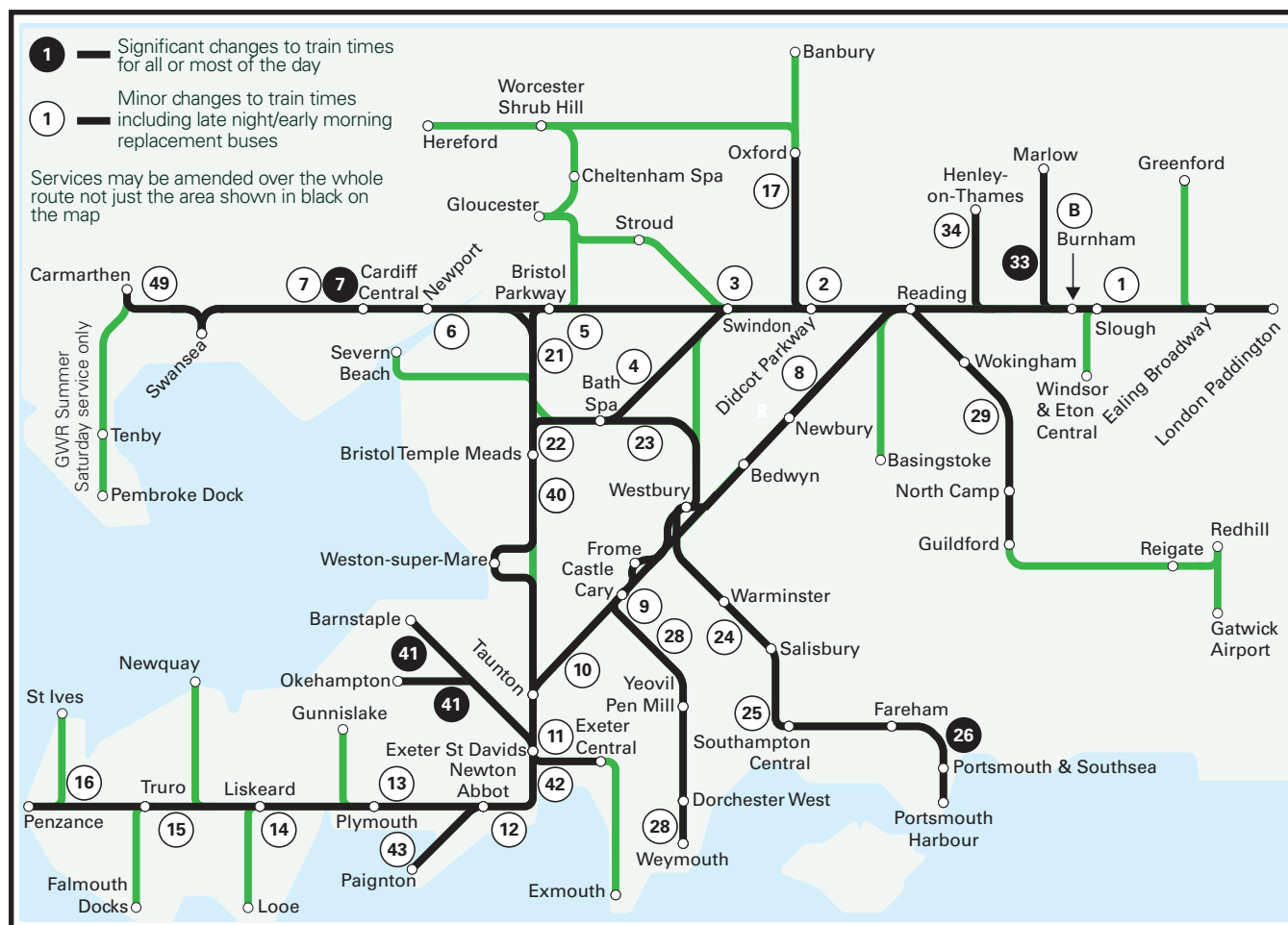

①	Saturday - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will finish its journey at Ealing Broadway. Sunday - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start from Ealing Broadway and will run slightly later throughout. TfL Central line connections will be available to / from central London, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. Sunday - The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will run later throughout. Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service - Some trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings.
① ② ③	Sunday - All day, some High Speed services from London Paddington will be retimed, in most cases departing a few minutes EARLIER than usual. Most trains to London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later than usual. Most local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will be slightly retimed for all or part of their journey.
① ⑧ ⑨ ⑩ ⑪ ⑫ ⑬ ⑭ ⑮ ⑯	Thursday - The 1203 London Paddington to Penzance and the 1549 Plymouth to London Paddington will run additionally. The 1205 London Paddington to Penzance will finish its journey at Plymouth. Please check online journey planners for specific stopping patterns and timings of these services.
① ⑧ ⑨ ⑩ ⑪ ⑫ ⑬ ⑳ ④①	Friday from approximately 1800 until end of service - Trains between London Paddington / Reading and the West of England will be revised. Some trains will be diverted to run non-stop between Reading and Taunton. Trains will depart EARLIER from London Paddington and Reading. Some trains will only run between London Paddington and Westbury. A few trains will not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey. Trains between Bristol Temple Meads / Westbury and Weymouth will be revised and will not run between Westbury and Castle Cary. The 1609 Gloucester to Weymouth will finish its journey at Westbury. Limited replacement buses will run between Westbury, Frome, Bruton and Castle Cary, and between Castle Cary and Taunton. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling, especially when travelling later in the day.
⑦ ④⑨	Sunday - All day, trains will not run between Cardiff Central and Swansea. Non-stop buses will run between Cardiff Central and Swansea instead. Passengers travelling to / from Bridgend, Port Talbot Parkway or Neath should use alternative replacement buses (between Cardiff Central and Port Talbot Parkway) and rail services (between Port Talbot Parkway and Swansea) operated by TfW. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
⑧ ⑨ ⑫ ⑬ ⑳	Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service each day - Buses will replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn. Monday to Thursday - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury will depart at 2310 and run slightly later throughout. Tuesday to Thursday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington. The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. An EARLIER connecting service will run from Frome to Westbury. Friday - The 0510 Bristol Temple Meads to London Paddington and the 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will not run. The 0618 Yeovil Pen Mill to Filton Abbey Wood will start from Westbury. In all cases, passengers travelling from stations no longer served should use the next available service.
