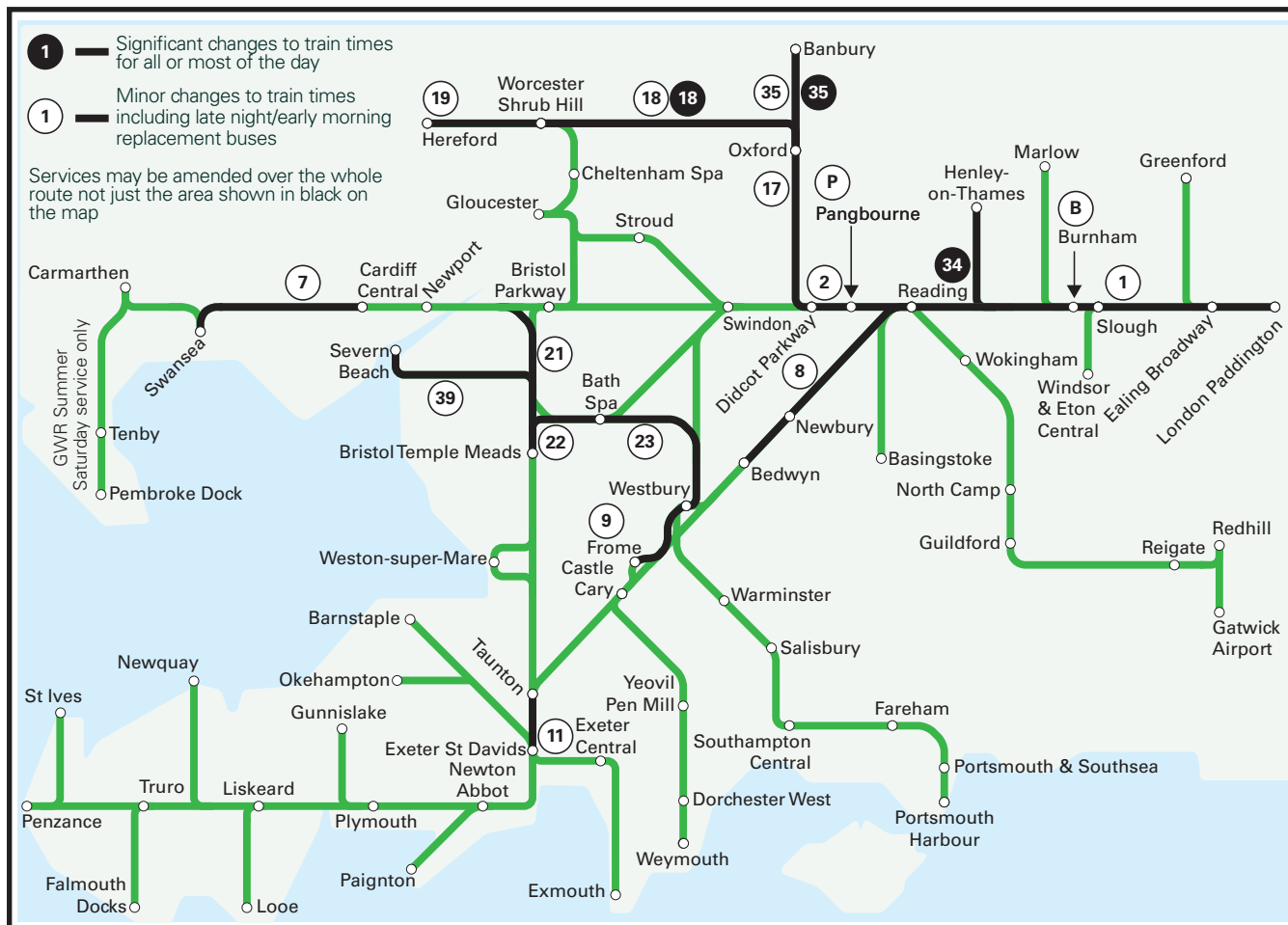


Summary of timetable changes

- ① **Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service** - Some trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings.
-
- ① ② **Saturday from approximately 2245 until end of service** - Buses will replace trains between Didcot Parkway and Oxford.
⑱ **Sunday** - The 0753 Oxford to London Paddington will start from Didcot Parkway. Passengers travelling from Oxford should use the next available service. Some trains from London Paddington to Oxford will arrive at Oxford up to 5 minutes later than usual.

