① **Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service** - Some trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings.

③ **Friday** - The 1203 London Paddington to Penzance and the 1549 Plymouth to London Paddington will run additionally. The 1205 London Paddington to Penzance will finish its journey at Plymouth. Please check online journey planners for specific stopping patterns and timings of these services.

③ ⑰ **Saturday** - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, the 1018 & 1518 Bristol Temple Meads to Oxford and the 1202 & 1702 Oxford to Bristol Temple Meads will not run. Passengers should use alternative services, changing en-route where necessary, to complete their journeys.

④ ⑳ **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads will be completely revised. Some trains will run between London Paddington and Bath Spa, diverted between Swindon and Bath Spa to run via, and call at, Bristol Temple Meads. Other trains will only run between London Paddington / Swindon and Chippenham (**on Saturday**) and between Swindon and Chippenham (**on Sunday**). A few other trains will also not run. Replacement buses will run between Chippenham and Bath Spa, with a few early morning / late evening buses also running between Swindon and Chippenham. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

⑦ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Swindon and will run later from Bristol Parkway to Bridgend. Normal timings from Port Talbot Parkway onwards.

⑧ **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service each day** - Buses will replace trains between Newbury and Bedwyn. The 2230 London Paddington to Bedwyn will start from Reading (and finish its journey at Newbury). An alternative rail connection will be available from London Paddington to Reading.

⑧ **Tuesday to Friday** - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will be slightly retimed and will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington.

⑨ **Tuesday to Thursday** - The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. An alternative rail connection will be available from Frome to Westbury, departing slightly EARLIER than usual.

⑪ ④⑩ **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, most direct trains between London Paddington and Weston-super-Mare / Taunton / Exeter St Davids (via Bristol Temple Meads) will not run. **On Saturday**, the 1345 Exeter St Davids to London Paddington will start from Taunton and the 2008 Weston-super-Mare to Bristol Temple Meads will not run. **On Sunday**, the 2105 Weston-super-Mare to Bristol Temple Meads will not run. Passengers should use other scheduled rail services between Bristol Temple Meads and Weston-super-Mare / Taunton / Exeter St Davids to complete their journeys.

⑳ ⑳ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will depart EARLIER and will be diverted to run non-stop to, and finish its journey at, Gloucester. A replacement bus will run from Swindon to Cheltenham Spa, calling at stations via Stroud.

㉖ **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Bath Spa and Westbury. Freshford and Avoncliff will only be served by separate buses running between Bath Spa and Bradford-on-Avon. A revised service will run between Bristol Temple Meads and Bath Spa. A few other trains will also either not run or will only run for part of their journey, and other trains will make additional stops as a result.

Sunday - The 0610 Reading to Gatwick Airport will start from Guildford. A replacement bus will run EARLIER from Reading to Guildford. Some trains FROM Reading to Gatwick Airport will be slightly retimed from Reading to Guildford. Some trains between Reading and Gatwick Airport will only run between Reading and Redhill. Alternative rail connections will be available between Redhill and Gatwick Airport, operated by Southern /Thamesink, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.

Saturday - All day, some trains FROM Reading to Basingstoke will run slightly EARLIER than usual.

Sunday - All day, buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke. Reading West will only be served by scheduled services between Reading and Newbury / Bedwyn.

Saturday - All day, some trains between Westbury and Swindon will be retimed, in some cases EARLIER than usual.

Sunday until approximately 1130 - Buses will replace trains Westbury and Chippenham / Swindon, and will, in some cases, run EARLIER than normal.

Saturday - The 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and the 0021 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
