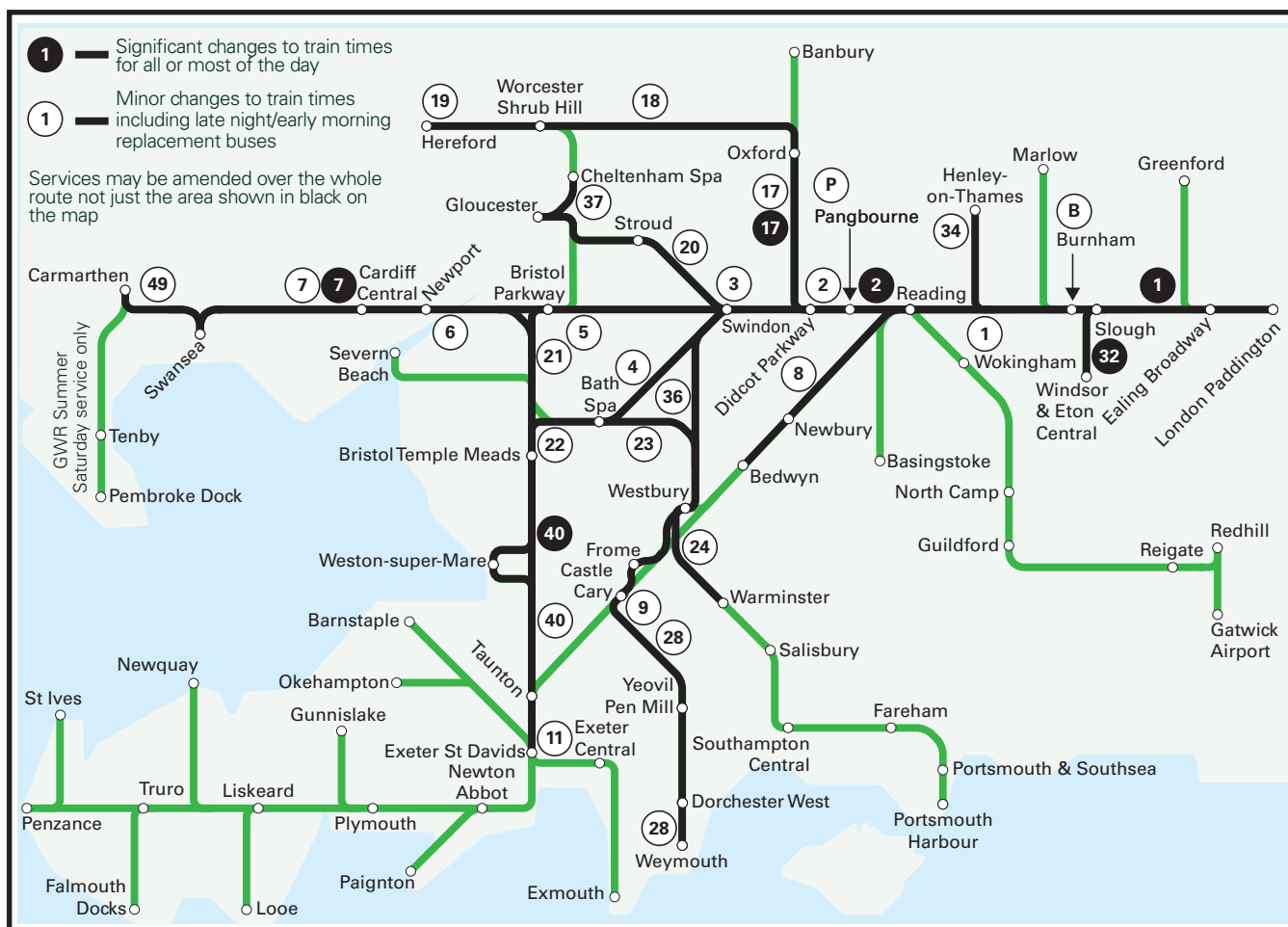


Summary of timetable changes

①	Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service each day - Some trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor later retimings.
① ② ③ ⑪	Sunday - All day, all trains to and from London Paddington will be revised. Most High Speed services FROM London Paddington will depart EARLIER than usual. A few trains will not run at all and other trains will make additional stops to compensate. Most trains between London Paddington and Oxford will not call at Slough and most local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will only run between Reading and Didcot Parkway. Trains between London Paddington and Swindon (sometimes beyond) will call additionally at Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
① ② ③ ⑤ ⑥ ⑦	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, a revised and reduced service will run between London Paddington / Reading and South Wales. Trains will be diverted via an alternative route between Cardiff Central and Bridgend, extending journey times. Most trains FROM South Wales to London Paddington will depart EARLIER than usual from Swansea, Neath, Port Talbot Parkway and Bridgend. Some other trains will also either only run for part of their journey or will not run at all. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
① ② ③ ④ ⑪ ⑫	Saturday from approximately 2300 until end of service - Trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to later retimings.
② ③ ④ ⑫	Sunday - All day, most trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads will be subject to later retimings. The 2333 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading to run non-stop to Bath Spa. A replacement bus will run from Reading to Swindon and Chippenham. Passengers for Didcot Parkway should change at Reading for an alternative local train service.
⑦	Monday to Thursday - The 2048, 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will be subject to later retimings after departing from Cardiff Central.
⑧	Monday to Thursday - The 2230 London Paddington to Bedwyn will start from Reading and will be slightly retimed. An alternative rail connection will be available from London Paddington to Reading. Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will be slightly retimed and will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington.
⑨ ⑫ ⑬ ⑭ ⑮ ⑯	Saturday - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Frome. Sunday until approximately 1400 - Some trains between Westbury and Bristol Temple Meads / Swindon / Warminster / Frome / Weymouth will be subject to later retimings, and a few will only run for part of their journey. Some trains will be replaced by buses between Westbury and Chippenham and between Westbury / Bradford-on-Avon and Bath Spa. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling. Monday to Thursday - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury & the 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will both finish their journeys at Bath Spa. Replacement buses will run from Bath Spa to Westbury and Frome. The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Temple Meads will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Bath Spa, with a connecting rail service from Bath Spa to Bristol Temple Meads.
⑪ ⑫ ⑬	Saturday - The 2104 Taunton to Bristol Temple Meads will not run. Passengers should travel on an alternative earlier or later service. Sunday - All day, buses will replace trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Weston-super-Mare. A few other trains will not run, or will only run for part of their journey. Replacement buses will not serve Bedminster and Parson Street. Valid rail tickets will be accepted on local bus services serving these stations, as well as on all local bus services between Bristol Temple Meads and Weston-super-Mare, including those serving intermediate stations.
