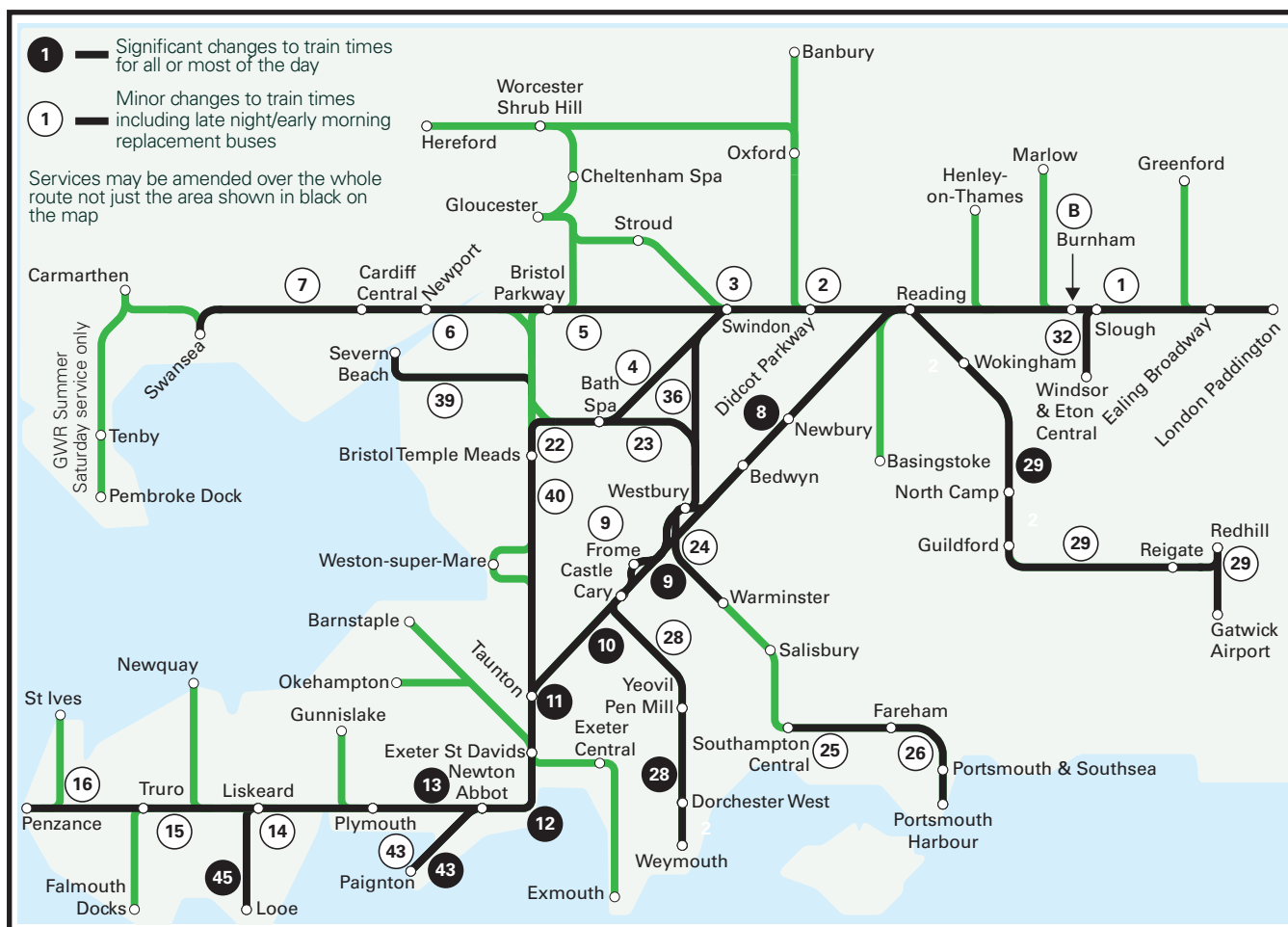

①	<p><b>Saturday from approximately 2145 until end of service</b> - Some trains from London Paddington will depart a few minutes EARLIER than usual. The 2158 Oxford to London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER from Reading and will not call at Twyford, Maidenhead or Slough. The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will finish its journey at Ealing Broadway. TfL Central line connections will be available to central London, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.</p> <p><b>Sunday</b> - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start from Ealing Broadway and run slightly later to Reading. TfL Central line connections will be available from central London, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will run later throughout.</p> <p><b>Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service</b> - Some trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings.</p>
① ②	<p><b>Sunday</b> - All day, most High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be subject to retimings. Most trains will depart EARLIER from London Paddington. Most trains between London Paddington and Oxford will not call at Slough. Most local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will only run between Reading and Didcot Parkway. Slough, Burnham and Taplow will be served by additional stops in other services.</p> <p><b>Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.</b></p>
① ⑧ ⑨ ⑩ ⑪ ⑫ ⑬ ⑭ ⑮ ⑯ ④③ ④③	<p><b>Saturday and Sunday</b> - All weekend, trains between London Paddington / Reading and the West Country will be revised. Trains will only run between London Paddington / Reading and Exeter St Davids. Trains between Exmouth / Exeter St Davids and Paignton will only run between Exmouth and Exeter St Davids / Teignmouth. Replacement buses will run non-stop between Tiverton Parkway and Plymouth, Exeter St Davids, Newton Abbot, Totnes and Plymouth, between Totnes, Ivybridge and Plymouth and between Teignmouth and Newton Abbot. Trains will run between Newton Abbot and Paignton and between Plymouth and Penzance. <b>On Sunday</b>, the Night Riviera Sleeper service will not run. Some other trains will not run, and others will make additional stops in place of trains that no longer run.</p> <p><b>Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling, especially when travelling later in the day.</b></p> <p><b>Monday to Friday</b> - All week, trains between London Paddington / Reading and the West Country will be revised. Trains will only run between London Paddington / Reading and Newton Abbot / Totnes. Replacement buses will run non-stop between Tiverton Parkway and Plymouth, and between Totnes, Ivybridge and Plymouth. A few early morning or late evening services will also be replaced by buses between Exeter St Davids / Newton Abbot and Totnes / Plymouth. Trains will run between Plymouth and Penzance. Direct trains between London Paddington and Paignton will not run. The Night Riviera Sleeper service will not run. Some other trains will not run, and others will make additional stops in place of trains that no longer run.</p> <p><b>Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling, especially when travelling later in the day.</b></p>
② ③ ④ ②②	<p><b>Sunday</b> - The 2333 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading, not calling at Didcot Parkway, Swindon or Chippenham. A replacement bus will run from Reading to Swindon and Chippenham. Passengers travelling to Didcot Parkway should change at Reading for an alternative local connecting service.</p> <p><b>Monday to Thursday</b> - The 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading, not calling at Didcot Parkway, Swindon or Chippenham. Passengers for these stations should travel on the 2314 (departing 2316 on Monday to Wednesday) to Oxford which will call additionally at Didcot Parkway. A replacement bus will connect out of this train, running to Swindon and Chippenham. Passengers travelling from Didcot Parkway, Swindon and Chippenham to Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads should travel on an EARLIER service.</p>
