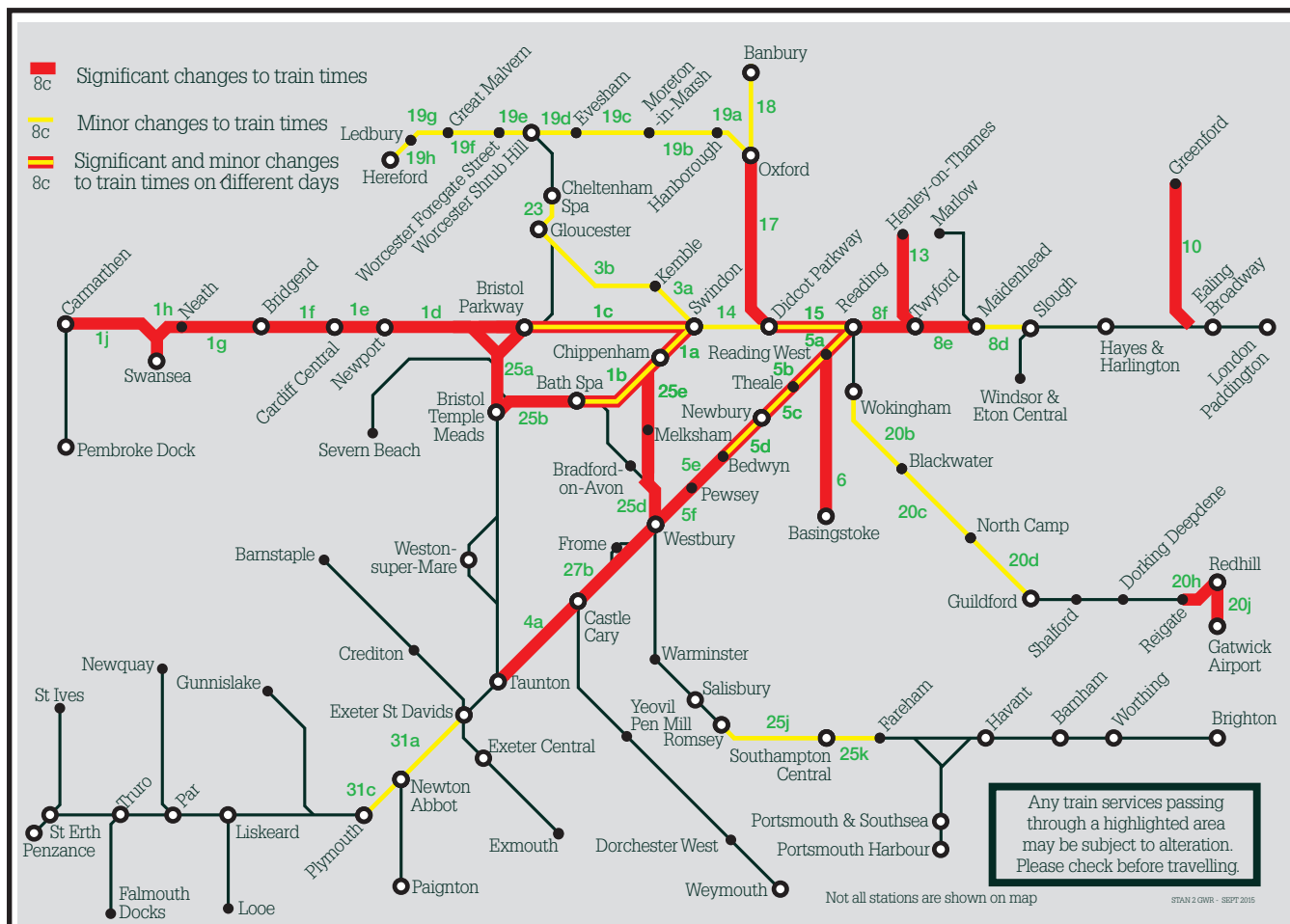


Summary of timetable changes

Area	DETAILS
1a – 1j, 25a, 25b ●	<p>Saturday, Sunday and Monday – From approximately 0800 Saturday, all day Sunday and until 0200 Monday, a revised GWR service will run on all routes. Trains to/from London Paddington will be diverted via alternative routes and will run to a reduced frequency. In addition, trains between London and South Wales will run via Bristol Parkway, and trains between Portsmouth Harbour and Bristol Parkway will be diverted to run to/from Cardiff Central. Replacement buses between Swindon and Bristol Parkway and between Bristol Parkway and Newport will not run. For more details, please visit GWR.com/Reading2017</p>
1a, 25d, 25e ●	<p>Saturday and Sunday – All weekend, most trains between Swindon and Westbury will be retimed, with some trains running EARLIER than usual.</p>
1a – 1c, 14 ●	<p>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2145 until end of service, trains between London Paddington and South Wales/Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted and will not call at Didcot Parkway, Swindon or Chippenham. Replacement buses will serve these stations. The 2029 Swansea to London Paddington service will be diverted after Bristol Parkway to terminate at Bristol Temple Meads.</p>
3a, 3b, 23 ●	<p>Sunday – All day, trains between London Paddington and Cheltenham Spa will run between Swindon and Cheltenham Spa only.</p>
5a – 5d ●	<p>Saturday – Until approximately 1400, there will be minor retimings to trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn, with some trains departing EARLIER than usual.</p>
5a, 5b, 6, 8e, 8f, 15 ●	<p>Saturday, Sunday and Monday – From approximately 1400 Saturday, all day Sunday and until 0200 Monday, there will be no GWR trains running through Reading station. High speed services to/from London Paddington will be diverted via alternative routes. Buses will replace trains for local journeys between Maidenhead and Reading, Reading and Didcot Parkway, Reading and Basingstoke and Reading and Theale. All long-distance services on other routes will be altered as a result of this work. For more details, please visit GWR.com/Reading2017</p>
4a, 5c – 5f, 27b ●	<p>Saturday, Sunday and Monday – From approximately 1400 Saturday, all day Sunday and until 0200 Monday, a special rail service will run between Theale and Taunton, via Newbury, Pewsey, Westbury and Castle Cary. For more details, please visit GWR.com/Reading2017</p>
8d ●	<p>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2215 each evening until 0500 next morning, trains will not call at Burnham and Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.</p>
