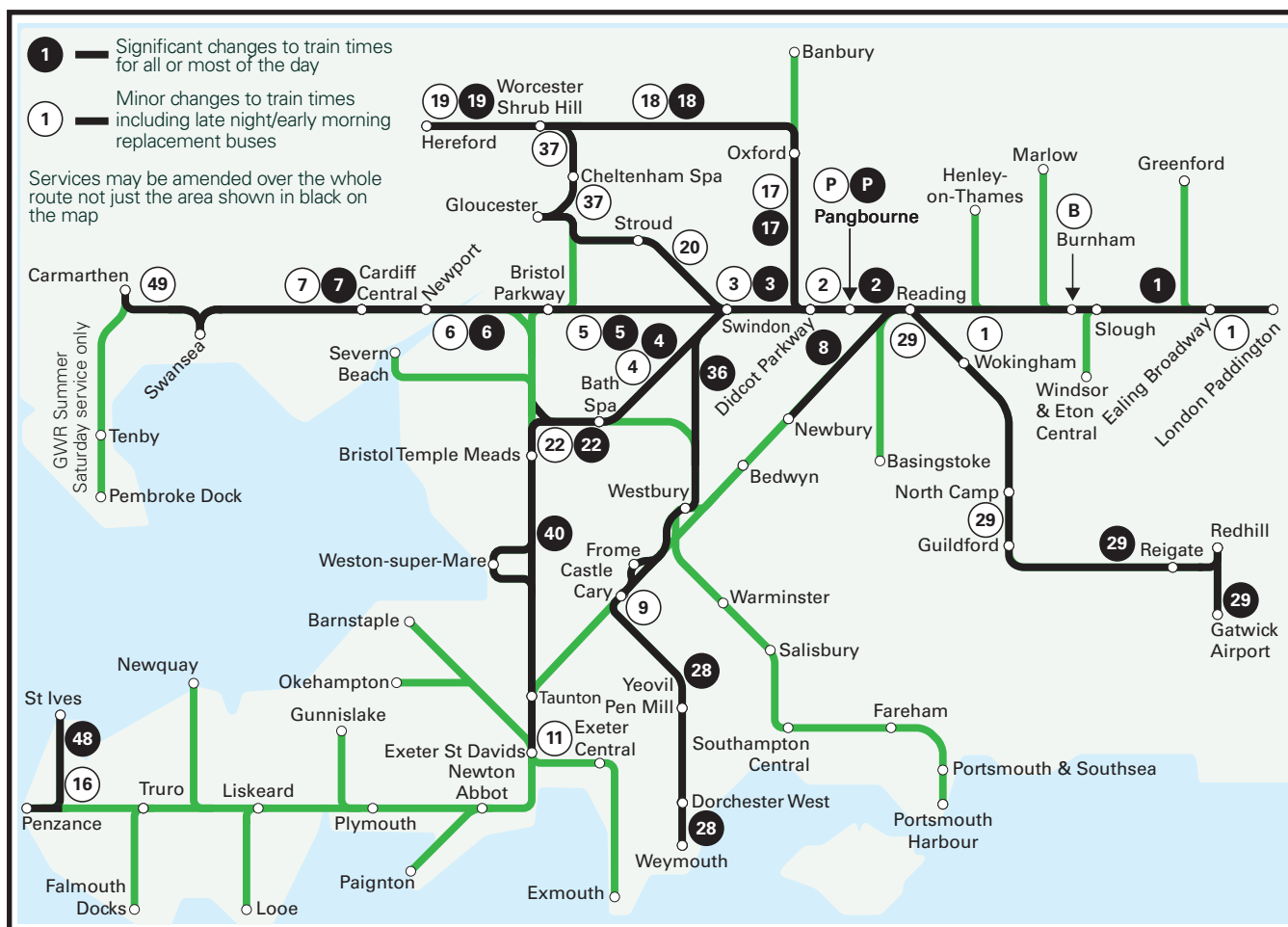


Summary of timetable changes

① ② ①⑦	Saturday from approximately 2300 to Sunday until approximately 0930 - Trains between London Paddington and Reading / Didcot Parkway / Oxford will be retimed, in some cases EARLIER than usual. Replacement buses will run between Reading and Didcot Parkway / Oxford. A few trains will not run. Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service - Trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings.
① ② ③ ④ ⑤ ⑥ ⑦ ⑧ ①⑦ ②⑦ ②② ③⑦ ④⑦ ④⑨	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, all High Speed services between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) and between London Paddington and South Wales will be completely revised and reduced in frequency. Trains will not call at Didcot Parkway, Swindon and Chippenham. Most trains FROM London Paddington and Reading will depart MUCH earlier than usual. Most trains running beyond Bristol Temple Meads to / from Weston-super-Mare, Taunton or Exeter St Davids will not run. Trains between London Paddington and South Wales will call additionally at Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads. Trains between London Paddington and Cheltenham Spa will only run between Swindon and Cheltenham Spa. On Saturday, trains between London Paddington and Newbury and direct services between Bristol Temple Meads and Oxford will not run. Some trains will not run at all or will only run for part of their journey. Additional trains will run between London Paddington and Reading (on Saturday, extended to / from Didcot Parkway) and between Chippenham, Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads. Replacement buses will run between Reading and Swindon, between Didcot Parkway and Swindon and between Swindon and Bristol Parkway. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling, especially when travelling later in the day.
① ② ①⑦ ①⑧ ①⑨	Sunday - All day, in addition to the above changes, most other High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be revised. Most trains from London Paddington will depart EARLIER than usual. Trains between London Paddington and Oxford / North Cotswolds will also be retimed beyond Didcot Parkway (towards Oxford and beyond) or beyond Oxford (towards London Paddington). Trains between London Paddington and Oxford will not call at Slough. Most local trains between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will be slightly retimed, in some cases, EARLIER than usual.
② ③ ④ ②②	Monday, Tuesday and Thursday - The 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading to run non-stop to Bath Spa. Passengers should travel EARLIER on the 2314 (2316 on Monday and Tuesday) London Paddington to Oxford, changing at Didcot Parkway for a replacement bus to Swindon and Chippenham. Passengers travelling from Didcot Parkway, Swindon or Chippenham to Bath Spa or Bristol Temple Meads should travel on an alternative EARLIER service.