- ⑦ **Sunday** - The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Replacement buses will run from Swansea, and from Neath, Port Talbot Parkway and Bridgend, to Cardiff Central to connect into the train.
Monday to Thursday - The 2048 & 2148 (**Monday and Thursday only**) and the 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will all run later beyond Cardiff Central.

- ⑧ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2230 London Paddington to Bedwyn will start from Reading and will be slightly retimed. An alternative rail connection will be available from London Paddington to Reading.
Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will be slightly retimed and will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington.

- ⑨ ⑳ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury and the 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will both finish their journeys at Bath Spa. Replacement buses will run from Bath Spa to Westbury and Frome. The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Temple Meads will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Bath Spa, with a rail connection from Bath Spa to Bristol Temple Meads.

- ⑪ **Monday to Wednesday** - The 2348 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids and the 2345 London Paddington to Penzance will both arrive later at Exeter St Davids.
Friday - The 2145 Penzance to London Paddington will arrive and depart later at Exeter St Davids and will not call at Taunton. Passengers travelling to / from Taunton should use an alternative earlier service.

- ⑱ ⑲ **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2115 until end of service** - The 2153 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill will call additionally at Didcot Parkway, and will then divert to run non-stop to Worcester Shrub Hill. A connecting rail service will run from Didcot Parkway to Oxford. Passengers for stations beyond Oxford should travel EARLIER on the 2123 London Paddington to Oxford. A replacement bus will connect out of this train, running from Oxford to Worcester Shrub Hill. The 2251 London Paddington to Worcestershire Parkway will finish its journey at Oxford. A replacement bus will run from Oxford to Worcestershire Parkway. The 2200 Hereford to London Paddington will finish its journey at Worcester Shrub Hill and will re-start right time from Oxford. A replacement bus will run from Worcester Shrub Hill to Oxford, but with no onward connecting service. In addition, stops at Kingham, Charlbury and Hanborough will be to drop off passengers only.

- ⑳ ⑲ **Sunday** - All day, buses will replace trains between Oxford and Hanborough. A revised service will run between Hanborough and Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street / Great Malvern / Hereford. A few trains will only run for part of their journey.

- ㉑ ㉓ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2230 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads and the 2308 Severn Beach to Bristol Temple Meads will both arrive at Bristol Temple Meads a few minutes later than usual.
-
- ㉔ **Monday from approximately 2100 until end of service** - In preparation for **Henley Regatta**, a revised service will run between Twyford and Henley-on-Thames. Most trains will run slightly EARLIER than usual.
Tuesday - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.
Tuesday to Friday - In connection with **Henley Regatta**, all day on all 4 days, a revised service will run between Twyford and Henley-on-Thames. Many trains will run slightly EARLIER than usual. Most trains FROM Henley-on-Thames TO Twyford will not call at Shiplake. Passengers travelling from Henley-on-Thames to Shiplake will need to travel via Twyford. Passengers travelling from Shiplake to Wargrave or Twyford will need to travel EARLIER and travel via Henley-on-Thames.

- ㉕ ㉕ **Sunday** - All day, buses will replace trains between Oxford and Banbury.
Monday to Thursday - The 2231 (departing 2239) Didcot Parkway to Banbury will finish its journey at Oxford. The 2334 Banbury to Oxford will not run. Replacement buses will run between Oxford and Banbury.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:

Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading;

ⓑ **Tuesday to Friday** - 0001 & 0048 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington;

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: Sunday - 0638 London Paddington to Reading and 0630 & 0742 Reading to London Paddington.

Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

The following trains will not call at Pangbourne:

Saturday - 2208 & 2308 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway, 2308 Didcot Parkway to Reading and 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

Sunday - 2233 & 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2352 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

Ⓟ **Monday** - 0410 Didcot Parkway to Reading (no replacement transport provided - passengers should use the next available service);

Monday to Thursday - 2236 & 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2326 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

Tuesday to Friday - 0355 Oxford to Reading (no replacement transport provided - passengers should use the next available service);

Friday - 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway;

In all cases, unless otherwise stated, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
