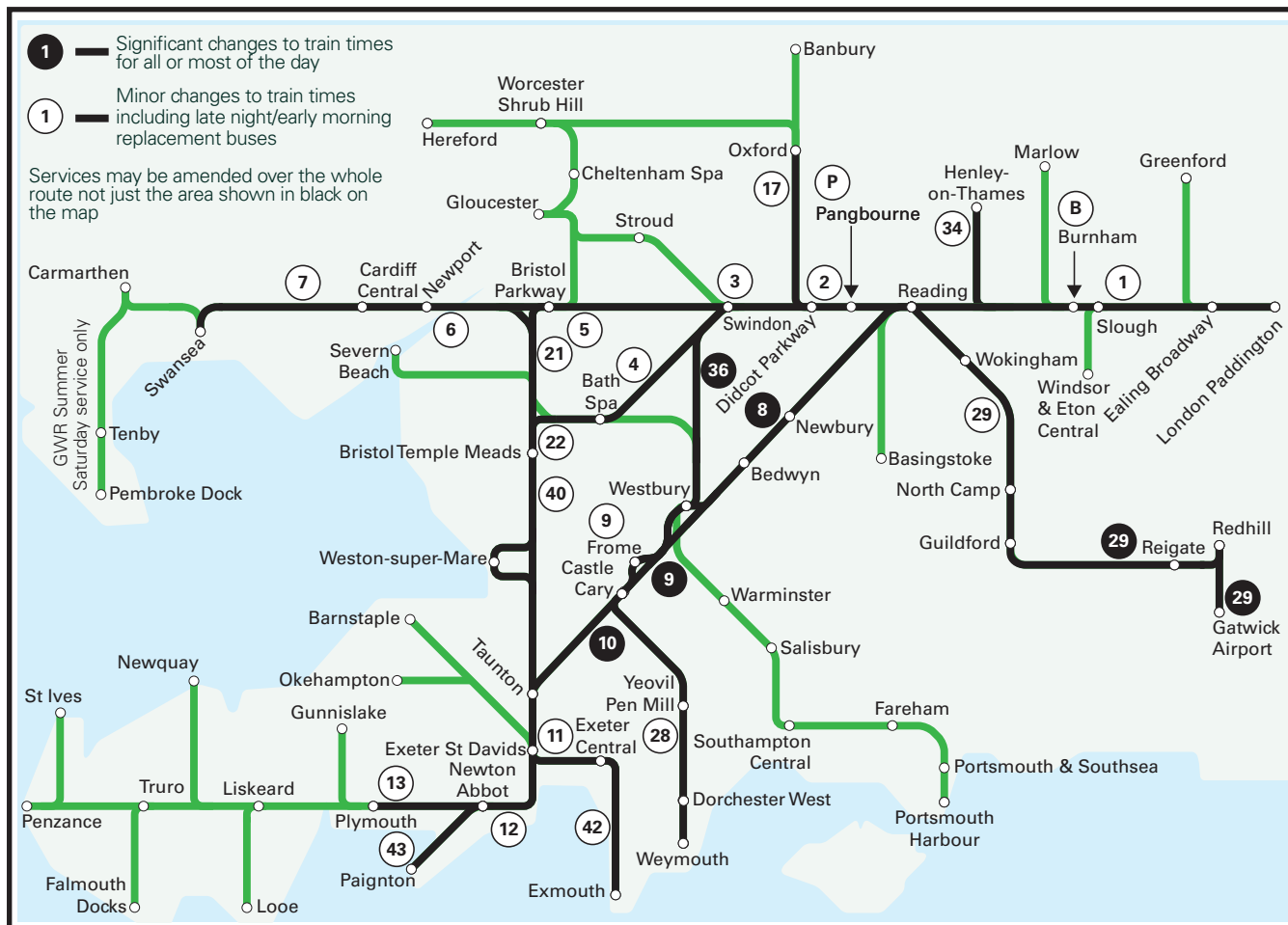


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between London Paddington and the West Country will be reduced in frequency and will be diverted either between Reading and Taunton (via Bristol Temple Meads) or between Reading and Westbury (via Swindon). Most trains from London Paddington and Reading will depart much EARLIER than usual. Trains will not call at Newbury, Hungerford or Pewsey, and a revised service will call at Westbury and Castle Cary. Some trains will not run at all (including all trains between London Paddington and Paignton), or will only run for part of their journey. Replacement buses will run between Pewsey and Swindon, connecting with diverted trains at Swindon.

In addition, trains between London Paddington / Reading and Newbury / Bedwyn will not run, and will be replaced by buses between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn.

Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling, especially when travelling later in the day, to ensure that their journey is still possible.

Sunday until approximately 1145 - Trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be replaced by buses between Bristol Parkway and Newport. In some cases, passengers will need to travel EARLIER to maintain connections.

Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, some trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) will be retimed. A few trains will not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey.

Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.

Saturday - The 1923 Portsmouth Harbour to Cardiff Central will finish its journey at Newport. An alternative rail connection, operated by Transport for Wales, will be available from Newport to Cardiff Central, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.

Sunday until approximately 1145 - Trains between Cardiff Central and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) will either not run between Cardiff Central and Bristol Temple Meads or will be diverted to start from / finish at Bristol Parkway. Replacement buses will run between Newport and Bristol Parkway. Alternative rail connections will be available between Cardiff Central and Newport.

Monday and Thursday - The 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will both finish their journeys at Port Talbot Parkway. Replacement buses will run from Port Talbot Parkway to Neath and Swansea.

Tuesday and Friday - The 0338 Swansa to London Paddington will start from Port Talbot Parkway. A replacement bus will run EARLIER from Swansea and Neath to connect into the train at Port Talbot Parkway.

Tuesday to Friday - The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. An EARLIER connecting rail service will run from Frome to Westbury. The 0618 Yeovil Pen Mill to Filton Abbey Wood will start from Castle Cary. Passengers from Yeovil Pen Mill should travel on the next available service.

Sunday - The 2350 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive later at Exeter St Davids. The 2115 Penzance to London Paddington will depart EARLIER from Exeter St Davids.

Friday - The 2145 Penzance to London Paddington will not call at Taunton. Passengers travelling to / from Taunton should use an alternative earlier service.

Tuesday to Friday - The 0355 Oxford to Reading will depart slightly EARLIER from Oxford. Normal timings from Didcot Parkway onwards.

Sunday - All day, buses will replace trains between Guildford and Redhill / Gatwick Airport. A few trains between Reading and Guildford will either be retimed or will not run at all.

Tuesday to Thursday - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.

Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, some stopping trains between Westbury and Swindon will be retimed, in some cases, EARLIER than usual. Additional non-stop trains will also run between Westbury and Swindon in both directions. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

- ④② **Tuesday to Friday** - The 2340 (**Tuesday to Thursday**) Exeter St Davids to Exmouth and the 0019 (**Wednesday to Friday**) Exmouth to Exeter St Davids will not run and will be replaced by buses.

- ④③ **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, direct trains between London Paddington and Paignton will not run. Passengers should use alternative services, changing en-route where necessary, to complete their journey.
Sunday - The 1440 & 1640 Paignton to Exmouth will depart at 1445 & 1645 respectively and will run later as far as Dawlish Warren.

- The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:***
④B **Tuesday to Thursday** - 0001 & 0048 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington;
Friday - 0048 London Paddington to Reading;
In both cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

- ④P **Friday** - The 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
