


Summary of timetable changes

①	<p>Saturday - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will finish its journey at Ealing Broadway. Sunday - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start from Ealing Broadway. TfL Central line connections will be available to / from central London, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.</p> <p>Sunday - The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will run later throughout.</p>
① ② ③ ④ ⑪ ⑫	<p>Saturday - The 2333 London Paddington to Oxford will finish its journey at Reading. A replacement bus will run from Reading to Didcot Parkway and Oxford. The 2345 London Paddington to Reading will not run.</p> <p>Sunday - The 0754 Oxford to London Paddington and the 0818 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will both start from Reading. Replacement buses will run EARLIER from Oxford to Didcot Parkway and from Didcot Parkway to Reading. Then for the rest of the day, most High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be revised. Some trains will depart from London Paddington slightly EARLIER than usual. A few trains will not run. Some trains will call additionally at Didcot Parkway. Local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will be retimed, in many cases, EARLIER than usual. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.</p>
① ② ③ ④ ⑤ ⑥ ⑦ ⑪	<p>Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will only run between London Paddington and Cardiff Central. Replacement buses will run non-stop between Cardiff Central and Swansea. Passengers travelling to / from Bridgend, Port Talbot Parkway and Neath should use alternative replacement buses operated on behalf of Transport for Wales, (apart from, on Sunday, the first service towards London Paddington and the last service from London Paddington, where buses will be operated on behalf of GWR). A few other trains between London Paddington and Bristol Parkway / Cardiff Central will not run. Separate rail services will run between Swansea and Carmarthen. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling, especially when travelling later in the day.</p> <p>Monday to Thursday - All day on all four days, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will only run between London Paddington and Port Talbot Parkway. Replacement buses will run between Port Talbot Parkway, Neath and Swansea. Some other trains between London Paddington and Bristol Parkway / Cardiff Central will not run. Separate rail services will run between Swansea and Carmarthen. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.</p> <p>Friday - Some trains between London Paddington and Cardiff Central / Swansea will not run. 0557 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central.</p>
⑤ ⑥ ⑦	<p>Monday to Thursday - The 2249 London Paddington to Swansea (finishing at Port Talbot Parkway) will be diverted after Swindon and will run later from Bristol Parkway to Port Talbot Parkway.</p>
⑥	<p>Saturday - The 1923 Portsmouth Harbour to Cardiff Central will finish its journey at Newport. An alternative rail connection, operated by Transport for Wales, will be available from Newport to Cardiff Central, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.</p>
⑧	<p>Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service each day - Buses will replace trains between Newbury and Bedwyn. The 2230 London Paddington to Bedwyn will start from Reading (and finish its journey at Newbury). An alternative rail connection will be available from London Paddington to Reading.</p> <p>Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will be slightly retimed and will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington.</p>
⑨	<p>Tuesday to Friday - The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. An alternative rail connection will be available from Frome to Westbury, departing slightly EARLIER than usual.</p>
⑪ ⑫ ⑬ ⑭	<p>Sunday to Friday - All week, trains between London Paddington and Oxford / North Cotswolds will run between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway, then between Oxford and Worcester / Great Malvern / Hereford. Replacement buses will run between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. On Monday to Friday, local stopping services between Didcot Parkway, Oxford and Banbury will be replaced by buses between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. A VERY limited service of direct trains will run between London Paddington / Reading and Worcester / Great Malvern / Hereford, diverted via Swindon and Cheltenham Spa. A few other trains will not run. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling, especially when travelling later in the day.</p>

20 37	Monday to Thursday - The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will depart EARLIER and will be diverted to run non-stop to, and finish its journey at, Gloucester. A replacement bus will run from Swindon to Cheltenham Spa, calling at stations via Stroud.
22	Monday to Thursday - The 0657 Bath Spa to Bristol Temple Meads will not run. The 0523 London Paddington to Swansea will call additionally at Oldfield Park and Keynsham and will finish its journey at Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers should use alternative services to continue their journey beyond Bristol Temple Meads.
24 25	Saturday - The 2030 Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour will finish its journey at Westbury. Passengers travelling beyond Westbury should use an alternative service.
26	Sunday - All day, buses will replace trains between Salisbury and Southampton Central. Romsey will only be served by replacement buses operated on behalf of SWR. The 1744 Swindon to Salisbury and the 1934 Bristol Temple Meads to Portsmouth Harbour will both finish their journeys at Westbury and the 1959 Salisbury to Bristol Temple Meads will start from Westbury. Passengers travelling beyond Westbury should use alternative earlier or later services.
32	Saturday - The 2353 Slough to Windsor & Eton Central will run 5 minutes later throughout. Sunday - The 0003 Windsor & Eton to Slough will run 4 minutes later throughout.
B	Saturday - The 0001 & 0049 London Paddington to Reading and the 0019 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