8d ●	<p>Friday – The 2349 London Paddington to Reading and the 2315 Reading to London Paddington services will not call at Burnham and Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.</p>
10 ●	<p>Saturday – From approximately 1300, services between West Ealing and Greenford will be reduced to hourly.</p>
13 ●	<p>Saturday and Sunday – From approximately 0830 to 1330 Saturday, services between Twyford and Henley-on-Thames will run to a revised timetable, with most trains running EARLIER than usual. From approximately 1330 Saturday and all day Sunday, buses will replace trains between Twyford and Henley-on-Thames, at a reduced hourly frequency.</p>
15, 17 ●	<p>Saturday – Until approximately 1400, fast services between London and Oxford will not run. Replacement buses will run between Reading and Didcot Parkway.</p>
15 ●	<p>Friday – From approximately 2345 (and until 0530 Saturday 23 September), trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.</p>
18 ●	<p>Saturday – All day, some GWR trains between Oxford and Banbury will be retimed.</p>
19a – 19h ●	<p>Saturday and Sunday – From approximately 0800 Saturday and all day Sunday, trains to/from London Paddington will not run between Didcot Parkway and London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Didcot Parkway and Reading (until approximately 1400 Saturday) or between Didcot Parkway and Maidenhead (at all other times), with alternative rail connections available between Oxford and London Marylebone (operated by Chiltern Railways) and between Maidenhead and London Paddington.</p>

Area	DETAILS
20b – 20d ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – The 2318 (Monday to Thursday) Gatwick Airport to Reading service will terminate at Guildford. The 0434 (Tuesday to Friday) Reading to Gatwick Airport service will start from Guildford. Replacement buses will run between Guildford and Reading.
20h, 20j ●	Saturday and Sunday – All weekend , buses will replace trains between Reigate, Redhill and Gatwick Airport. There will also be an hourly replacement bus service running directly between Reigate and Gatwick Airport.
25j, 25k ●	Sunday – The 0819 Romsey to Brighton service will not call at Southampton Central, but will call additionally at Eastleigh. Replacement buses will run between Eastleigh and Southampton Central.
31a, 31c ●	Monday and Tuesday – From approximately 2330 until 0530 next morning , some trains will be subject to minor retimings between Plymouth and Exeter St Davids. The 2221 Gunnislake to Exeter St Davids service will terminate at Newton Abbot, with a connecting rail service to Exeter St Davids.
