


# Summary of timetable changes

**Saturday** - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will finish its journey at Ealing Broadway. TfL Central line connections will be available to central London, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.

**Sunday** - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will not run. Passengers should travel on a later service. The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will run later throughout.

Sunday - All day, most High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings. Some trains will depart a few minutes EARLIER from London Paddington. Local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway are subject to minor retimings.

Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.

Saturday to Friday - All week, trains between London Paddington / Reading and the West Country will be revised. Trains will only run between London Paddington / Reading and Newton Abbot / Totnes. Replacement buses will run non-stop between Tiverton Parkway and Plymouth, and between Totnes, Ivybridge and Plymouth. A few early morning or late evening services will also be replaced by buses between Exeter St Davids / Newton Abbot and Totnes / Plymouth. Trains will run between Plymouth and Penzance. Direct trains between London Paddington and Paignton will not run. The Night Riviera Sleeper service will not run. Some other trains will not run, and others will make additional stops in place of trains that no longer run.

Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling, especially when travelling later in the day.

**Sunday** -The 0806 Reading to Newbury will not run and the 0833 Reading to Bedwyn will start from Newbury and run slightly later than usual. A replacement bus will run EARLIER from Reading at 0751 to Newbury. The 0804 (departing 0757) London Paddington to Penzance (finishing its journey at Totnes) will not call at Newbury or Pewsey. The 0844 (departing 0830) London Paddington to Penzance (finishing its journey at Totnes) will call additionally at Newbury and Pewsey. **Monday to Thursday** -The 2230 London Paddington to Bedwyn will start from Reading and be slightly retimed. An alternative rail connection will be available from London Paddington to Reading.

**Tuesday to Friday** - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will be slightly retimed and will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington.

**Monday to Thursday** - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury and the 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will both finish their journeys at Bath Spa. Replacement buses will run from Bath Spa to Westbury and Frome. The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Temple Meads will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Bath Spa, with a connecting rail service from Bath Spa to Bristol Temple Meads.

Monday to Thursday - The 2153 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill will call additionally at Didcot Parkway and will then be diverted to run non-stop to Worcester Shrub Hill. A connecting rail service will be available from Didcot Parkway to Oxford. Passengers travelling to stations beyond Oxford should travel EARLIER on the 2123 from London Paddington to Oxford, from where a replacement bus will run to Worcester Shrub Hill. The 2251 London Paddington to Worcestershire Parkway will finish its journey at Oxford. A replacement bus will run from Oxford to Worcestershire Parkway. The 2200 Hereford to London Paddington will finish its journey at Worcester Shrub Hill (and restart at 0010 from Oxford). A replacement bus will run from Worcester Shrub Hill to Oxford. Stops at Kingham, Charlbury and Hanborough will be to drop passengers off only. There will also be no onward connection to stations beyond Oxford.

Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between Cardiff Central / Bristol Temple Meads and Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted between Romsey and Fareham, not calling at Southampton Central, but calling additionally at Chandlers Ford and Eastleigh. Replacement buses will run between Southampton Central and Eastleigh to connect with diverted trains. On Saturday, a few other trains will be retimed or will only run for part of their journey. On Sunday, the 1934 Bristol Temple Meads to Portsmouth Harbour will not run. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.

29 (finishing its journey at Guildford) will start from Redhill. A replacement bus will run EARLIER from Gatwick Airport to Redhill.

**Sunday** -The 0837 Reading to Basingstoke will not run. A replacement bus will run instead, departing Reading EARLIER at 0807. This bus will not call at Reading West, and passengers travelling to / from Reading West should use alternative services running between Reading and Newbury.

- Sunday The 0007 Marlow to Maidenhead will finish its journey at Bourne End. A replacement bus will run from Bourne End to Maidenhead.

  Sunday from approximately 1000 until end of service, all trains between Maidenhead, Bourne End and Marlow will run up to 7 minutes later than normal, to maintain connections with retimed services between London Paddington, Maidenhead and Reading.
- Tuesday to Thursday The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.
- Monday to Thursday The 2231 (departing 2240) Didcot Parkway to Banbury will finish its journey at Oxford. The 2334 Banbury to Oxford will not run. Replacement buses will run between Oxford and Banbury.
- Saturday The 1030 London Paddington to Exeter St Davids will finish its journey at Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers should use the next available service to travel to Exeter St Davids.
- Saturday and Monday to Friday All week, buses will replace trains between Liskeard and Looe. For details of alternative stopping points, please refer to local publicity. Coombe Junction Halt will not be served. Passengers travelling to or from this station should contact station staff at Liskeard or use the station Help Point at Coombe Junction Halt, to arrange alternative transport.

#### The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:

Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to Ealing Broadway;

Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading:

Tuesday to Thursday - 0001 & 0049 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington;

Friday - 0049 London Paddington to Reading;

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

**The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: Sunday** - 0638 Reading to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

#### The following trains will not call at Pangbourne:

P Sunday - 0738, 2233 & 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 0818 & 2352 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington; Friday - 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway;

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
