**Saturday** - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will finish its journey at Ealing Broadway. **Sunday** - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start from Ealing Broadway and will run slightly later throughout. TfL Central line connections will be available to / from central London, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.

**Sunday until approximately 0900** - A few trains from London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual. The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will run later throughout.

**Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service** - Some trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings.

**Saturday** - The 2333 London Paddington to Oxford will run slightly later from Slough onwards.

**Sunday** - All day, trains between London Paddington / Reading and the West of England will be reduced in frequency, and will be diverted, either between Reading and Westbury, or between Reading and Taunton. No trains will call at Newbury, Hungerford or Pewsey. Some trains will call additionally at Swindon and there will be changes to trains calling at Westbury and Castle Cary. Most trains FROM London Paddington and Reading will depart EARLIER than usual. Replacement buses will run between Reading and Newbury and between Pewsey and Swindon (connecting with diverted trains calling additionally at Swindon). A revised train service will run between Newbury and Bedwyn. Some trains will not run at all, including all trains between London Paddington and Paignton.

**Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

**Monday to Thursday** - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will not call at Stapleton Road or Lawrence Hill. A replacement bus will run from Filton Abbey Wood to Bristol Temple Meads, serving these two stations. In addition, **on Monday and Tuesday**, the train will run a few minutes later from Severn Tunnel Junction onwards.

**Sunday** - The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Replacement buses will run from Swansea and from Neath, Port Talbot Parkway and Bridgend to Cardiff Central, to connect into the train.

**Monday to Thursday** - The 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will both finish their journeys at Neath. Replacement buses will run from Neath to Swansea.

**Tuesday to Friday** - The 0338 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Neath and run slightly later as far as Cardiff Central. A replacement bus will run from Swansea to Neath.

**Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service each day** - Buses will replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn.

**Tuesday to Friday** - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will be slightly retimed and will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington.

**Monday to Friday** - The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. An alternative rail connection will be available from Frome to Westbury, departing slightly EARLIER than usual.

**Sunday** - Some trains FROM Reading to Gatwick Airport will be slightly retimed from Reading to Guildford.

**Saturday** - All day, some trains FROM Reading to Basingstoke will run slightly EARLIER than usual.

**Sunday** - All day, buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke. Reading West will only be served by scheduled services between Reading and Newbury / Bedwyn.

**Saturday** - The 2353 Slough to Windsor & Eton Central will run 5 minutes later throughout.

**Sunday** - The 0003 Windsor & Eton to Slough will run 4 minutes later throughout.

**Sunday** - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, some trains between Westbury and Swindon before approximately 1430 will be retimed, in some cases EARLIER than usual. Additional, non-stop trains will also run between Westbury and Swindon.
