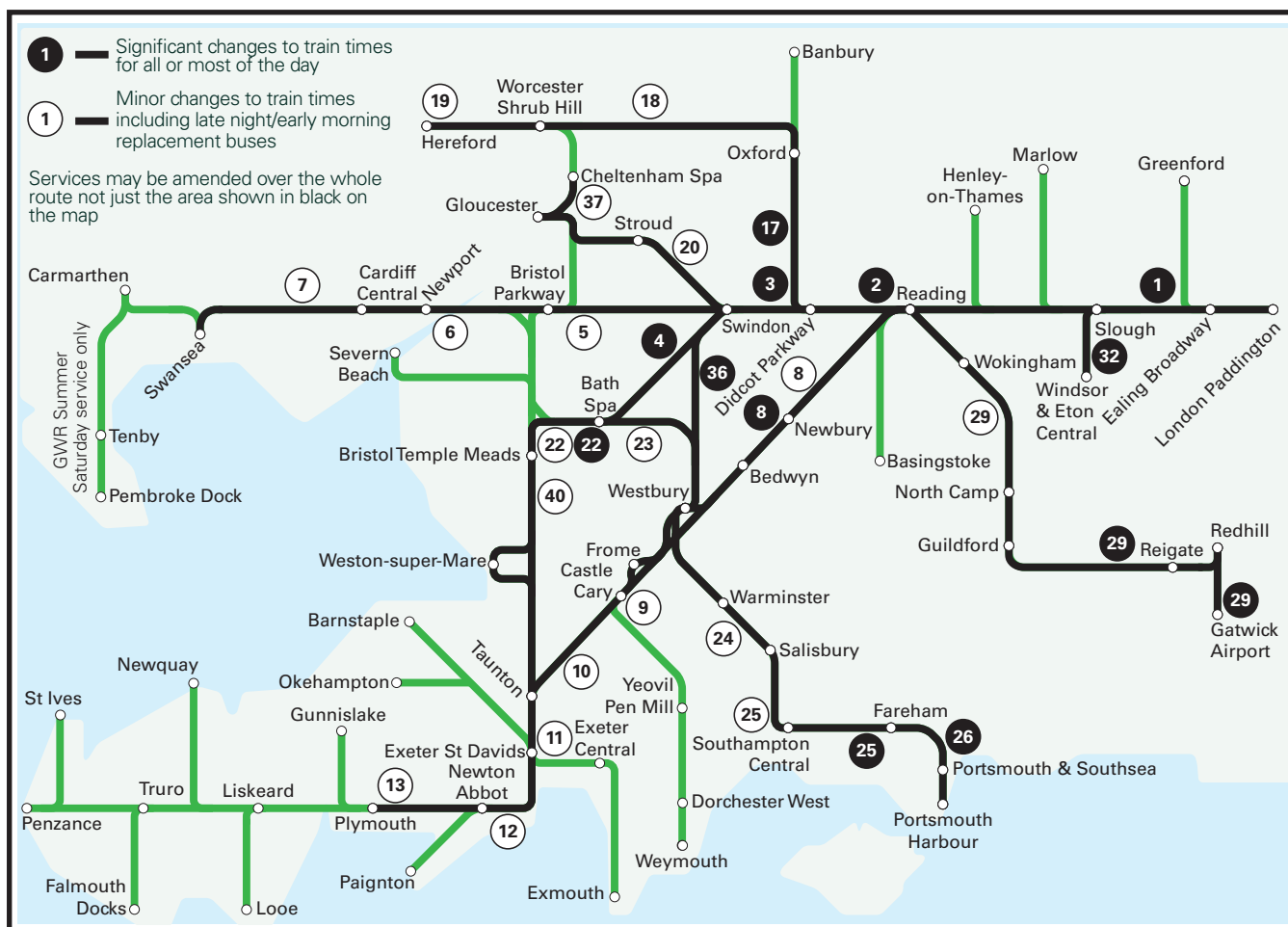

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Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, all trains to and from London Paddington will be revised. Most High Speed services FROM London Paddington will depart EARLIER than usual. A few trains will not run at all and other trains will make additional stops to compensate. In addition, **on Saturday**, most trains between London Paddington and Newbury will only run between Reading and Newbury and local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will only run hourly between London Paddington and Reading (they will still run half-hourly between Reading and Didcot Parkway). In addition, **on Sunday**, most trains between London Paddington and Oxford will not call at Slough and most local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will only run between Reading and Didcot Parkway. Trains between London Paddington and Swindon (sometimes beyond) will call additionally at Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