⑪	Monday to Wednesday - The 2348 (Monday and Tuesday) Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids and the 2345 (Monday to Wednesday) London Paddington to Penzance will both arrive later at Exeter St Davids. Friday - The 2145 Penzance to London Paddington will depart later from Exeter St Davids, will not call at Taunton and will arrive later at Reading and London Paddington. Passengers for Taunton should use an alternative EARLIER service.

	Monday to Wednesday - The 2153 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill will call additionally at Didcot Parkway and will then be diverted to run non-stop to Worcester Shrub Hill. A connecting rail service will run from Didcot Parkway to Oxford. Passengers for stations beyond Oxford should travel EARLIER on the 2123 London Paddington to Oxford. A replacement bus will connect out of this train, calling at stations to Worcester Shrub Hill. Thursday - The 2052 London Paddington to Great Malvern will finish its journey at Worcester Shrub Hill. A replacement bus will run from Worcester Shrub Hill to Great Malvern. The 2153 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill will finish its journey at Oxford. Replacement buses will run from Oxford to Worcester Shrub Hill. Monday to Thursday - The 2251 London Paddington to Worcestershire Parkway will finish its journey at Oxford. A replacement bus will run from Oxford to Worcestershire Parkway. The 2200 Hereford to London Paddington will finish its journey at Worcester Shrub Hill and re-start at normal time from Oxford. A replacement bus will run from Worcester Shrub Hill to Oxford, but there will be no onward connection beyond Oxford to London Paddington. Stops at Kingham, Charlbury and Hanborough in this bus will be to drop off passengers only.
17 18 19	Sunday - The 1733 (departing 1730) London Paddington to Cheltenham Spa will be slightly retimed throughout.
20 37	Monday to Thursday - The 2230 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads, the 2244 Taunton to Bristol Temple Meads and the 2308 Severn Beach to Bristol Temple Meads will all arrive up to 10 minutes later at Bristol Temple Meads.
21 40	Saturday from approximately 2300 until end of service and all day Sunday - Trains between Slough and Windsor & Eton Central will not run. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Windsor & Eton Riverside (note: Windsor & Eton Riverside is approximately 10 minutes walk from Windsor & Eton Central, which will not be served).
32	Tuesday to Thursday - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.
34	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, due to engineering work taking place between Cardiff Central and Bridgend, most GWR services to and from Carmarthen will only run between Swansea and Carmarthen. Change at Swansea for connecting services to and from London Paddington. On Saturday, the 1648 London Paddington to Carmarthen and, on Sunday, the 1845 Carmarthen to London Paddington will continue to run as through trains.
49	Tuesday to Friday - The 0001 & 0048 London Paddington to Reading and the 0019 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
B	The following trains will not call at Pangbourne: Monday to Thursday - 2236 & 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2326 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington; Tuesday to Friday - 0355 Oxford to Reading (no replacement transport provided - passengers should use the next available service); Friday - 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway. Unless otherwise stated, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
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
