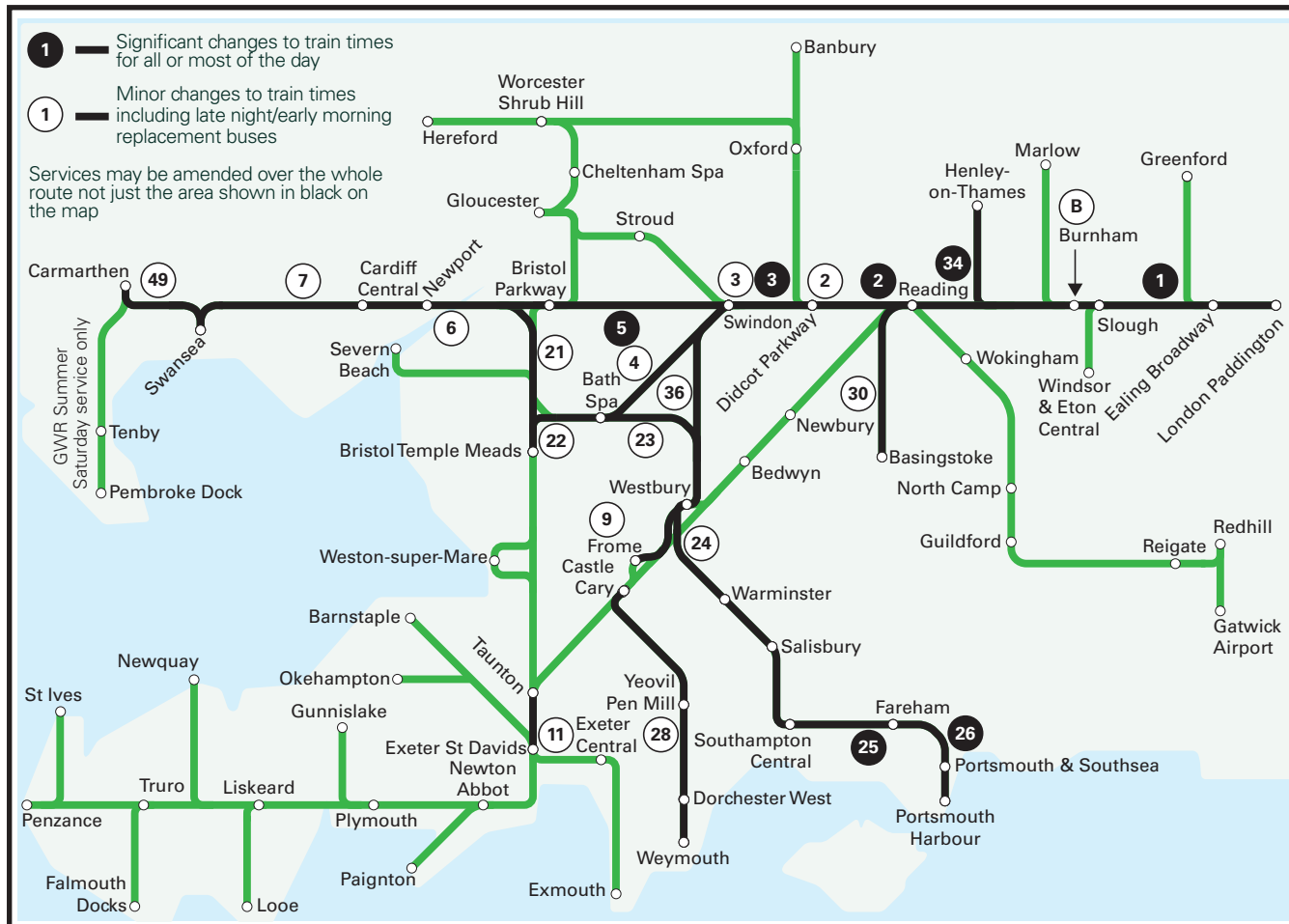


Summary of timetable changes

1 2 **Monday to Friday** - All week, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Parkway / South Wales will be reduced in frequency and will be diverted between Swindon and Bristol Parkway. Most trains TO South Wales will depart from London Paddington, Reading, (Didcot Parkway) and Swindon much EARLIER than usual. A few late evening trains will be subject to minor retimings between Cardiff Central and Swansea. Some trains will no longer call at Didcot Parkway with other trains calling there additionally instead. Additional trains will run between London Paddington, Reading, Didcot Parkway and Swindon. A few other trains between London Paddington and Reading will be retimed. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling, especially when travelling later in the day, to ensure that their journey is still possible.**

2 3 **Sunday** - The 2333 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading and will not call at Didcot Parkway, Swindon or Chippenham. A replacement bus will run from Reading to Swindon and Chippenham. Passengers travelling to Didcot Parkway should use an alternative local service from Reading.

