


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will finish its journey at Maidenhead. A replacement bus will run from Maidenhead to London Paddington. Separate buses will run from Slough to Taplow and Burnham, and from Burnham and Taplow to Slough, connecting out of / into the Maidenhead to London Paddington bus at Slough.

Sunday - The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will finish its journey at Maidenhead and the 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start from Maidenhead. No replacement transport will be provided - passengers should travel on the next available service.

- **12** Saturday The 2333 London Paddington to Oxford will arrive later than usual at Oxford.
- Sunday The 0754 Oxford to London Paddington will run later throughout.

 Sunday In connection with the Wales v France Rugby match at the Cardiff Principality Stadium, there will be some additional trains running between London Paddington / Swindon and Cardiff Central, and between Cardiff Central and Swansea / Llanelli. Some other trains, including some trains between London Paddington and Swindon / Bristol Parkway, will not run as a result. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
- Monday to Thursday The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will not call at Stapleton Road or Lawrence Hill. A replacement bus will run from Filton Abbey Wood to Bristol Temple Meads, calling at these two stations. In addition, on Monday and Tuesday, the train will also run slightly later from Patchway onwards.
 - **Sunday** The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Replacement buses will run from Swansea and from Neath, Port Talbot Parkway and Bridgend to Cardiff Central, to connect into the train.
 - (7) Monday to Thursday The 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will both finish their journeys at Neath. Replacement buses will run from Neath to Swansea.
 - Tuesday to Friday The 0338 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Neath. A replacement bus will run from Swansea to Neath, to connect into the train.
- Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service each day Buses will replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn.

 Tuesday to Friday The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington.
- Friday The 1736 & 1836 London Paddington to Plymouth will both finish their journeys at Taunton. Passengers should use alternative services to travel to stations beyond Taunton. The 1803 & 1903 London Paddington to Penzance will both finish their journeys at Plymouth. Passengers should use alternative services to travel to stations beyond Plymouth.
- Monday to Thursday from approximately 2100 until end of service Buses will replace trains between Moreton-in-Marsh and Worcester Shrub Hill. Some journeys will no longer be possible and passengers may need to travel EARLIER than usual to complete their journey. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
 - **Tuesday to Friday** The 0516 Worcester Shrub Hill to London Paddington will start from Moreton-in-Marsh. A replacement bus will run from Worcester Shrub Hill to Moreton-in-Marsh, departing EARLIER than usual.
- 21 22 Sunday The 1749 Cardiff Central to Westbury will finish its journey at Bristol Temple Meads. An additional train will run at 1841 from Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury. No connection between the two trains.
 - **Sunday** All day, trains between Cardiff Central / Bristol Temple Meads and Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted between Romsey and Fareham, not calling at Southampton Central, but calling additionally at Chandlers Ford and Eastleigh. Passengers travelling to / from Southampton Central should use SWR rail services to / from Eastleigh to connect with diverted trains. The 1934 Bristol Temple Meads to Portsmouth Harbour will not run.

Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Exeter St Davids, Exeter Central and Exmouth.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:

Saturday - 0049 London Paddington to Reading;

Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading;

In both cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: Sunday - 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2352 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.