⑪ ⑫ ⑬	Saturday - 2155 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids and 2030 London Paddington to Exeter St Davids will both finish their journeys at Taunton. A replacement bus will run from Taunton to Tiverton Parkway and Exeter St Davids. Sunday until approximately 12noon - A reduced service will run between Taunton and Exeter St Davids. Some trains will be replaced by buses. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
⑪ ④①	Monday to Thursday from approximately 2200 until end of service - Trains between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton will either be diverted to run non-stop between Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton, or will either only run for part of their journey, or will not run at all. Buses will run between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton / Exeter St Davids, in place of diverted or cancelled trains.
⑫①	Monday - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will run a few minutes later from Patchway onwards.

24 25 26	Saturday to Thursday - All week, buses will replace trains between Fareham and Portsmouth Harbour. A few other trains will only run for part of their journey. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
	Friday - The 0450 Fratton to Bristol Temple Meads will start from Southampton Central and the 0601 Portsmouth Harbour to Cardiff Central will start from Fareham. Passengers travelling from stations no longer served should use a later service. The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Temple Meads will no longer call at Eastleigh or Southampton Airport Parkway. Passengers travelling to / from these stations should use alternative replacement buses operated on behalf of SWR.
29	Monday to Wednesday - The 2322 Gatwick Airport to Reading will finish its journey at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Reading. Tuesday to Thursday - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport will start from Guildford. A replacement bus will run EARLIER from Reading, non-stop to Guildford. Passengers travelling from other stations should use the next available service.
33	Sunday from approximately 1000 until end of service - Trains will run up to 7 minutes later than usual, to maintain connections with retimed services between London Paddington, Maidenhead, Reading and Didcot Parkway. Friday - All day, a revised hourly service will run between Maidenhead, Bourne End and Marlow.
34	Sunday - The 2200 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection, operated by Elizabeth line, will be available from Twyford to Reading, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.
41 42	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Exeter St Davids and Okehampton / Barnstaple. A revised service will run between Exeter St Davids, Exeter Central and St James' Park.
B	Saturday - The 0001 & 0049 London Paddington to Reading and the 0021 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow. Sunday - The 2331 London Paddington to Reading and the 2352 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will not call at Burnham. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

RUGBY AT CARDIFF: BRISTOL v HARLEQUINS 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 21 22 40

On **Saturday 28 March**, a revised service will run on all routes to / from Cardiff Central. Some trains on other routes will either not run, or will only run for part of their journey.
