

①	<p>Saturday - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will finish its journey at Ealing Broadway. Sunday - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start from Ealing Broadway. TfL Central line connections will be available to / from central London, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.</p> <p>Sunday - The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will run later throughout.</p>
① ② ③ ④ ①⑦ ②②	<p>Saturday - The 2333 London Paddington to Oxford will finish its journey at Reading. A replacement bus will run from Reading to Didcot Parkway and Oxford. The 2345 London Paddington to Reading will not run.</p> <p>Sunday - The 0754 Oxford to London Paddington and the 0818 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will both start from Reading. Replacement buses will run EARLIER from Oxford to Didcot Parkway and from Didcot Parkway to Reading. Then for the rest of the day, most High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be revised. Some trains will depart from London Paddington slightly EARLIER than usual. A few trains will not run. Some trains will call additionally at Didcot Parkway. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.</p> <p>Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service each day - The 2314 London Paddington to Oxford will run later throughout. Some trains towards London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later at London Paddington.</p>
① ② ③ ④ ⑤ ⑥ ⑦ ④⑨	<p>Sunday - All day, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will only run between London Paddington and Cardiff Central. Replacement buses will run non-stop between Cardiff Central and Swansea. Passengers travelling to / from Bridgend, Port Talbot Parkway and Neath should use alternative replacement buses operated on behalf of Transport for Wales, (apart from the first service towards London Paddington and the last service from London Paddington, where buses will be operated on behalf of GWR). Separate rail services will run between Swansea and Carmarthen. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling, especially when travelling later in the day.</p>
③ ④ ①⑦ ②②	<p>Saturday - The 1018 & 1518 Bristol Temple Meads to Oxford and the 1202 & 1712 Oxford to Bristol Temple Meads will not run. Passengers should use alternative services, changing en-route where necessary to complete their journeys.</p>
⑦	<p>Monday to Thursday - The 2048, 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run later from Bridgend to Swansea.</p>
⑨	<p>Tuesday to Friday - The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. An alternative rail connection will be available from Frome to Westbury, departing slightly EARLIER than usual.</p> <p>Wednesday and Thursday - The 2130 Cardiff Central to Frome and the 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will both finish their journeys at Westbury. Replacement buses will run from Westbury to Frome.</p>
①⑦ ①⑧ ①⑨ ③⑤	<p>Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between London Paddington and Oxford / North Cotswolds will run between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway, then between Oxford and Worcester / Great Malvern / Hereford. Replacement buses will run between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. On Saturday, local stopping services between Didcot Parkway, Oxford and Banbury will be replaced by buses between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. A few other trains will not run or will run EARLIER than usual. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling, especially when travelling later in the day.</p>
①⑦ ①⑧ ①⑨	<p>Monday to Thursday from approximately 2100 until end of service - Buses will replace trains between Moreton-in-Marsh and Worcester Shrub Hill. Some journeys will no longer be possible and passengers may need to travel EARLIER than usual to complete their journey. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.</p> <p>Tuesday to Friday - The 0355 Oxford to Reading will depart at 0346. Normal timings from Didcot Parkway onwards. The 0516 Worcester Shrub Hill to London Paddington will start from Moreton-in-Marsh. A replacement bus will run from Worcester Shrub Hill to Moreton-in-Marsh, departing EARLIER than usual.</p>
②④ ②④ ②⑤ ②⑥	<p>Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Warminster and Salisbury. A reduced service will also run between Westbury and Warminster. A few trains will not run at all. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.</p>

②⑧	Tuesday to Friday - The 0618 Yeovil Pen Mill to Filton Abbey Wood will start from Castle Cary. Passengers travelling from Yeovil Pen Mill should use the next available service.
③②	Saturday - The 2353 Slough to Windsor & Eton Central will run 5 minutes later throughout. Sunday - The 0003 Windsor & Eton to Slough will run 4 minutes later throughout.
③④	Tuesday to Friday - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.
④②	Monday to Thursday - The 2340 (Monday to Wednesday) Exeter St Davids to Exmouth and the 0019 (Tuesday to Thursday) Exmouth to Exeter St Davids will not run and will be replaced by buses.
⑤	Sunday - The 0650 Ealing Broadway to Reading will not call at Burnham. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham. Tuesday to Friday - The 0001 & 0049 London Paddington to Reading and the 0019 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham and Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
⑥	The following trains will not call at Pangbourne: Monday to Wednesday - 2236 & 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway; Tuesday to Thursday - 0346 Oxford to Reading (no replacement transport provided - passengers should use the next available service); Friday - 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway; Unless otherwise stated, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
