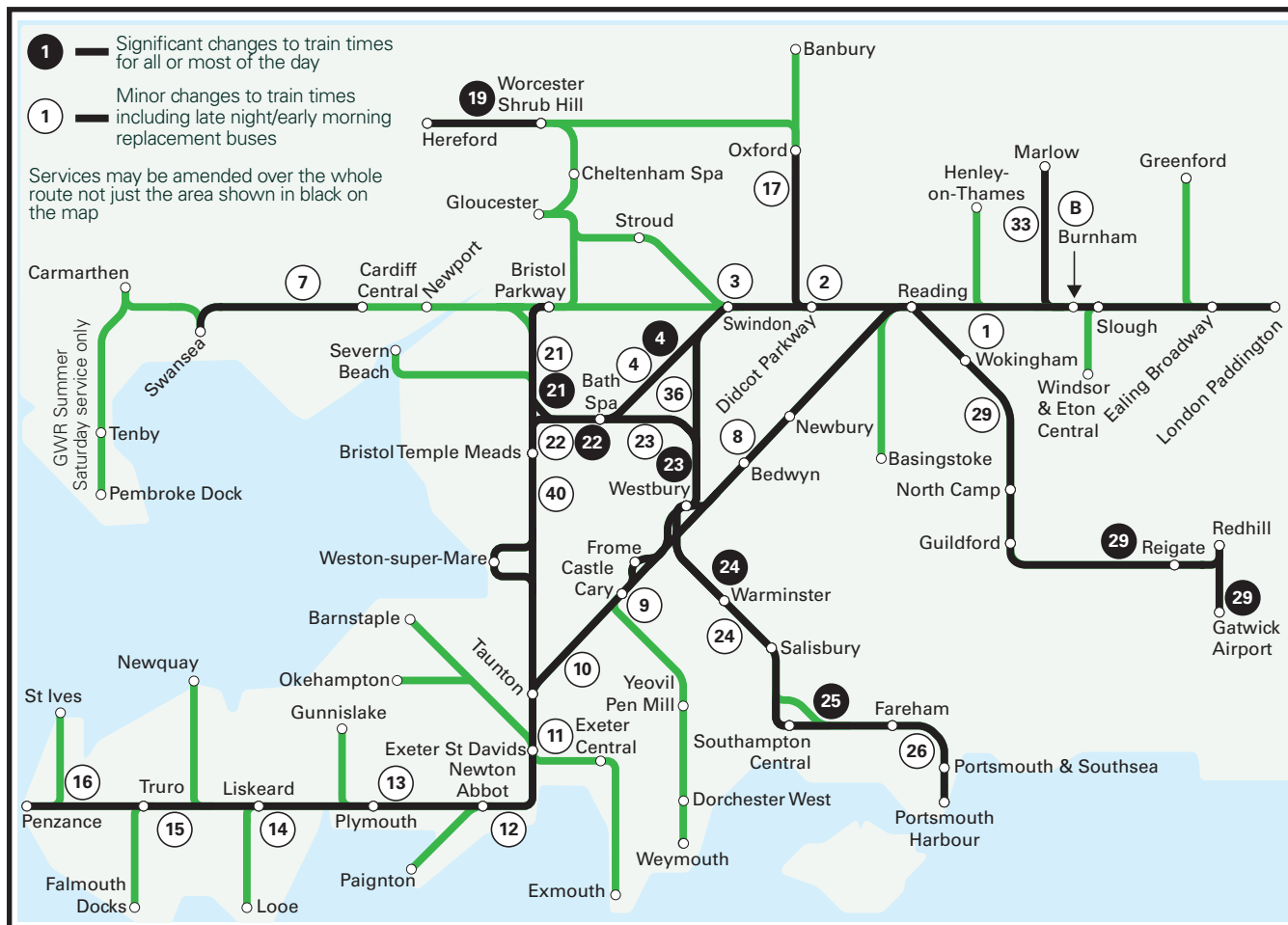


Summary of timetable changes

Sunday - All day, some High Speed services to / from London Paddington will be revised. Some trains FROM London Paddington will depart a few minutes EARLIER than usual. A few trains will not run, or will only run for part of their journey, and other trains will make additional stops instead. Most local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will also be retimed for all or part of their journey.

Monday to Wednesday - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, the 0838 London Paddington to Westbury will not run. The 0934 London Paddington to Paignton will call additionally at Pewsey and will no longer call at Tiverton Parkway.
Friday - The 1203 London Paddington to Penzance will run non-stop from London Paddington to Plymouth and will run EARLIER from Plymouth to Penzance. Additional trains will run from London Paddington at 1205 to intermediate stations to Plymouth and there will also be an additional 1549 Plymouth to London Paddington. Please check journey planners for details of specific calling points and timings.

