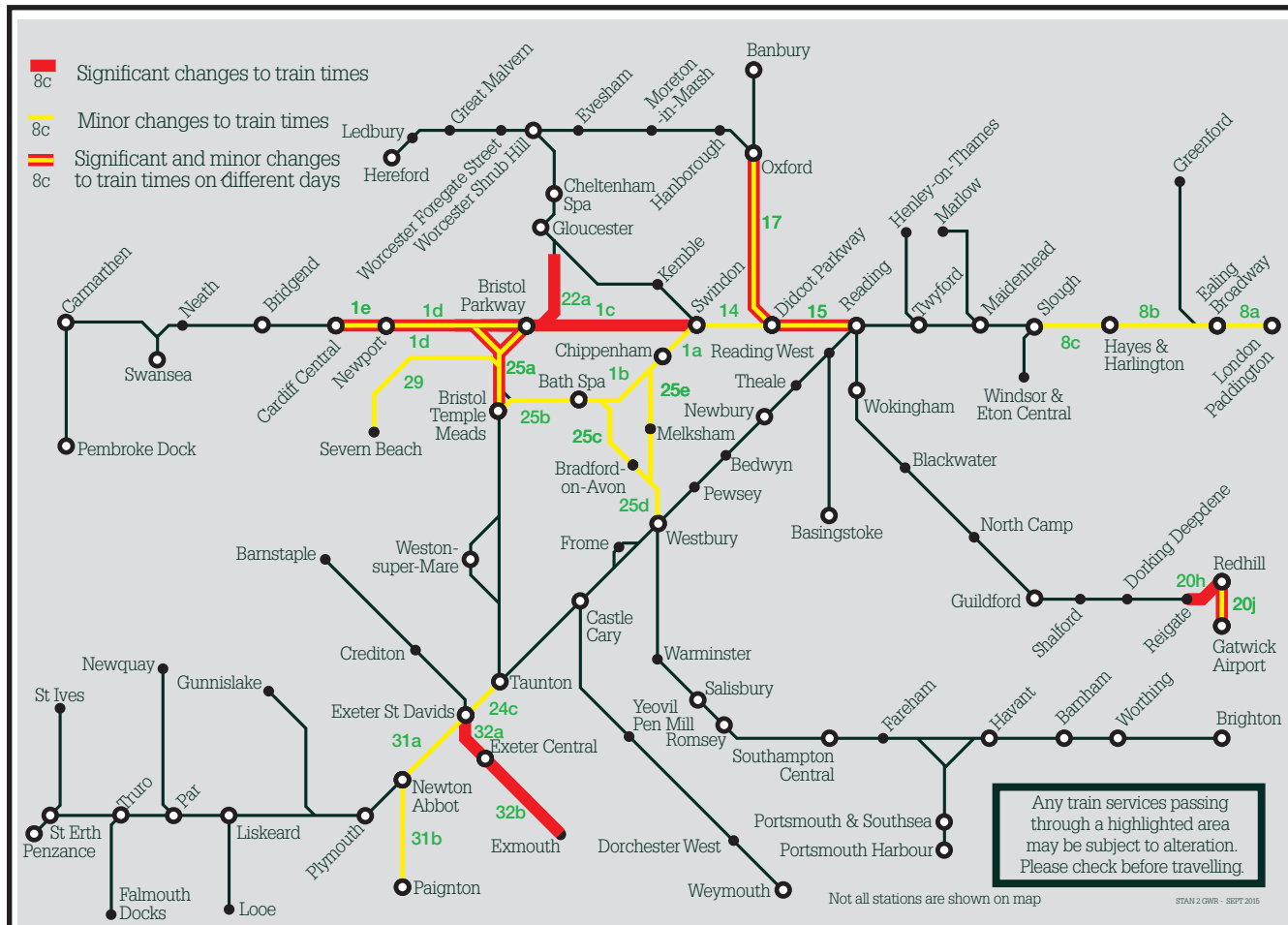


Summary of timetable changes

Area	DETAILS
1a, 1b, 14, 15 ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2215 until end of service, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted, not calling at Didcot Parkway, Swindon and Chippenham. Please use either replacement train or bus services as appropriate to complete your journey if travelling to/from these stations.
1c, 1d ●	Saturday and Sunday – All weekend, trains between London Paddington and South/West Wales will be diverted between Swindon and Newport, with journey time increases of around 35 minutes. On Saturday, most westbound trains will depart EARLIER from London Paddington, Reading and Swindon. Trains will not call at Bristol Parkway, but most will call additionally at Patchway. Replacement buses will run between Patchway and Bristol Parkway. For more information, please visit GWR.com/BristolParkway2017
1c, 1d ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – All week, trains between London Paddington and South/West Wales will be reduced in frequency and will be diverted between Swindon and Newport, with journey time increases of around 35 minutes. Most westbound trains will depart EARLIER from London Paddington, Reading and Swindon. Trains will not call at Bristol Parkway, but most will call additionally at Patchway. Replacement buses will run between Patchway and Bristol Parkway. For more information, please visit GWR.com/BristolParkway2017
1d ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – In addition to the above, the 2029 Swansea to London Paddington service will, after calling additionally at Patchway, be diverted to terminate at Bristol Temple Meads. A rail connection will be available to London Paddington, calling at intermediate stations.
1e ●	Saturday – All day, a revised service will run between Newport and Cardiff Central. Most trains from Cardiff Central to Newport will depart EARLIER than usual.
8a – 8c ●	Sunday – The 0800 London Paddington to Penzance and the 0803 London Paddington to Great Malvern services will depart 3 minutes EARLIER from London Paddington.
