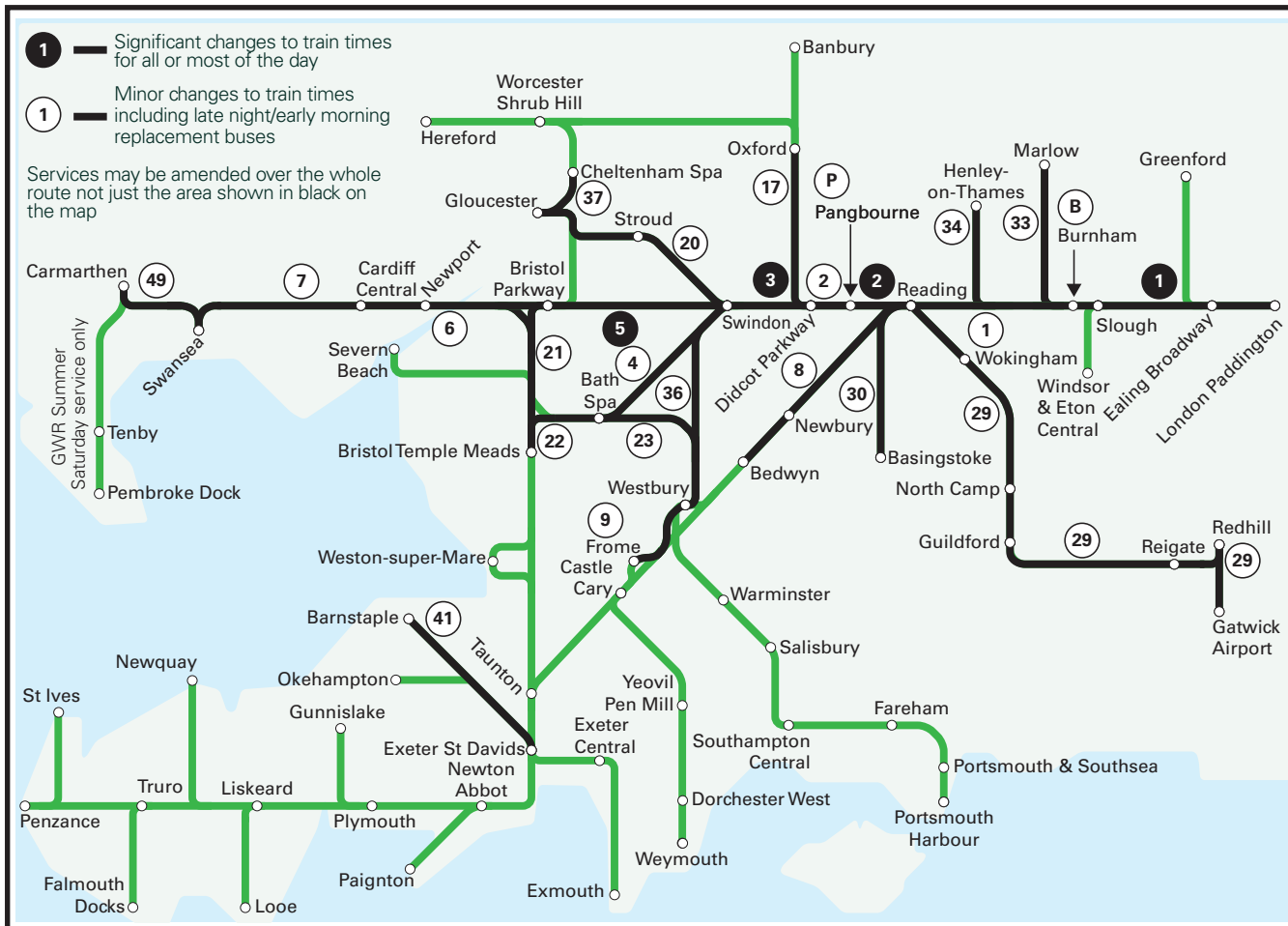


Summary of timetable changes

① ② **Saturday to Friday** - All week, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Parkway / South Wales will be reduced in frequency and will be diverted between Swindon and Bristol Parkway. Most trains TO South Wales will depart from London Paddington, Reading, (Didcot Parkway) and Swindon much EARLIER than usual. Some trains will no longer call at Didcot Parkway with other trains calling there additionally instead. Some trains between London Paddington, Reading, Didcot Parkway and Swindon will be retimed, and some additional trains will also run. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling, especially when travelling later in the day, to ensure that their journey is still possible.**

① **Sunday until approximately 0900** - Some trains from London Paddington will be retimed, in some cases, EARLIER than usual.

