


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday 24 to Friday 30 January 2026

- **(1)(2)** Saturday from approximately 2300 to Sunday until approximately 0930 - Trains between London Paddington and Reading / Didcot Parkway / Oxford will be **17**) retimed, in some cases EARLIER than usual. Replacement buses will run between Reading and Didcot Parkway / Oxford. A few trains will not run. Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, all High Speed services between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) and between 12
- London Paddington and South Wales will be completely revised and reduced in frequency. Trains will not call at Didcot Parkway, Swindon and Chippenham. 34 Most trains FROM London Paddington and Reading will depart MUCH earlier than usual. Most trains running beyond Bristol Temple Meads to / from 56 Weston-super-Mare, Taunton or Exeter St Davids will not run. Trains between London Paddington and South Wales will call additionally at Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads. Trains between London Paddington and Cheltenham Spa will only run between Swindon and Cheltenham Spa. On Saturday, trains 78 between London Paddington and Newbury and direct services between Bristol Temple Meads and Oxford will not run. Some trains will not run at all or will only 17 20 run for part of their journey. Additional trains will run between London Paddington and Reading (on Saturday, extended to / from Didcot Parkway) and between **22** 37 Chippenham, Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads. Replacement buses will run between Reading and Swindon, between Didcot Parkway and Swindon and between Swindon and Bristol Parkway.
- 40 49 Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling, especially when travelling later in the day.
- 12 Sunday - All day, in addition to the above changes, most other High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be revised. Most trains from London Paddington will depart EARLIER than usual. Trains between London Paddington and Oxford / North Cotswolds will also be retimed beyond Didcot Parkway **17 18** (towards Oxford and beyond) or beyond Oxford (towards London Paddington). Trains between London Paddington and Oxford will not call at Slough. Most local 19 trains between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will be slightly retimed, in some cases, EARLIER than usual.
- From approximately 0600 Monday and all day Tuesday to Friday All week, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will only run between 12 London Paddington and Port Talbot Parkway. Replacement buses will run between Port Talbot Parkway, Neath and Swansea, and (operated by Transport for Wales) 3 5 6 7 49 between Swansea, Llanelli and Carmarthen. Some other trains will only run between London Paddington and Cardiff Central and some other trains (including some trains between London Paddington and Cardiff Central) will not run at all. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling, especially when travelling later in the day.
 - (On Monday only, the 0338, 0459 & 0529 Swansea to London Paddington will run normally).
- Monday to Thursday The 2228 (departing 2230) & 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Swindon to run non-stop to 4 22 Bristol Temple Meads. Replacement buses will serve Chippenham and Bath Spa.
- **6 21** Monday and Tuesday - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will be retimed after Newport, in some cases, slightly EARLIER than usual.
- Sunday The 0806 Reading to Newbury will not run. The 0833 Reading to Bedwyn will depart slightly EARLIER and call additionally at Reading West. Aldermaston and Midgham. (8)
 - Monday to Friday The 2230 London Paddington to Bedwyn will start from Reading and the 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will finish its journey at Reading. Alternative connections will be available between London Paddington and Reading.
 - Saturday and Sunday All weekend, buses will replace trains between Castle Carv, Yeovil Pen Mill and Weymouth, In addition, on Saturday, the 0733 Weymouth to Gloucester will start from Westbury and the 1608 Gloucester to Weymouth will finish its journey at Frome. On Sunday, the 0900 Westbury to Weymouth will not run at all. Passengers from Westbury should travel on the 0922 to Castle Cary, changing there for replacement buses towards Weymouth. Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between Swindon and Westbury (and beyond) will only run between Chippenham and Westbury. Some trains will be retimed. Replacement buses will run between Swindon and Chippenham.

Monday to Thursday - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury will finish its journey at Bath Spa. A replacement bus will run from Bath Spa to Westbury. The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will not run. Replacement buses will run from Bath Spa to Westbury and Frome. The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Temple Meads will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Bristol Temple Meads.



Monday to Friday - The 0657 Bath Spa to Bristol Temple Meads will not run. The 0523 (departing 0533) London Paddington to Swansea (finishing its journey at Bristol Temple Meads) will call additionally at Oldfield Park and Keynsham.



Sunday until approximately 1800 - Most trains between Cardiff Central / Bristol Temple Meads and Exeter St Davids will not run between Taunton and Exeter St Davids. Passengers should travel on alternative services. Some trains between Exeter St Davids / Plymouth and Penzance will only run between Newton Abbot / Plymouth and Penzance. Some trains to and from Paignton will be revised.



Monday and Tuesday - The 2131 London Paddington to Cheltenham Spa will finish its journey at Gloucester. A replacement bus will run from Gloucester to Cheltenham Spa.

Monday to Thursday - The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will be diverted to run non-stop to, and finish its journey at, Gloucester. A replacement bus will run from Swindon to Cheltenham Spa, calling at stations via Stroud.

Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between Reading and Gatwick Airport will only run between Reading and Guildford. Replacement buses will run between Guildford and Redhill / Gatwick Airport. Buses will stop at Dorking station instead of at Dorking Deepdene station, a 5 minute walk away. Passengers travelling between Reigate, Redhill and Gatwick Airport should use alternative rail services, operated by Southern and Thameslink. A few other trains between Reading and Guildford will either be retimed or will not run at all.



Monday to Thursday - The 2333 Reading to Gatwick Airport will finish its journey at Guildford, and the 2322 Gatwick Airport to Reading will finish its journey at Redhill and restart from Guildford. Replacement buses will run instead.

Tuesday to Friday - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport will run later from Guildford and finish its journey at Redhill. The 0559 Gatwick Airport to Reading will start from Redhill. Alternative rail connections, operated by Southern, will be available between Redhill and Gatwick Airport, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.

- 33 Sunday The 0007 Marlow to Maidenhead will finish its journey at Bourne End. A replacement bus will run from Bourne End to Maidenhead.
- Tuesday to Thursday The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.
- 37 Sunday The 1139, 1339, 1538 & 1739 Bristol Temple Meads to Worcester Foregate Street will all finish their journeys at Worcester Shrub Hill. Alternative rail connections will be available from Worcester Shrub Hill to Worcester Foregate Street.

Saturday - The 2255 & 2350 Exmouth to Exeter St Davids will both finish their journeys at Exeter Central. Replacement buses will run from Exeter Central to Exeter St Davids.



Sunday until approximately 1800 - Buses will replace trains between Exeter St Davids and Exeter Central. Trains between Exeter Central and Exmouth will be reduced to hourly. Some trains between Exeter St Davids and Okehampton / Barnstaple will be revised.

Monday to Thursday - The 2054 Exmouth (2129 Exeter St Davids) to Barnstaple will finish its journey at Crediton. A replacement bus will run from Crediton to Barnstaple and a taxi from Crediton to Yeoford. The 2241 Barnstaple to Exeter St Davids will not run. A replacement bus will run from Barnstaple to Exeter St Davids. Yeoford will be served by a separate taxi service to / from Crediton.

Saturday 24 to Friday 30 January 2026

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:

Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading;

Tuesday to Thursday - 0001 & 0049 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington;

(B) Friday - 0049 London Paddington to Reading;

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham:

Sunday - 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0625 Reading to London Paddington and 2352 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

Sunday - All day, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.

The following trains will not call at Pangbourne:

Monday - 0410 Oxford to Reading (no replacement transport provided - passengers should travel on the next available service);

Friday - 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway;

Unless otherwise shown, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
