

| ①                    | <p><b>Saturday</b> - The 2333 London Paddington to Oxford (finishing its journey at Didcot Parkway) and 2345 London Paddington to Reading will both depart slightly EARLIER than usual. The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will finish its journey at Ealing Broadway. TfL Central line connections will be available to central London, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.</p> <p><b>Sunday until approximately 0900</b> - A few High Speed services from London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual. The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will not run. Passengers should travel on the next available service. The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will run later throughout.</p> <p><b>Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service</b> - Some trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings.</p>  |
| ① ②<br>①⑦            | <p><b>Saturday from approximately 2230 until end of service</b> - Trains between London Paddington / Didcot Parkway and Oxford will be replaced by buses between Oxford and Didcot Parkway.</p> <p><b>Sunday</b> - The 0754 Oxford to London Paddington will start from Didcot Parkway. Passengers from Oxford should travel on the next available service.</p> <p><b>Tuesday to Friday</b> - The 0355 Oxford to Reading will depart EARLIER from Oxford. Normal timings from Didcot Parkway onwards.</p>  |
| ③ ①⑦                 | <p><b>Saturday</b> - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, the 1018 &amp; 1518 Bristol Temple Meads to Oxford and the 1202 &amp; 1702 Oxford to Bristol Temple Meads will not run. Passengers should use alternative services, changing en-route where necessary, to complete their journeys.</p>   |
| ④ ②②                 | <p><b>Saturday to Monday</b> - All day on all 3 days, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads will be revised. Some trains will run between London Paddington and Bath Spa, diverted between Swindon and Bath Spa to run via, and call at, Bristol Temple Meads. Other trains will only run between London Paddington / Swindon and Chippenham (<b>on Saturday and Monday</b>) and between Swindon and Chippenham (<b>on Sunday</b>). A few other trains will not run. Replacement buses will run between Chippenham and Bath Spa, with a few early morning / late evening buses also running between Swindon and Chippenham. <b>Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.</b></p>  |
| ⑦                    | <p><b>Sunday</b> - The 2045 &amp; 2145 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run later from Bridgend to Swansea.</p>  |
| ⑨                    | <p><b>Monday to Thursday</b> - The 2048, 2148 &amp; 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run later from Bridgend to Swansea.</p> <p><b>Tuesday to Friday</b> - The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. An alternative rail connection will be available from Frome to Westbury, departing slightly EARLIER than usual.</p> <p><b>Wednesday and Thursday</b> - The 2130 Cardiff Central (2225 Bristol Temple Meads) to Frome and the 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will both finish their journeys at Westbury. Replacement buses will run from Westbury to Frome.</p>  |
| ①① ④⑩                | <p><b>Saturday to Monday</b> - All day on all 3 days, due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, most direct trains between London Paddington and Weston-super-Mare / Taunton / Exeter St Davids (via Bristol Temple Meads) will not run. <b>On Saturday</b>, the 1345 Exeter St Davids to London Paddington will start from Taunton and the 2008 Weston-super-Mare to Bristol Temple Meads will not run. <b>On Sunday</b>, the 2105 Weston-super-Mare to Bristol Temple Meads will not run. <b>On Monday</b>, the 0610 Bristol Temple Meads to Weston-super-Mare and the 2110 &amp; 2210 Weston-super-Mare to Bristol Temple Meads will not run. The 1851 Paignton to Cardiff Central and the 2024 Exmouth to Cardiff Central will call additionally at Parson Street and Bedminster. Passengers should use other scheduled rail services between Bristol Temple Meads and Weston-super-Mare / Taunton / Exeter St Davids to complete their journeys.</p> |
| ②② ②③<br>②④ ②⑤<br>②⑥ | <p><b>Saturday to Monday</b> - All day on all 3 days, buses will replace trains between Bath Spa and Westbury. Freshford and Avoncliff will be served by a separate bus service between Bath Spa and Bradford-on-Avon only. A revised service will run between Bristol Temple Meads and Bath Spa. A few other trains will also either not run or will only run for part of their journey, and other trains will make additional stops as a result. <b>Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.</b></p>   |
| ②⑧                   | <p><b>Tuesday to Friday</b> - The 0618 Yeovil Pen Mill to Filton Abbey Wood will start from Castle Cary. Passengers travelling from Yeovil Pen Mill should use the next available service.</p>   |
| ③②                   | <p><b>Saturday</b> - The 2353 Slough to Windsor &amp; Eton Central will run 3 minutes later throughout.</p> <p><b>Sunday</b> - The 0003 Windsor &amp; Eton to Slough will run 2 minutes later throughout.</p>  |
| ③③                   | <p><b>Monday</b> - All day, a revised hourly service will run between Maidenhead, Bourne End and Marlow.</p>   |

③④ **Tuesday to Friday** - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.

③⑥ **Saturday and Monday** - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, some trains between Westbury and Swindon will be retimed, in some cases EARLIER than usual.

④② **Tuesday to Friday** - The 2340 (**Tuesday to Thursday**) Exeter St Davids to Exmouth and the 0019 (**Wednesday to Friday**) Exmouth to Exeter St Davids will not run and will be replaced by buses. Journey times will be extended.

***The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:***

**Saturday** - 2345 Didcot Parkway to Ealing Broadway;

**Sunday** - 0034 London Paddington to Reading;

Ⓑ **Tuesday to Friday** - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington;  
In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

***The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: Sunday*** - 0640 & 0742 Reading to London Paddington and 2352 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington.  
Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

***The following trains will not call at Pangbourne:***

**Monday to Thursday** - 2236 & 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2326 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

Ⓟ **Tuesday to Friday** - 0346 Oxford to Reading (no replacement transport provided - passengers should use the next available service);

**Friday** - 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway;

In all cases, unless otherwise stated, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
