1 2 **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Parkway / South Wales will be reduced in frequency and will be diverted between Swindon and Bristol Parkway. Most trains TO South Wales will depart from London Paddington, Reading, (Didcot Parkway) and Swindon much EARLIER than usual. Some trains will no longer call at Didcot Parkway with other trains calling there additionally instead. Some trains between London Paddington, Reading, Didcot Parkway, Swindon and Bristol Temple Meads will be retimed, and some additional trains will also run. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling, especially when travelling later in the day, to ensure that their journey is still possible.**

1 2 **Sunday until approximately 1800** - Most High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be retimed, in some cases, EARLIER than usual.

1 2 **Monday** - In connection with **The Wilderness Festival**, the 0900 Oxford to London Paddington will depart at 0847 and run EARLIER throughout. The 0959, 1100 & 1200 Oxford to London Paddington will start back from Charlbury. The 1300 Oxford to London Paddington will start back from Charlbury and will finish its journey at Reading. The 1323 London Paddington to Oxford will start from Reading. Alternative rail connections will be available between Reading and London Paddington.

2 3 **Sunday** - The 2333 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading to run non-stop to Bath Spa. A replacement bus will run from Reading to Swindon and Chippenham. Passengers for Didcot Parkway should change at Reading for an alternative local train service.

6 21 **Monday to Thursday** - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will be slightly retimed from Severn Tunnel Junction onwards, and will not call at Stapleton Road or Lawrence Hill. A replacement bus will run from Filton Abbey Wood to Bristol Temple Meads, calling at Stapleton Road and Lawrence Hill.

Sunday - The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Replacement buses will run from Swansea, and from Neath, Port Talbot Parkway and Bridgend, to Cardiff Central to connect into the train.

7 **Monday to Thursday** - The 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will both finish their journeys at Neath. Replacement buses will run from Neath to Swansea.

Tuesday to Friday - The 0338 Swansa to London Paddington will start from Neath and will run later as far as Cardiff Central. A replacement bus will run Swansea to Neath to connect into the train.

Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2145 until end of service - Buses will replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn.

8 **Friday** - The 0017 Reading to Newbury will not run and will be replaced by a bus.

Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will be slightly retimed and will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington.

9 **Monday to Friday** - The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. An EARLIER connecting rail service will run from Frome to Westbury.

Sunday - The 2350 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive later at Exeter St Davids. 2115 Penzance to London Paddington will depart EARLIER from Exeter St Davids and will arrive earlier at Reading.

11 **Monday** - The 2345 London Paddington to Penzance will not call at Taunton and will arrive earlier at Exeter St Davids. Passengers travelling to / from Taunton should use an alternative EARLIER service.

14 15 **Wednesday to Friday** - In connection with **The Boardmasters Festival** in Newquay, some trains between London Paddington and Penzance will not serve stations west of Par. Some other trains between Plymouth and Penzance will also be revised. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling**

22 23 **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, some trains between Bristol Temple Meads, Bath Spa and Westbury will be subject to minor retimings.

36 **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, some trains between Westbury and Swindon will be subject to retimings, with a few trains running EARLIER than usual.