① ② **Saturday from approximately 2245 until end of service** - Buses will replace trains between Didcot Parkway and Oxford.

①⑦ **Sunday** - The 0753 Oxford to London Paddington will start from Didcot Parkway. Passengers travelling from Oxford should use the next available service.

Saturday until approximately 0700 - Buses will replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn. A few other trains will be subject to minor retimings.

Sunday - The 0806 Reading to Newbury will not run and the 0833 Reading to Bedwyn will start from Newbury and run slightly later than usual. A replacement bus will run EARLIER from Reading at 0751 to Newbury. The 0804 (departing 0753) London Paddington to Penzance will be diverted after Reading and will no longer call at Newbury or Pewsey. The 0844 (departing 0828) London Paddington to Penzance will call additionally at Newbury and Pewsey. The 2323 Newbury to Reading will not run and will be replaced by a bus.

⑧ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2230 London Paddington to Bedwyn will start from Reading and will be slightly retimed. An alternative rail connection will be available from London Paddington to Reading.

Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will be slightly retimed and will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington.

Saturday to Friday - All week, due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, some trains between Bristol Temple Meads, Bath Spa and Westbury will be subject to minor retimings.

⑨ ②② **Monday to Thursday** - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury and the 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will both finish their journeys at Bath Spa. Replacement buses will run from Bath Spa to Westbury and Frome. The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Temple Meads will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Bath Spa, with a rail connection from Bath Spa to Bristol Temple Meads.

②③ **Monday to Friday** - The 1601 (departing 1604) Westbury to Gloucester and the 1528 Weymouth to Gloucester will not call at Oldfield Park. The 1530 London Paddington to Weston-super-Mare and the 1630 London Paddington to Taunton will call additionally at Oldfield Park and at Keysham (to set down passengers only).

②① ③⑦ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will be diverted to run non-stop to, and finish its journey at, Gloucester. A replacement bus will run from Swindon to Cheltenham Spa, calling at intermediate stations via Stroud.

Tuesday - The 2131 London Paddington to Cheltenham Spa will finish its journey at Gloucester. A replacement bus will run from Gloucester to Cheltenham Spa.

②① **Monday and Tuesday** - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will run slightly later from Patchway onwards.

Monday to Thursday - The 2333 Reading to Gatwick Airport will finish its journey at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Gatwick Airport. Passengers travelling from Redhill to Gatwick Airport should use an alternative earlier or later rail service provided by another operator, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. The 2322 Gatwick Airport to Reading will finish its journey at Redhill. A replacement bus will run from Redhill to Guildford, with a rail connection from Guildford to Reading. Stops in replacement buses will be at Dorking (Main) station, a 5 minute walk from Dorking Deepdene.

②⑨ **Tuesday to Friday** - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport will run later from Guildford and will finish its journey at Redhill. The 0559 Gatwick Airport to Reading will start from Redhill. Alternative rail connections, provided by Southern, will be available between Redhill and Gatwick Airport, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.

- ③⑩ **Sunday** - The 0837 Reading to Basingstoke will not run. A replacement bus will run EARLIER, calling at all stations except Reading West. Passengers travelling to / from Reading West should use an alternative service.

- ③③ **Sunday** - The 0007 Marlow to Maidenhead will finish its journey at Bourne End. A replacement bus will run from Bourne End to Maidenhead.
-
- ③④ **Tuesday to Thursday** - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.
-
- ③⑥ **Saturday to Friday** - All week, due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, some trains between Westbury and Swindon will be subject to retimings, with a few trains running EARLIER than usual.
-
- ④① **Monday to Wednesday** - The 2054 Exmouth (2129 Exeter St Davids) to Barnstaple will finish its journey at Crediton. A replacement bus will run from Crediton to Barnstaple. The 2241 Barnstaple to Exeter St Davids will not run and will be replaced by a bus. Yeoford will be served by a separate minibus / taxi shuttle to and from Crediton.

- ④⑨ **Monday to Friday** - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, the 1618 London Paddington to Carmarthen will start from Swansea and will depart Swansea slightly EARLIER than usual.

- The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:**
Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;
Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading;
⑤ **Tuesday to Thursday** - 0001 & 0048 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington;
Friday - 0048 London Paddington to Reading;
In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: Sunday - 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 Reading to London Paddington and 2352 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

- ⑥ **The following trains will not call at Pangbourne:**
Sunday - 0738, 2233 & 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 0818 & 2352 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;
Friday - 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway;
In all cases, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