⑤ ⑥ ⑦	Monday, Tuesday and Thursday - The 2246 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Swindon, calling additionally at Chippenham and Bath Spa and will run up to 45 minutes later from Bristol Parkway onwards. Monday to Thursday - The 2048, 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will all be subject to retimings between Cardiff Central and Swansea.
⑨ ②⑧ ③⑥	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Castle Cary, Yeovil Pen Mill and Weymouth. In addition, on Saturday, the 0733 Weymouth to Gloucester will start from Westbury and the 1608 Gloucester to Weymouth will finish its journey at Frome. On Sunday, the 0900 Westbury to Weymouth will not run at all. Passengers from Westbury should travel on the 0922 to Castle Cary, changing there for replacement buses towards Weymouth. Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between Swindon and Westbury (and beyond) will only run between Chippenham and Westbury. Some trains will be retimed. Replacement buses will run between Swindon and Chippenham.
⑪	Monday to Thursday - The 2305 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will finish its journey at Taunton and the 2348 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will be replaced by a bus throughout. The 2345 London Paddington to Penzance and the 2145 Penzance to London Paddington will not call at Taunton. Passengers travelling to / from Taunton should use EARLIER services.
①⑥ ④⑧	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between Penzance / St Erth and St Ives will not run. Passengers should use local bus services 17 / 17A, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. Other trains will continue to run normally between Penzance and St Erth.
②⑨ ②⑨	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between Reading and Gatwick Airport will only run between Reading and Guildford. Replacement buses will run between Guildford and Redhill / Gatwick Airport. Buses will stop at Dorking station instead of at Dorking Deepdene station, a 5 minute walk away. Passengers travelling between Reigate, Redhill and Gatwick Airport should use alternative rail services, operated by Southern and Thameslink. A few other trains between Reading and Guildford will either be retimed or will not run at all.

Sunday - The 1139, 1339, 1538 & 1739 Bristol Temple Meads to Worcester Foregate Street will all finish their journeys at Worcester Shrub Hill. Alternative rail connections will be available from Worcester Shrub Hill to Worcester Foregate Street.

Saturday - The 0049 London Paddington to Reading will not call at Burnham and Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

Sunday - All day, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.

Monday - The 0410 Oxford to Reading will not call at Pangbourne. No replacement transport will be provided - passengers should travel on the next available service.
