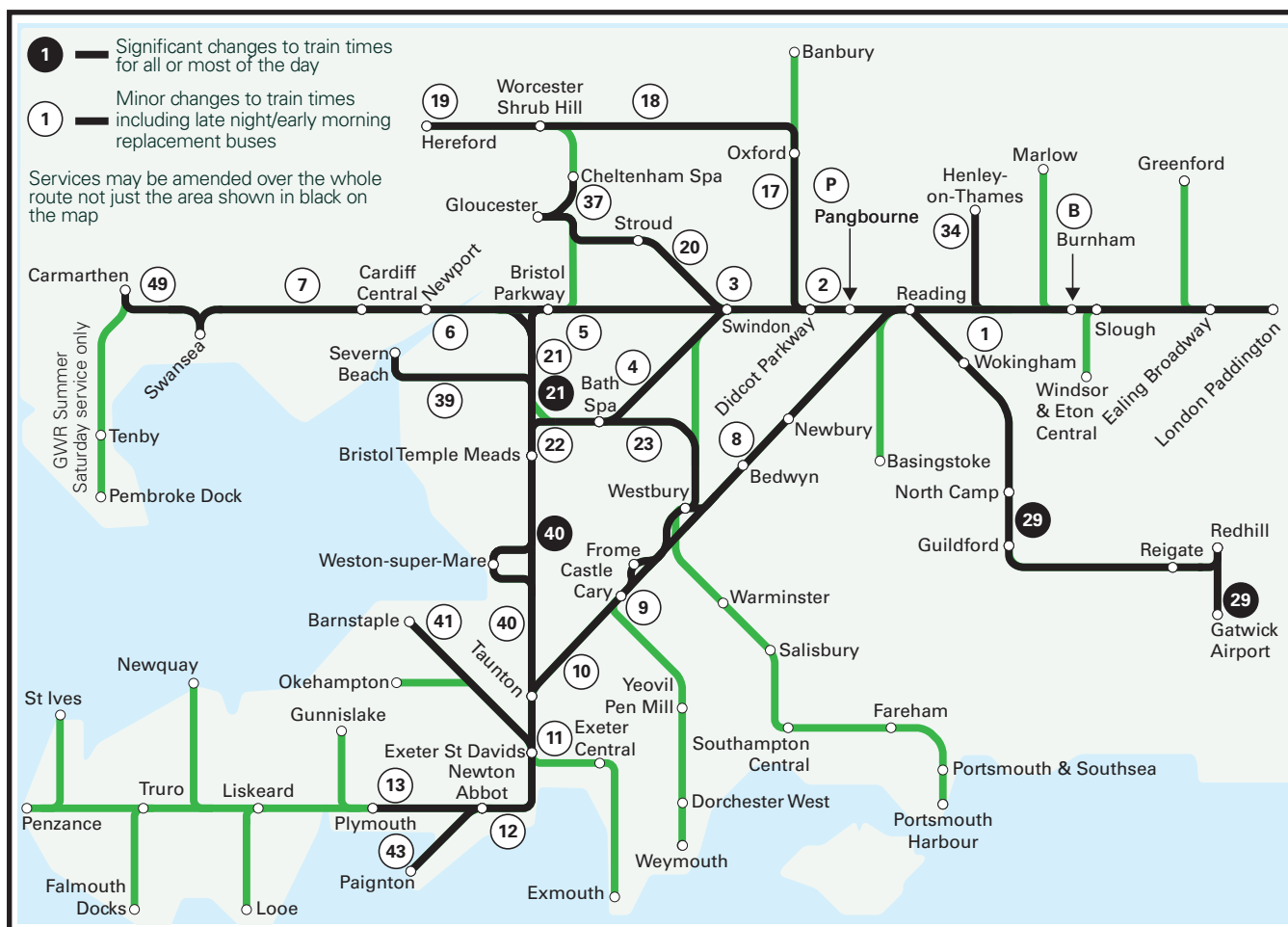


Summary of timetable changes

①	Sunday - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start from Slough and the 0620 Reading to London Paddington will finish its journey at Slough. Passengers travelling to / from stations east of Slough should use an alternative later service.
① ② ③ ④ ⑤ ⑥ ⑦ ⑧ ⑨ ⑩ ⑪ ⑫ ⑬ ⑰ ⑱ ⑲ ⑳ ㉔	Sunday - All day, High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be revised. Most trains FROM London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual, and many will then be subject to later retimings from Reading onwards. Most trains TO London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later at London Paddington. Most trains between London Paddington and Oxford will not call at Slough. A few trains will not run at all and a few other trains will make additional stops. Local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will be revised, with some trains running slightly EARLIER than usual. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journey before travelling.
④ ㉔	Monday to Thursday - The 2228 (departing 2230) & 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Swindon to run non-stop to Bristol Temple Meads, not calling at Chippenham or Bath Spa. Replacement buses will serve Chippenham and Bath Spa.
⑦	Sunday - The 2045 (departing 2038) & 2145 (departing 2138) London Paddington to Swansea will be subject to later retimings after departing from Cardiff Central. Monday to Thursday - The 2048, 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will be subject to later retimings after departing from Cardiff Central.
⑧	Monday to Thursday - The 2230 London Paddington to Bedwyn will start from Reading and will be slightly retimed. An alternative rail connection will be available from London Paddington to Reading. Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will be slightly retimed and will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington.
⑨ ㉔ ㉔	Monday to Thursday - The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will not run. Replacement buses will run from Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury and Frome. The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Temple Meads will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Bristol Temple Meads.
⑪ ④①	Saturday and Sunday - Due to engineering work taking place between Bristol Temple Meads and Weston-super-Mare (see later item), a few trains between Weston-super-Mare and Taunton / Exeter St Davids will not run. In addition, the 0735 (Saturday) (departing EARLIER at 0636) Bristol Temple Meads to Penzance WILL run, but will be diverted via an alternative route between Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton. The 2030 (Saturday) London Paddington to Exeter St Davids, 1745 (Saturday) Penzance to London Paddington and 2014 (Sunday) Plymouth to London Paddington WILL all run, but will be diverted via an alternative route between Chippenham and Taunton, calling additionally at Westbury. Monday to Wednesday - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, the 2243 Exeter St Davids to Bristol Temple Meads will run 3 minutes later as far as Weston-super-Mare. Normal timings from Weston-super-Mare onwards.
⑳ ③⑦	Monday to Thursday - The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will be diverted to run non-stop to, and finish its journey at, Gloucester. A replacement bus will run from Swindon to Cheltenham Spa, calling at intermediate stations via Stroud.
㉔	Saturday - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, local stopping services between Bristol Temple Meads and Filton Abbey Wood will not run. Some trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Cardiff Central / Gloucester will call additionally at Lawrence Hill, Stapleton Road and Lawrence Hill, and will be retimed, with some trains departing EARLIER than usual. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
