


Summary of timetable changes

1 **Saturday** - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will finish its journey at Ealing Broadway. **Sunday** - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start from Ealing Broadway and will run slightly later throughout. TfL Central line connections will be available to / from central London, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.

2 **Sunday** - The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will run later throughout.

3 **Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service** - Some trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings.

4 **1 2 Sunday** - All day, most High Speed services from London Paddington will be retimed, in most cases departing EARLIER than usual. Most trains to London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later than usual. Most local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will only run between Reading and Didcot Parkway. Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford will be served by additional stops in services running between London Paddington and Swindon (sometimes beyond). **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

5 **1 8 Sunday until approximately 1500** - Trains between London Paddington / Reading and the West of England will be revised. Some trains will be diverted between Reading and Taunton, not calling at Newbury, Hungerford, Pewsey, Westbury or Castle Cary. A few other trains will not run at all. Replacement buses will run between Pewsey and Swindon (connecting at Swindon with diverted trains which will call there additionally) and between Castle Cary and Taunton.

6 **1 8 Friday** - The 1203 London Paddington to Penzance and the 1549 Plymouth to London Paddington will run additionally. The 1205 London Paddington to Penzance will finish its journey at Plymouth. Please check online journey planners for specific stopping patterns and timings of these services.

10 **2 3 Monday to Thursday** - The 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading, not calling at Didcot Parkway, Swindon or Chippenham. Passengers for these stations should travel on the 2314 (departing 2316 on Monday to Wednesday) London Paddington to Oxford which will call additionally at Didcot Parkway. A replacement bus will connect out of this train, running to Swindon and Chippenham. Passengers travelling from Didcot Parkway, Swindon and Chippenham to Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads should travel on an EARLIER service.

11 **4 22 Saturday and Sunday** - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, the 0846 (**Saturday**) Cheltenham Spa to Bristol Temple Meads (via Swindon) and the 1053 (**Sunday**) Swindon to Bristol Temple Meads will not run. Passengers should use alternative earlier or later services.

12 **5 6 Monday to Thursday** - The 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Swindon to call additionally at Chippenham and Bath Spa, and will run later from Bristol Parkway to Swansea.

13 **7 Sunday** - The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Replacement buses will run from Swansea and from Neath, Port Talbot Parkway and Bridgend to Cardiff Central, to connect into the train.

14 **Monday to Thursday** - The 2048, 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will be subject to minor retimings beyond Cardiff Central.

15 **8 Saturday until approximately 0700** - Buses will replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn.

16 **Sunday** - The 2323 Newbury to Reading will not run and will be replaced by a bus.

17 **Saturday** - The 2215 & 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will both finish their journeys at Westbury. 2316 Frome to Westbury will not run. Replacement buses will run between Westbury and Frome.

18 **9 28 Sunday until approximately 1500** - Buses will replace trains between Westbury, Frome and (until approximately 1000), Castle Cary. A few trains will not run, or will only run for part of their journey. Some trains between Swindon and Westbury will also be slightly retimed. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

Sunday - The 2350 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive slightly later at Exeter St Davids. The 2115 Penzance to London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER from Exeter St Davids.

11 **Monday to Thursday** - The 2305 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will finish its journey at Taunton and the 2348 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will be replaced by a bus. The 2345 London Paddington to Penzance and the 2145 Penzance to London Paddington will not call at Taunton. Passengers travelling to / from Taunton should use EARLIER services.

Saturday - All day, buses will replace trains between Stroud and Gloucester. Trains between Swindon and Stroud will be retimed. Passengers should use other scheduled rail services to travel between Gloucester and Cheltenham Spa.

20 37 **Sunday** - All day, buses will replace trains between Swindon and Gloucester. Passengers should use other scheduled rail services to travel between Gloucester and Cheltenham Spa.

Monday - The 0511 Gloucester to Southampton Central will start from Swindon. Passengers should travel on the next available service.

21 38 **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Bristol Parkway and Gloucester. Some trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway will be revised.

22 23 **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, trains between Cardiff Central / Bristol Temple Meads and Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted between Romsey and Fareham, not calling at Southampton Central, but calling additionally at Chandlers Ford and Eastleigh. Replacement buses will run between Southampton Central and Eastleigh. A few other trains will either not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

40 **Sunday** - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, the 1030 (departing 1033) London Paddington to Weston-super-Mare will finish its journey at Bristol Temple Meads. The 1328 Weston-super-Mare to London Paddington will start from Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers travelling to stations beyond Bristol Temple Meads should use alternative earlier or later services.

43 **Sunday** - Direct trains between London Paddington and Paignton will not run. Passengers should use alternative services, changing en-route where necessary to complete their journey.

B **Saturday** - 0049 London Paddington to Reading will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