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Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, a revised service will run between London Paddington / Reading / Oxford and Bristol Temple Meads. **On Saturday**, some trains will be diverted to run non-stop between Reading and Bath Spa, not calling at Didcot Parkway, Swindon or Chippenham. Other trains, including all trains between Oxford and Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted to run non-stop between Swindon and Bristol Temple Meads, not calling at Chippenham or Bath Spa. **On Sunday**, trains will be diverted to run non-stop between Swindon and Bristol Temple Meads, and will then extend to / from Bath Spa. On both days, replacement buses will run between Swindon and Chippenham and between Chippenham and Bath Spa. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

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Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, due to engineering work taking place between Slough and Reading, all High Speed services running to and from London Paddington are subject to retimings for their whole journey. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

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Sunday - The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Replacement buses will run EARLIER from Swansea and from Neath, Port Talbot Parkway and Bridgend to Cardiff Central to connect into the train.

Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service - Buses will replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn.

Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will be slightly retimed and will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington.

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Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, due to engineering work taking place between Slough and Reading, all High Speed services running to and from London Paddington are subject to retimings for their whole journey. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

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Monday to Friday - The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. An alternative EARLIER rail connection will be available from Frome to Westbury.

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Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, due to engineering work taking place between Swindon and Bath Spa, most direct trains between London Paddington and Weston-super-Mare (sometimes beyond) will only run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers should use other scheduled rail services to travel between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton. A few other trains will not run.

Monday to Thursday from approximately 2200 until end of service - Trains between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton will either be diverted to run non-stop between Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton, or will either only run for part of their journey or will not run at all. Buses will run between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton / Exeter St Davids, in place of diverted or cancelled trains.

Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, due to engineering work taking place between Slough and Reading, all High Speed services running to and from London Paddington are subject to retimings for their whole journey. A few other trains between Swindon and Gloucester / Cheltenham Spa will also be subject to minor retimings. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

22 23	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Southampton Central and Portsmouth Harbour. Buses will not carry passengers making local journeys between Fratton, Portsmouth & Southsea and Portsmouth Harbour, and these passengers should use alternative rail services provided by other operators, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. A few other trains will either not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.

25 26	Monday - The 0450 Fratton to Bristol Temple Meads will start from Southampton Central. Passengers travelling from stations before Southampton Central should use a later service.
22 23	Monday to Thursday - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, the 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury will run 4 minutes later throughout.
29 29	Saturday - The 2333 Reading to Gatwick Airport will finish its journey at Redhill. An alternative rail connection, operated by Southern, will be available from Redhill to Gatwick Airport, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.
29 29	Sunday - All day, buses will replace trains between Guildford and Redhill / Gatwick Airport. Passengers travelling between Redhill and Gatwick Airport should use alternative rail / replacement bus services operated by Southern and change at Horley. A few trains between Reading and Guildford will either not run or will be retimed. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
29	Tuesday to Thursday - The 2322 Gatwick Airport to Reading will finish its journey at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Reading.
29	Wednesday to Friday - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport will start from Guildford. A replacement bus will run EARLIER from Reading non-stop to Guildford. Passengers travelling to / from other stations should use the next service.
32	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, replacement buses will run between Slough and Windsor & Eton Riverside (note: Windsor & Eton Riverside is approximately 10 minutes walk from Windsor & Eton Central, which will not be served).
36	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Swindon and Westbury via Melksham. Buses will not carry passengers making local journeys between Trowbridge and Westbury, and these passengers should use other scheduled rail services.
