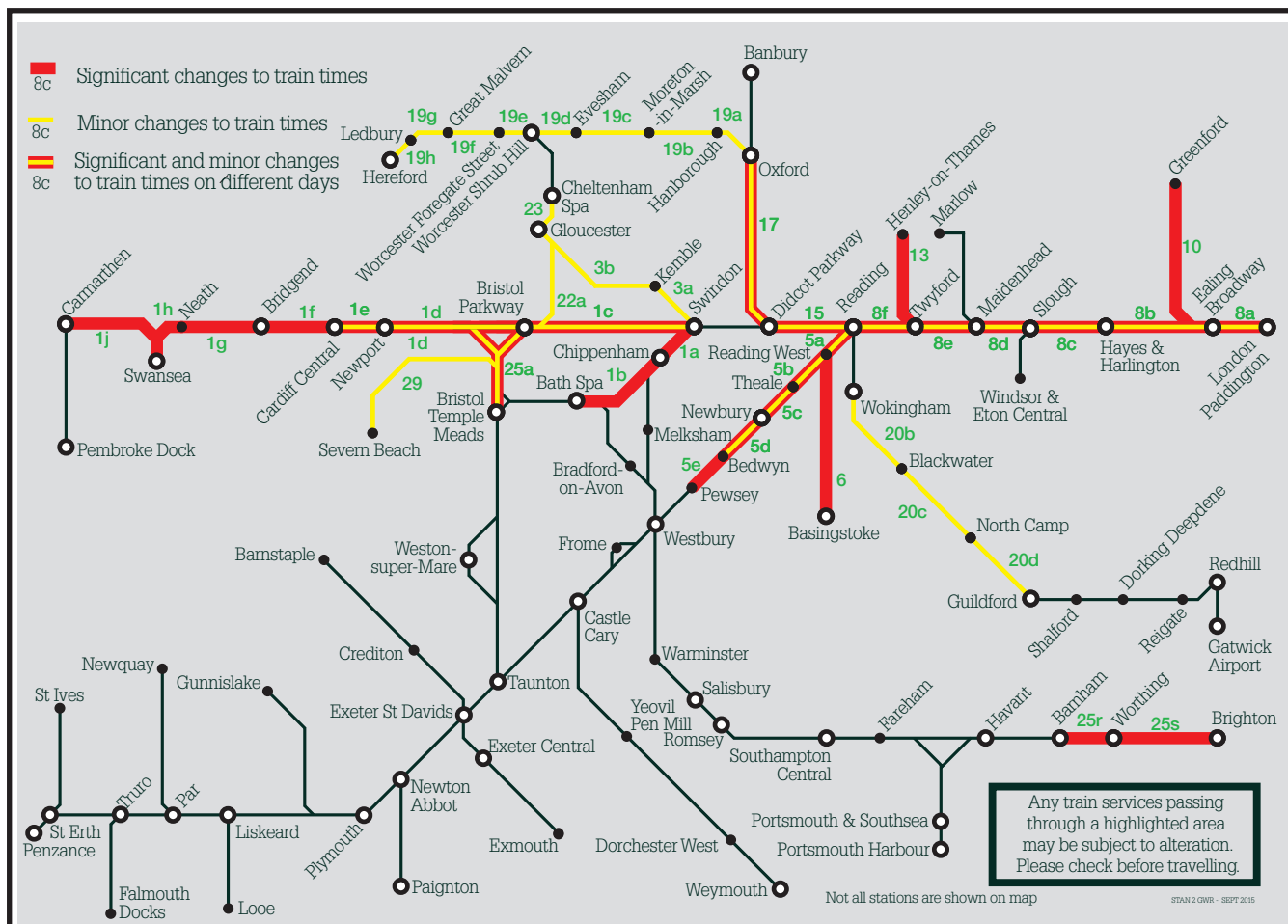


## Summary of timetable changes

**Due to late notice Crossrail improvement work on Saturday, all trains running to/from London Paddington will be amended. Most trains from London Paddington will depart EARLIER than usual.**

