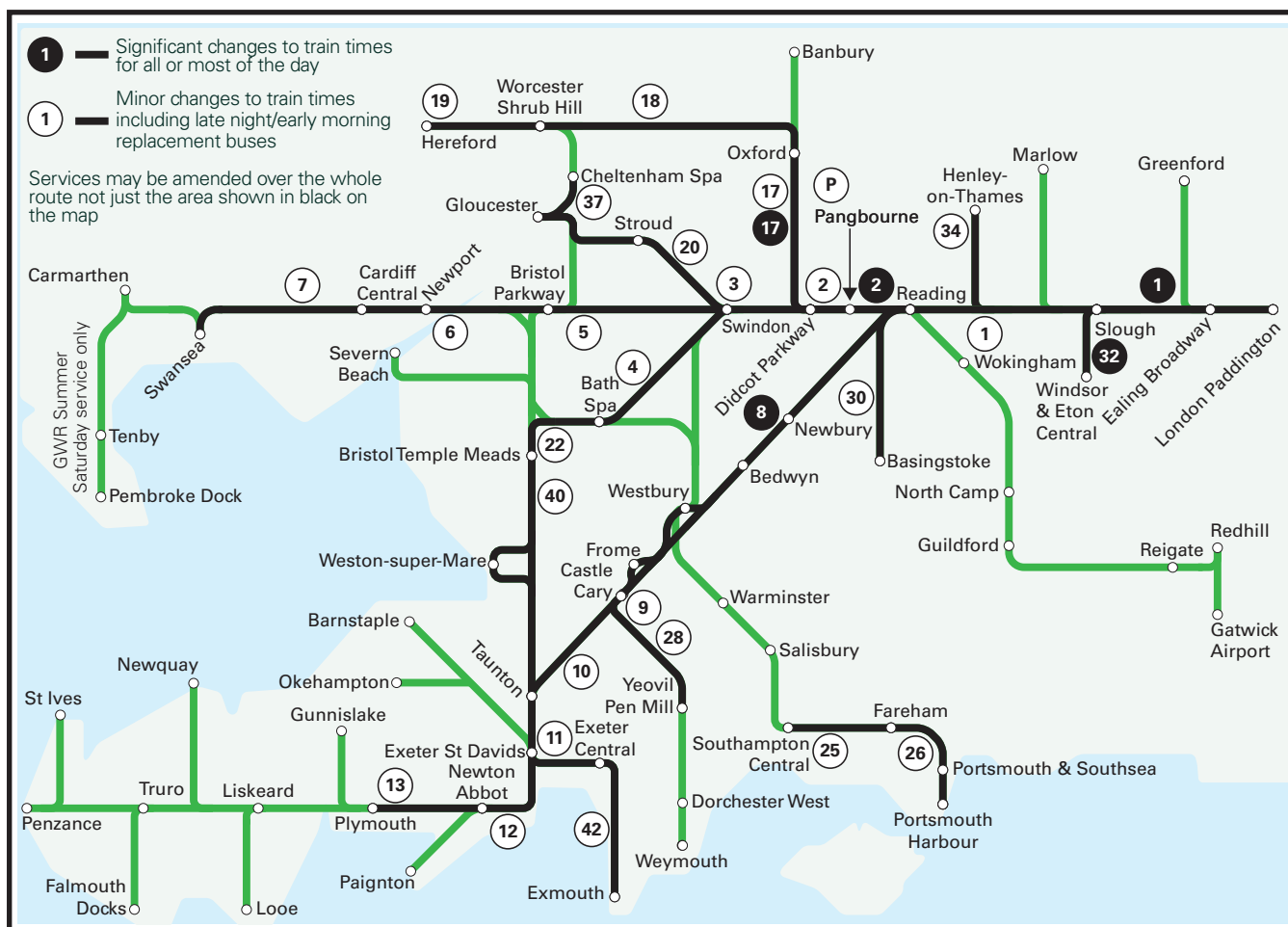


Summary of timetable changes

1 2 8 17	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, all trains to and from London Paddington will be revised. Most High Speed services FROM London Paddington will depart EARLIER than usual. A few trains will not run at all and other trains will make additional stops to compensate. In addition, on Saturday , most trains between London Paddington and Newbury will only run between Reading and Newbury and local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will only run hourly between London Paddington and Reading (they will still run half-hourly between Reading and Didcot Parkway). In addition, on Sunday , most trains between London Paddington and Oxford will not call at Slough and most local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will only run between Reading and Didcot Parkway. Trains between London Paddington and Swindon (sometimes beyond) will call additionally at Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
1	Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will finish its journey at Ealing Broadway. Sunday - 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start from Ealing Broadway. In both cases, TfL Central line connections will be available to / from central London, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. Sunday - 0620 Reading to London Paddington will run later throughout.
2 17	Saturday from approximately 2245 until end of service - Buses will replace trains between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. Sunday - The 0753 Oxford to London Paddington will start from Didcot Parkway. Passengers travelling from Oxford should use the next available service. Tuesday, Thursday and Friday - The 0355 Oxford to Reading will depart slightly EARLIER from Oxford and will be slightly retimed throughout.
3 4 5 6 7 22 40	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, due to engineering work taking place between Slough and Reading, all High Speed services running to and from London Paddington are subject to retimings for their whole journey. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
7	Monday to Wednesday - The 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will both finish their journeys at Port Talbot Parkway. Replacement buses will run from Port Talbot Parkway to Neath and Swansea. Tuesday to Thursday - The 0338 Swansa to London Paddington will start from Port Talbot Parkway. A replacement bus will run EARLIER from Swansea and Neath to Port Talbot Parkway to connect into the train.
9 10 11 12 13 18 19	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, due to engineering work taking place between Slough and Reading, all High Speed services running to and from London Paddington are subject to retimings for their whole journey. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
9 28	Tuesday to Friday - The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. An alternative EARLIER rail connection will be available from Frome to Westbury. The 0618 Yeovil Pen Mill to Gloucester will start from Castle Cary. Passengers travelling from Yeovil Pen Mill should use a later service, changing en-route where necessary to complete their journey.
20 37	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, due to engineering work taking place between Slough and Reading, all High Speed services running to and from London Paddington are subject to retimings for their whole journey. A few other trains between Swindon and Gloucester / Cheltenham Spa will also be subject to minor retimings. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
25 26	Friday - The 2030 Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour will finish its journey at Southampton Central. Passengers travelling beyond Southampton Central should use alternative later services.
30	Saturday - All day, due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, some trains from Reading to Basingstoke will run a few minutes later than usual (trains from Basingstoke to Reading will not be affected).

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Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, replacement buses will run between Slough and Windsor & Eton Riverside (note: Windsor & Eton Riverside is approximately 10 minutes walk from Windsor & Eton Central, which will not be served).

Tuesday to Thursday - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.

Monday to Thursday - The 2340 (**Monday to Wednesday**) Exeter St Davids to Exmouth and the 0019 (**Tuesday to Thursday**) Exmouth to Exeter St Davids will not run and will be replaced by buses.

B

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:

Tuesday to Thursday - 0001 & 0048 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington;

Friday - 0048 London Paddington to Reading;

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

P

Friday - The 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