⑤ ⑥ ⑦	<p><b>Monday to Thursday</b> - The 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Swindon to call additionally at Chippenham and Bath Spa, and will run later from Bristol Parkway to Swansea.</p>
⑦	<p><b>Monday to Thursday</b> - The 2048, 2148 &amp; 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run later from Bridgend to Swansea.</p>
⑨ ②② ②③	<p><b>Saturday</b> - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will both finish their journeys at Westbury. Replacement buses will run from Westbury to Frome.</p> <p><b>Sunday</b> - The 0839 Westbury to Bristol Temple Meads will not run. Passengers should travel on a later service. The 0922 Frome to Cardiff Central will run later from Frome to Bristol Temple Meads. The 0908 Bristol Temple Meads to Weymouth will finish its journey at Westbury. An alternative rail connection, running later than usual, will be available from Westbury to Castle Cary.</p>

24 36	<b>Sunday</b> - The 0806 Warminster to Swindon will be replaced by a bus from Warminster to Chippenham and the 0908 Swindon to Westbury will be replaced by a bus from Chippenham to Westbury. Alternative rail connections will be available at Chippenham to / from Swindon. The 1332 Swindon to Weymouth (finishing its journey at Yeovil Pen Mill) will run EARLIER throughout.
25 26	<b>Saturday</b> - The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Westbury will not call at Eastleigh or Southampton Airport Parkway. <b>Sunday</b> - The 1934 Bristol Temple Meads to Portsmouth Harbour will not call at Southampton Airport Parkway, Eastleigh, Botley or Hedge End and will run EARLIER from Fareham to Portsmouth Harbour. Passengers should use alternative services, operated by SWR, to travel to / from these stations.
28 23	<b>Saturday to Friday</b> - All week, buses will replace trains between Yeovil Pen Mill, Dorchester West and Weymouth. In addition, <b>on Saturday</b> , the 1608 Gloucester to Weymouth will finish its journey at Castle Cary. No replacement transport beyond Castle Cary. <b>On Sunday</b> , the 0900 Westbury to Weymouth will not run. Passengers from Westbury travel on 0922 to Castle Cary, for replacement buses from Castle Cary to Weymouth. No replacement transport from Frome or Bruton. The 1332 Swindon to Weymouth (finishing its journey at Yeovil Pen Mill) will run EARLIER throughout. <b>Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling, especially when travelling later in the day.</b>
29 29	<b>Sunday</b> - All day, buses will replace trains between Reading and Guildford. 2216 Reading to Guildford will not run.
32	<b>Saturday</b> - The 2353 Slough to Windsor & Eton Central will run 5 minutes later throughout. <b>Sunday</b> - The 0003 Windsor & Eton to Slough will run 4 minutes later throughout.
39	<b>Sunday until approximately 1600</b> - Buses will replace trains between Avonmouth and Severn Beach. Passengers travelling from Severn Beach and St Andrews Road will need to depart EARLIER to maintain connections into trains at Avonmouth.
40	<b>Saturday</b> - The 1030 London Paddington to Exeter St Davids will finish its journey at Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers should use the next available service to travel to Exeter St Davids.
45	<b>Saturday and Monday to Friday</b> - All week, buses will replace trains between Liskeard and Looe. For details of alternative stopping points, please refer to local publicity. Coombe Junction Halt will not be served. Passengers travelling to or from this station should contact station staff at Liskeard or use the station Help Point at Coombe Junction Halt, to arrange alternative transport.
B	<b>Saturday</b> - The 0001 & 0049 London Paddington to Reading and the 0021 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