15 ●	Saturday, Sunday and Monday – From approximately 2045 Saturday, all day Sunday and until approximately 0515 Monday, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst. On Sunday, the 0759 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington service will start from Reading, with a replacement bus departing EARLIER from Didcot Parkway to Reading.
15, 17 ●	Sunday – From approximately 1030 to 2100, most local stopping trains from Oxford to London Paddington will depart up to 15 minutes EARLIER from stations between Oxford and Reading.
17 ●	Sunday – The 0715 replacement bus from Oxford to Didcot Parkway will run 25 minutes later throughout.
20h, 20j ●	Saturday and Sunday – All weekend, buses will replace trains between Reigate, Redhill and Gatwick Airport. There will also be an hourly replacement bus service running directly between Reigate and Gatwick Airport.
20j ●	Friday – The 2334 Reading to Gatwick Airport service will terminate at Redhill. Please use other operators' services to complete your journey if travelling to Gatwick Airport.
22a, 25a ●	All week – Buses will replace trains between Yate, Bristol Parkway and Filton Abbey Wood. Some early morning/late evening buses will be extended to run to/from Bristol Temple Meads.
24c ●	Wednesday and Thursday – The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids and the 2145 London Paddington to Exeter St Davids services will arrive up to 25 minutes later than advertised at Tiverton Parkway and Exeter St Davids.
25a – 25d, 29 ●	All week – Some trains will be subject to alterations in the Bristol area. Some trains will not call at some local stations, and other trains will make additional stops. Some trains will also run EARLIER than usual, or will not run at all.
25d, 25e ●	Saturday – Some trains between Westbury and Swindon will run to a revised timetable. The 1522 Swindon to Warminster service will depart at 1512 and run EARLIER as far as Melksham.

Area	DETAILS
31a, 31b ●	Sunday – Some trains between Exeter St Davids and Newton Abbot/Paignton will be subject to retimings.
32a, 32b ●	Sunday – All day, (and including 0001 Monday morning service from Exmouth to Exeter St Davids), buses will replace trains between Exeter St Davids/Exeter Central and Exmouth. For details of specific stopping arrangements at intermediate stations, please see local publicity.
