

1. The Railcard is not valid unless it has been signed by the holder. 2. The Railcard is not transferable. The holder must travel on all occasions when the railcard is being used. 3. The Railcard must be presented when buying discounted tickets. 4. The Railcard must be carried on all journeys for which it is being used. 5. The holder must show the valid Railcard when requested by rail staff otherwise a full fare will be payable. 6. If the Railcard becomes defaced, illegible or torn it will not be valid and a new Railcard will need to be purchased. 7. Discounted tickets are available on services operated by Great Western Railway and West Midlands Trains, or their successors. 8. The train companies may refuse to issue or renew a Railcard and do not undertake to replace lost or stolen Railcards. 9. Discounted tickets are issued subject to the National Rail Conditions of Travel and the conditions listed in this leaflet. 10. Discounted tickets cease to be valid upon expiry of the Railcard. 11. Tickets must be bought before boarding the train unless ticket issuing facilities are not available at the station. If this requirement is not met, Railcard holders will be required to pay the full Standard Single or Return fare without the benefit of any discount.

Which tickets receive a discount?

Cotswold Line railcard holders receive 1/3 off the price of Standard Class Single and Day Return tickets for travel wholly with the Cotswold Line Railcard area.

Discounts are applied on all Off-Peak services on Mondays to Fridays and all day on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays.

The Cotswold Railcard is NOT valid on the morning service from Shipton, Ascott-under-Wychwood, Finstock or Combe.
