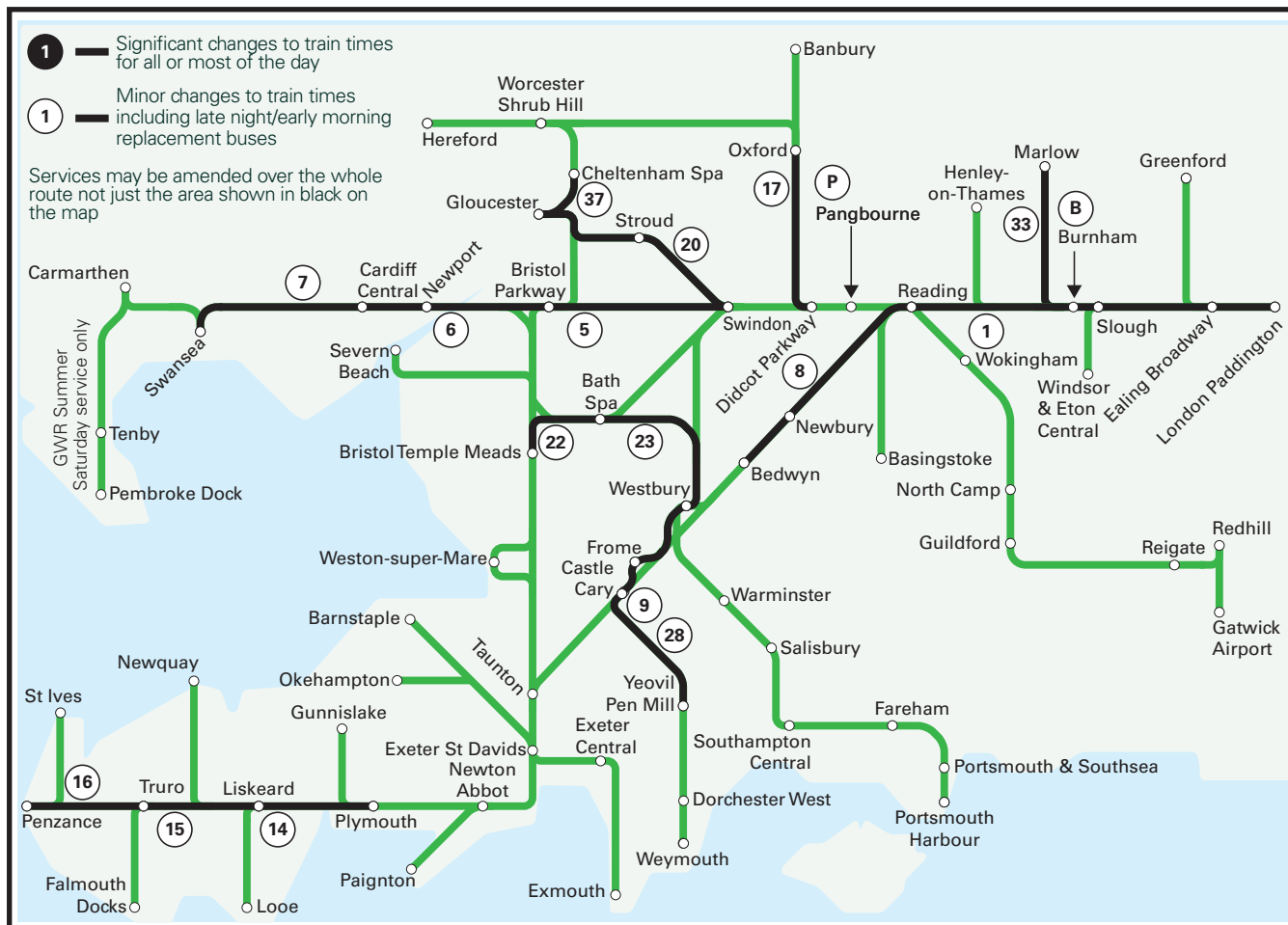


Summary of timetable changes

①	Monday - In connection with Reading Festival , additional trains will run from Reading, non-stop to London Paddington, in the early hours of Monday morning.
⑤ ⑥	Sunday - The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Replacement buses will run EARLIER from Swansea and from Neath, Port Talbot Parkway and Bridgend to Cardiff Central to connect into the train.
⑦	Monday to Thursday - The 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Swindon and will run later from Bristol Parkway to Swansea.
⑧	Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service - Buses will replace trains between Newbury and Bedwyn. The 2230 London Paddington to Bedwyn will start from Reading, will be slightly retimed and will finish its journey at Newbury. An alternative rail connection will be available from London Paddington to Reading. Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will be slightly retimed and will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington.
⑨ ②②	Monday - The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. Passengers travelling from Frome should use a later service. The 0618 Yeovil Pen Mill to Gloucester will start from Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers travelling from stations before Bristol Temple Meads should use an alternative earlier or later service. The 0625 Westbury to Frome will depart at 0630 and run later throughout.
②③ ②⑧	Tuesday to Thursday - The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. An alternative EARLIER rail connection will be available from Frome to Westbury.
⑭ ⑮	Saturday - In connection with The Quarry Festival in Menheniot, some trains will call additionally at Menheniot, and a few trains will call additionally at St Budeaux Ferry Road, Saltash and St Germans, and will be retimed. A few trains will depart slightly EARLIER from certain stations.
⑰	Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
⑰	Sunday from approximately 2300 until end of service - Scheduled replacement buses between Didcot Parkway, Radley and Oxford will be replaced by rail services, running at different times.
⑳ ③⑦	Monday to Thursday - The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will depart EARLIER from Swindon, be diverted to run non-stop to, and finish its journey at, Gloucester. A replacement bus will run from Swindon to Cheltenham Spa, calling at intermediate stations via Stroud.
③③	Sunday - The 0007 Marlow to Maidenhead will finish its journey at Bourne End. A replacement bus will run from Bourne End to Maidenhead.
③	The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow: Saturday - 0049 London Paddington to Reading and 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington; Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading; In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow. The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: Sunday - 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0625 Reading to London Paddington and 2352 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.
③	Sunday - The 2233 & 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and the 2352 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