㉔	Tuesday to Thursday - 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will be subject to later retimings after departing from Severn Tunnel Junction.

22 40	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Weston-super-Mare. A few other trains will not run, or will only run for part of their journey. Replacement buses will not serve Bedminster and Parson Street. Valid rail tickets will be accepted on local bus services serving these stations, as well as on all local bus services between Bristol Temple Meads and Weston-super-Mare, including those serving intermediate stations. Some trains from London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will arrive at Bristol Temple Meads later than usual. A few trains from Bristol Temple Meads to London Paddington will depart Bristol Temple Meads slightly EARLIER than usual.
29	Sunday - All day, buses will replace trains between Reading and Guildford. A reduced, hourly, rail service will run between Guildford and Redhill / Gatwick Airport. Some stations will only be served every 2 hours.
34	Tuesday to Thursday - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.
39	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, trains between Bristol Temple Meads, Avonmouth and Severn Beach will be subject to retimings. In some cases, trains will depart EARLIER than usual.
41	Monday to Wednesday - The 2054 Exmouth (2129 Exeter St Davids) to Barnstaple will finish its journey at Crediton. A replacement bus will run from Crediton to Barnstaple. The 2241 Barnstaple to Exeter St Davids will not run and will be replaced by a bus. In both cases, Yeoford will be served by a separate minibus / taxi shuttle to and from Crediton.
43	Saturday - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, the 1035 London Paddington to Paignton will finish its journey at Exeter St Davids and the 1455 Paignton to London Paddington will start from Exeter St Davids. Passengers should use alternative services, changing en-route where necessary, to complete their journey.
49	Saturday - The 0648 & 0848 London Paddington to Carmarthen will both finish their journeys at Swansea. The 1130 Carmarthen to London Paddington will start from Swansea. Passengers travelling to / from stations beyond Swansea should use alternative services, operated by Transport for Wales, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. The 1330 Carmarthen to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Passengers travelling from stations before Cardiff Central should use alternative services, changing en-route where necessary to complete their journey.
B	Tuesday to Friday - The 0001 & 0048 London Paddington to Reading and the 0019 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
	The following trains will not call at Pangbourne:
P	Monday to Wednesday - 2236 & 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2326 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington; Tuesday to Thursday - 0346 Oxford to Reading (no replacement transport provided - passengers should use the next available service); Friday - 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway; Unless otherwise stated, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.

RUGBY AT CARDIFF PRINCIPALITY STADIUM: WALES v JAPAN - Saturday 14 November 2026

Some additional trains will run between London Paddington and Cardiff Central, between Bristol Temple Meads and Cardiff Central and between Swansea and Cardiff Central. A few other trains on other routes will either not run, or will only run for part of their journey.

A few trains between Portsmouth Harbour and Cardiff Central will run as separate trains between Portsmouth Harbour and Bristol Temple Meads, then between Bristol Temple Meads and Cardiff Central. These trains will NOT connect at Bristol Temple Meads.
