


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday to Friday - All week, due to the closure of the Severn Tunnel, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be reduced in frequency and will be diverted between Swindon and Newport, no longer calling at Bristol Parkway, but calling additionally at Gloucester. Most trains from London Paddington, Reading and Swindon towards South Wales will depart much EARLIER than usual. Some direct trains between London Paddington and Bristol Parkway will continue to run, otherwise passengers should travel via Bristol Temple Meads. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway and Newport. Some other trains between London Paddington, Reading, Didcot Parkway and Swindon will also be retimed. A few other trains will either not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling, especially when travelling later in the day, to ensure that their journey is still possible.**

Saturday from approximately 2230 until end of service - Trains between London Paddington / Didcot Parkway and Oxford will be replaced by buses between Oxford and Didcot Parkway.

Sunday - The 0753 Oxford to London Paddington will start from Didcot Parkway. Passengers from Oxford should travel on the next available service.

Sunday - All day, most trains from London Paddington to Oxford will be slightly retimed and will run a few minutes later than usual.

Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service - Some trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings.

Saturday to Friday - All week, due to the closure of the Severn Tunnel and consequent alterations to services between London Paddington and South Wales, some trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) will be retimed. **On Sunday**, some trains will not run.

Saturday to Friday - All week, due to the closure of the Severn Tunnel, trains between Cardiff Central and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) will either not run between Cardiff Central and Bristol Temple Meads, or will be diverted to start and finish at Bristol Parkway. **On Saturday and Monday to Friday**, local stopping services between Filton Abbey Wood and Bristol Temple Meads will not run. Some other trains will call additionally at Ashley Down, and, **on Saturday and Monday to Friday only**, at Stapleton Road and Lawrence Hill. Replacement buses will run between Newport and Bristol Parkway, with some calling at Severn Tunnel Junction and Patchway. **On Saturday only**, a limited taxi service will run between Pilning and Bristol Parkway. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling, especially when travelling later in the day, to ensure that their journey is still possible.**

Saturday until approximately 0700 - Buses will replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn.

Sunday - The 2323 Newbury to Reading will not run and will be replaced by a bus.

Monday to Thursday - The 2230 London Paddington to Bedwyn will start from Reading and will be slightly retimed. An alternative rail connection will be available from London Paddington to Reading.

Monday to Friday - The 0703, 0805, 0906, 1305 & 1406 London Paddington to Newbury will all run slightly later than usual.

Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will be slightly retimed and will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington.

Monday to Thursday - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury and the 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will both finish their journeys at Bath Spa. Replacement buses will run from Bath Spa to Westbury and Frome. The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Temple Meads will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Bath Spa, with a connecting rail service from Bath Spa to Bristol Temple Meads.

Monday to Friday - The 0705 London Paddington (0805 Swindon) to Swansea will call additionally at Stroud, to drop off passengers only. The 0635 Salisbury (0754 Swindon) to Worcester Foregate Street will depart Swindon at 0811 and run later as far as Worcester Shrub Hill.

Monday and Tuesday - The 2131 London Paddington to Cheltenham Spa and the 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will both finish their journeys at Gloucester. Replacement buses will run from Gloucester to Cheltenham Spa.

Saturday - The 0540 Portsmouth & Southsea to Bristol Temple Meads will start from Southampton Central and the 0608 Portsmouth Harbour to Cardiff Central (diverted to Bristol Parkway) will start from Fareham. Passengers should either travel later, or should use alternative SWR rail services, changing en-route where necessary, to complete their journey. Valid GWR tickets will be accepted on these services.

Saturday - Trains will be reduced to an hourly frequency and will run between Blackwater and Redhill / Gatwick Airport only. Replacement buses will run between Reading and North Camp. Passengers should interchange between buses and trains at North Camp.

Sunday - Trains will be reduced to an hourly frequency and will run between Guildford and Redhill / Gatwick Airport only. Replacement buses will run between Reading and Guildford.

30

Monday to Friday - The 0738 Reading to Basingstoke will run 4 minutes EARLIER from Reading to Reading Green Park.

34

Tuesday to Thursday - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.

37 38

Sunday - Some trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Gloucester / Worcester Foregate Street will be subject to minor retimings.

39

Saturday - The 1412 Bristol Temple Meads to Avonmouth will not run and the 1446 Avonmouth to Weston-super-Mare will start from Bristol Temple Meads. The 1501 Severn Beach to Bristol Temple Meads will run EARLIER from Severn Beach to Avonmouth. Some other trains will be retimed by a few minutes.

Monday to Wednesday - The 2054 Exmouth (2129 Exeter St Davids) to Barnstaple will finish its journey at Crediton. A replacement bus will run from Crediton to Barnstaple and a separate taxi service from Crediton to Yeoford. The 2241 Barnstaple to Exeter St Davids will not run. A replacement bus will run from Barnstaple to Exeter St Davids. Yeoford will be served by a separate taxi service to / from Crediton.

49

Sunday - The 0931 London Paddington to Carmarthen will finish its journey at Swansea and the 1415 Carmarthen to London Paddington will start from Swansea. Passengers should travel on alternative earlier or later Transport for Wales services.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:

Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading;

Tuesday to Friday - 0001 & 0048 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington;

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: Sunday - 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0631 & 0742 Reading to London Paddington, 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2352 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

The following trains will not call at Pangbourne:

Monday to Wednesday - 2236 & 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2326 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

Tuesday to Thursday - 0355 Oxford to Reading (no replacement transport provided - passengers should use the next available service);

Friday - 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway;

In all cases, unless otherwise stated, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