Monday to Wednesday - All day on all 3 days, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads will either be diverted to run non-stop between Swindon and Bristol Temple Meads, not calling at Chippenham and Bath Spa, or will only run between London Paddington and Bath Spa. Replacement buses will run between Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads. Valid GWR tickets will also be accepted on relevant local buses between Bath, Oldfield Park, Keynsham and Bristol. A few late night services will also be replaced by buses between Swindon / Chippenham and Bath Spa / Bristol Temple Meads. Direct services between Oxford and Bristol Temple Meads will not run, and passengers should use alternative services, changing en-route where necessary to complete their journey.
Passengers are strongly advised to check their journey before travelling.

Sunday - The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Replacement buses will run EARLIER from Swansea and from Neath, Port Talbot Parkway and Bridgend to Cardiff Central to connect into the train.
Monday to Thursday - The 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will both finish their journeys at Neath. Replacement buses will run from Neath to Swansea.
Tuesday to Friday - The 0338 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Neath. A replacement bus will run from Swansea to Neath to connect into the train.

Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service - Buses will replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn.
Monday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will be slightly retimed and will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington.

Monday to Wednesday - All day on all 3 days, buses will replace trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Bath Spa. Trains between Cardiff Central and Portsmouth Harbour will run between Cardiff Central and Bristol Temple Meads (in revised timings), and separately between Bath Spa and Portsmouth Harbour. Trains between Gloucester and Westbury / Frome / Weymouth will run between Gloucester and Bristol Temple Meads and separately between Bath Spa / Westbury and Frome / Weymouth (most trains to / from Weymouth will only run between Westbury and Weymouth). Trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Warminster / Salisbury will only run between Bath Spa and Westbury. A few services will not run at all. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Temple Meads and Bath Spa. Valid GWR tickets will also be accepted on relevant local buses between Bristol, Keynsham, Oldfield Park and Bath.
Passengers are strongly advised to check their journey before travelling.

Monday to Friday - All week, buses will replace trains between Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street, Great Malvern and Hereford. Most trains between London Paddington and Worcester Foregate Street / Great Malvern / Hereford will only run between London Paddington and Worcester Shrub Hill, but a limited number of trains will also continue to run to / from Worcester Foregate Street.

21 21	Monday to Wednesday - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, local stopping services between Bristol Temple Meads and Filton Abbey Wood will not run. Most trains between Portsmouth Harbour and Cardiff Central (only running between Bristol Temple Meads and Cardiff Central) will call additionally at Lawrence Hill, Stapleton Road and Ashley Down. Monday to Thursday - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will not call at Stapleton Road or Lawrence Hill. A replacement bus will run from Filton Abbey Wood to Bristol Temple Meads, serving Stapleton Road and Lawrence Hill.
22 23 24 25 26	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between Cardiff Central / Bristol Temple Meads and Portsmouth Harbour will divert between Romsey and Fareham, calling additionally at Chandlers Ford and Eastleigh, but not calling at Southampton Central. Replacement buses will run between Southampton Central and Eastleigh, connecting with diverted trains. A few other trains will either not run or will only run for part of their journey. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journey before travelling.
29 29	Saturday - The 2333 Reading to Gatwick Airport will finish its journey at Redhill. An alternative rail service, operated by Southern, will be available from Redhill to Gatwick Airport, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. Sunday - All day, a revised train service will run between Reading and Guildford, and replacement buses will run between Guildford and Redhill / Gatwick Airport. Alternative rail services, operated by Thameslink, will be available between Redhill and Gatwick Airport, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. Stops in replacement buses between North Camp and Redhill will be at Dorking (Main) station, a 5 minute walk from Dorking Deepdene. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journey before travelling. Monday to Thursday - The 2322 Gatwick Airport to Reading will finish its journey at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Reading. Tuesday to Friday - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport will start from Guildford. A replacement bus will run EARLIER from Reading non-stop to Guildford. Passengers travelling to / from other stations should use the next service.
33	Sunday from approximately 1800 until end of service - The 1803 Maidenhead to Marlow and the 1829 Marlow to Maidenhead will both run 1 minute EARLIER than usual. After this time, buses will replace trains, at a reduced frequency, between Maidenhead, Bourne End and Marlow.
36	Monday to Wednesday - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, some trains between Westbury (or beyond) and Swindon via Melksham will be retimed. The 2231 Swindon to Westbury will not run. A replacement bus will run from Chippenham to Westbury. An EARLIER rail connection will be available from Swindon to Chippenham and a slightly EARLIER rail service will be available from Trowbridge to Westbury.
40	Monday to Wednesday - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, most off-peak trains between London Paddington and Weston-super-Mare will only run between London Paddington and either Bath Spa or Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers should use alternative services to travel between Bristol Temple Meads and Weston-super-Mare. Some peak services will continue to run, but will mostly only run between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton. Passengers will need to change at Bristol Temple Meads for services to / from London Paddington.
B	Saturday - The 0049 London Paddington to Reading will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow. Sunday - The 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and the 2352 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will not call at Burnham. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.