4 22 **Monday to Thursday** - The 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will call additionally at Chippenham and at Bath Spa (to set down passengers only). The 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading and will not call at Didcot Parkway, Swindon or Chippenham. Passengers travelling to Didcot Parkway should use the 2314 London Paddington to Oxford service. A replacement bus will connect out of this train at Didcot Parkway running to Swindon and Chippenham.

6 21 **Sunday** - The 1750 Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour and the 1934 Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury will not run. Passengers should travel on alternative earlier or later services.

22 23 **Monday to Friday** - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, some trains between Bristol Temple Meads, Bath Spa and Westbury will be subject to minor retimings. The 1601 (departing 1604) Westbury to Gloucester and The 1528 Weymouth to Gloucester will not call at Oldfield Park. The 1530 London Paddington to Weston-super-Mare and the 1630 London Paddington to Taunton will call additionally at Oldfield Park and at Keysham (to set down passengers only).

9 22 **Saturday** - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Frome.

23 24 **Sunday** - The 0806 Warminster to Swindon and 0908 Swindon to Westbury will not run. Replacement buses will run between Warminster / Westbury and Chippenham, with alternative rail connections between Chippenham and Swindon. The 0839 Westbury to Bristol Temple Meads will depart at 0921 and will not call at Bradford-on-Avon, Avoncliff or Freshford. Passengers travelling to / from these stations should use a later service. The 0900 Westbury to Weymouth will depart at 0940 and run later throughout. The 0908 Bristol Temple Meads to Weymouth will run approximately 15 minutes later from Yeovil Pen Mill onwards. The 1038 Weymouth to Swindon will depart at 1116, run later throughout and finish its journey at Chippenham. The 1332 Swindon to Weymouth will start from Chippenham. Alternative rail connections will be available between Chippenham and Swindon.

28 36 **Monday** - The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. An EARLIER connecting rail service will run from Frome to Westbury.

11 **Sunday** - The 2350 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive later at Exeter St Davids. The 2115 Penzance to London Paddington will depart EARLIER from Exeter St Davids.

Monday to Wednesday - The 2305 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will finish its journey at Taunton. No replacement transport provided to Tiverton Parkway and Exeter St Davids. The 2348 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will not run and will be replaced by a bus. The 2145 Penzance to London Paddington will not call at Taunton. Passengers travelling to / from Taunton should use an alternative earlier service.

Monday to Thursday - The 2345 London Paddington to Penzance will not call at Taunton and will arrive earlier at Exeter St Davids. Passengers travelling to / from Taunton should use an alternative earlier service.

Thursday - The 2145 Penzance to London Paddington will arrive at Reading much earlier than usual.

Saturday - The 2030 Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour will finish its journey at Southampton Central. Passengers travelling beyond Southampton Central should use alternative services.

25 26 **Sunday** - All day, buses will replace trains Southampton Central and Portsmouth Harbour. Passengers travelling between Fratton, Portsmouth & Southsea and Portsmouth Harbour should use alternative rail services provided by other operators.

Monday - The 0450 Fratton to Bristol Temple Meads will start from Southampton Central. Passengers travelling from Fratton, Cosham, Portchester or Fareham should use a later service.

- ③⑩ **Saturday** - All day, a reduced service will run between Reading and Basingstoke. **From approximately 1930 until end of service**, some trains will run EARLIER than usual and a few trains from Basingstoke to Reading will not call at Reading West.

- ③④ **Saturday** - All day, in connection with **Henley Regatta**, a revised service will run between Twyford and Henley-on-Thames. Some trains FROM Henley-on-Thames TO Twyford will not call at Shiplake. Trains will also not call at Wargrave in either direction. Replacement buses will run between Wargrave and Twyford.
- ③④ **Sunday** - All day, in connection with **Henley Regatta**, a revised service will run between Twyford and Henley-on-Thames. Many trains will run slightly EARLIER than usual. Most trains FROM Henley-on-Thames TO Twyford will not call at Shiplake. Passengers travelling from Henley-on-Thames to Shiplake will need to travel via Twyford. Passengers travelling from Shiplake to Wargrave or Twyford will need to travel EARLIER and travel via Henley-on-Thames.

- ③⑥ **Monday to Friday** - All week, due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, the 1105 Swindon to Westbury will run EARLIER than usual. A few other trains will be subject to minor retimings.

- ④⑨ **Monday to Friday** - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, the 1618 London Paddington to Carmarthen will start from Swansea and will depart Swansea slightly EARLIER than usual.

- ⑧ **Saturday** - 0049 London Paddington to Reading will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
