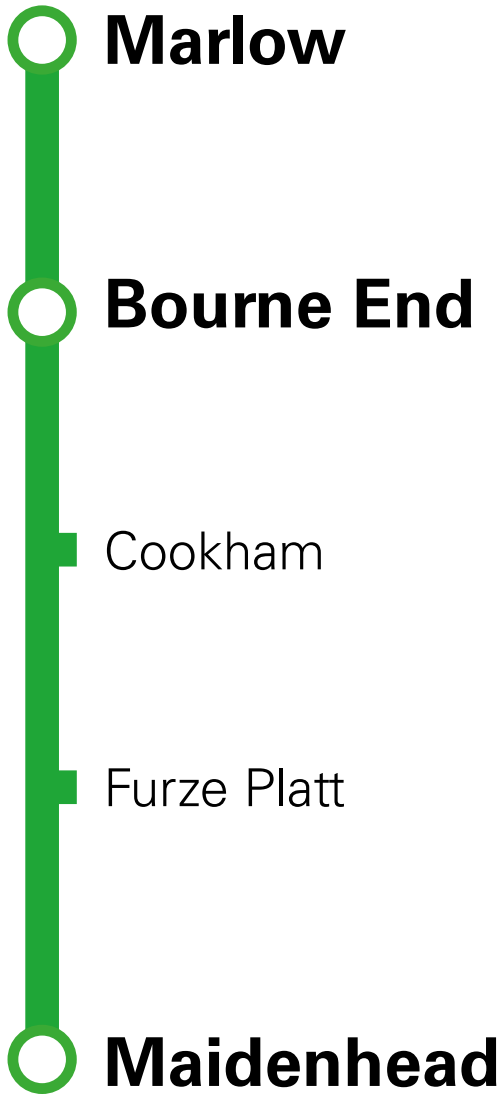



If you buy a ticket on the day of travel, we may allocate you a space instead of a specific seat. Sit in any unreserved seat in your class of travel, social distancing as best you can.

Contactless customers wishing to travel on the Henley-on-Thames, Marlow and Windsor branch lines, or beyond Reading, will need to 'tap in' or 'tap out' at the gateline of the mainline station and be in possession of a normal ticket for the rest of their journeys.
