


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday 4 to Friday 10 April 2026

Saturday - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will finish its journey at Ealing Broadway. TfL Central line connections will be available to central London, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.

① **Sunday** - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will not run. Passengers should use the next available service. The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will run later throughout.

Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service - Some trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings.

① ② **Sunday** - All day, most High Speed services from London Paddington will be retimed, in most cases departing EARLIER than usual. Most trains to London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later than usual. Most local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will only run between Reading and Didcot Parkway. Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford will be served by additional stops in services running between London Paddington and Swindon (sometimes beyond). **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

① ⑧ **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, trains between London Paddington / Reading and the West of England will be revised. Trains will either be diverted between Reading and Taunton, not calling at Newbury, Hungerford, Pewsey, Westbury or Castle Cary (**on Saturday only**, calling additionally at Bristol Temple Meads) or will either not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey. Trains between Bristol Temple Meads / Westbury and Weymouth will be revised and will not run between Westbury and Castle Cary. Replacement buses will run between Pewsey and Swindon (connecting at Swindon with diverted trains which will call there additionally), Westbury, Frome, Bruton and Castle Cary, and between Castle Cary and Taunton. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling, especially when travelling later in the day.**

⑪ ⑫ **Friday** - The 1203 London Paddington to Penzance and the 1549 Plymouth to London Paddington will run additionally. The 1205 London Paddington to Penzance will finish its journey at Plymouth. Please check online journey planners for specific stopping patterns and timings of these services.

⑦ **Sunday** - The 2045 (departing 2037) & 2145 (departing 2137) London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run later from Bridgend to Swansea.

Monday to Thursday - The 2048, 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run later from Bridgend to Swansea.

Monday - The 0510 Bristol Temple Meads to London Paddington and the 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will not run. The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. The 0618 Yeovil Pen Mill to Filton Abbey Wood will start from Westbury. The 1808 London Paddington to Frome will finish its journey at Newbury. In all cases, passengers travelling from stations no longer served should use the next available service.

⑧ ⑨ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury and the 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will both finish their journeys at Bath Spa. Replacement buses will run from Bath Spa to Westbury and Frome. The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Temple Meads will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Bath Spa, with a connecting rail service from Bath Spa to Bristol Temple Meads.

Monday to Thursday - The 2230 London Paddington to Bedwyn will start from Reading and will be slightly retimed. **Tuesday to Friday** - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will be slightly retimed and will finish its journey at Reading. In both cases, alternative rail connections will be available between London Paddington and Reading.

⑪ **Monday and Tuesday** - The 2348 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will arrive later at Exeter St Davids.

Monday to Wednesday - The 2345 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive later at Exeter St Davids.

⑯ ⑰ **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2115 until end of service** - Buses will replace trains between Oxford and Worcester Shrub Hill. Certain journeys will no longer be possible and passengers may need to travel EARLIER than usual to complete their journeys. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

Saturday - The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Westbury will no longer call at Eastleigh or Southampton Airport Parkway.

Sunday - The 1934 Bristol Temple Meads to Portsmouth Harbour will no longer call at Eastleigh Southampton Airport Parkway, Eastleigh, Botley and Hedge End and will run EARLIER from Fareham to Portsmouth Harbour.

25 26 Monday - The 2121 Bristol Parkway to Portsmouth & Southsea will run EARLIER from Fareham to Portsmouth & Southsea. The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Temple Meads (finishing its journey at Westbury) will no longer call at Eastleigh or Southampton Airport Parkway.
In all cases, passengers travelling to / from stations no longer served should use alternative services operated by SWR.

33 Monday - All day, a revised hourly service will run between Maidenhead, Bourne End and Marlow.

34 Tuesday to Thursday - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.

39 Monday to Thursday - The 2308 Severn Beach to Bristol Temple Meads will arrive 7 minutes later at Bristol Temple Meads.

Saturday - Some trains between London Paddington and Weston-super-Mare / Taunton that run via Bristol Temple Meads will only run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers should use other scheduled rail services between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton to complete their journey.

42 Monday - The 1631 Barnstaple to Axminster will finish its journey at Exeter St Davids. Passengers travelling beyond Exeter St Davids should use alternative replacement bus services, operated on behalf of SWR.

43 Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, direct trains between London Paddington and Paignton will not run. Also, **on Saturday**, 2005 Paignton to Newton Abbot will not run. Passengers should use alternative services, changing en-route where necessary to complete their journey.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:

Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to Ealing Broadway;

Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading;

B Tuesday to Friday - 0001 & 0049 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington;
In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: Sunday - 0640 & 0742 Reading to London Paddington, 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2352 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

The following trains will not call at Pangbourne:

Monday to Thursday - 2236 & 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2326 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

Tuesday to Friday - 0355 Oxford to Reading (no replacement transport provided - passengers should use the next available service);

Friday - 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway;

In all cases, unless otherwise stated, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