Area	DETAILS
1a, 1b, 25a ●	<b>Sunday – Until approximately 1230</b> , trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads will not run between London Paddington and Didcot Parkway. Some trains will be extended to run from/to Oxford. Alternative trains, operated by Chiltern Railways, will run between London Marylebone and Oxford.
1c, 1d, 1e, 25a ●	<b>Sunday – All day</b> , direct trains between London Paddington and South Wales will NOT run. A special service will run between either London Paddington (from approximately 1230) or Oxford (until approximately 1230) and Bristol Parkway/Bristol Temple Meads. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway, Newport and Cardiff Central.
1c, 25a ●	<b>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday</b> – The 0447 Bristol Temple Meads to London Paddington service will not call at Bristol Parkway. A replacement bus will depart EARLIER from Bristol Parkway to Bristol Temple Meads to connect with the train.
1d, 1e ●	<b>Saturday</b> – The 2200 London Paddington to Cardiff Central service will be diverted after Swindon to terminate at Bristol Parkway. A replacement bus will run from Bristol Parkway to Newport and Cardiff Central.
1d, 1e, 25a ●	<b>Sunday – All day</b> , a revised service will run between Bristol Temple Meads, Bristol Parkway, Newport and Cardiff Central. Most services to/from Newport and Cardiff Central will be operated by replacement buses. The 2237 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads service will terminate at Bristol Parkway, with NO alternative transport to Bristol Temple Meads. Please travel on the 2303 service from London Paddington.
1d, 1e, 22a, 25a ●	<b>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2115 until end of service</b> , a revised service will run between Bristol Temple Meads and Cardiff Central. Some trains will not run and other trains will be replaced by buses between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway. Trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Gloucester/Cheltenham Spa/Worcester Shrub Hill will be replaced by buses between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway. The 2330 London Paddington to Cardiff Central service will be replaced by a bus from Bristol Temple Meads to Cardiff Central.
1e ●	<b>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – All day</b> , a reduced train service will run between Newport and Cardiff Central.
1f – 1j ●	<b>Sunday – All day</b> , a revised GWR service will run between Cardiff Central and Swansea/Carmarthen.
1f ●	<b>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – All day</b> , trains from London Paddington to Cardiff Central/South Wales will arrive up to 7 minutes later than usual at Cardiff Central and stations beyond.
3a, 3b, 23 ●	<b>Saturday – All day</b> , trains between London Paddington and Cheltenham Spa will run between Swindon and Cheltenham Spa only. Please use other rail services to complete your journey if travelling to/from stations between London Paddington and Swindon.
3a, 3b, 23 ●	<b>Sunday – Until approximately 1230</b> , trains between London Paddington and Cheltenham Spa will not run between London Paddington and Swindon. Please use alternative road/rail connections to travel to/from London.
5a – 5e ●	<b>Sunday – Until approximately 1230</b> , buses will replace trains between Reading and Theale. A revised train service will run between Theale and Newbury/Bedwyn, with some trains running EARLIER than usual. Long-distance services between London and the West of England will not run between London Paddington and Newbury. Please use alternative trains between London Paddington and Slough, and replacement buses between Slough and Newbury. The 1133 London Paddington to Paignton service will not run (but will be replaced in part by an 1154 Didcot Parkway to Paignton service, running via Bristol Temple Meads) and the 1157 London Paddington to Penzance service will call at Pewsey instead of Newbury.
5a – 5d ●	<b>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2200 until end of service each evening</b> , buses will replace trains between Reading and Newbury/Bedwyn.
6 ●	<b>Sunday – Until approximately 1300</b> , buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke.

Area	DETAILS
8a – 8d	<p><b>Saturday – All day</b>, a revised service will run between London Paddington and Reading. In most cases, stopping trains will run between London Paddington and Maidenhead only, with separate trains running between Maidenhead and Reading (and mostly continuing to Didcot Parkway and Oxford).</p>
8a – 8f	<p><b>Saturday – All day</b>, all long distance services running to/from London Paddington will be revised. Many services will depart EARLIER than usual from London Paddington.</p>
8d	<p><b>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2215 each evening until end of service</b>, trains will not call at Burnham and Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.</p>
8d	<p><b>Saturday – Until approximately 0630</b>, trains will not call at Burnham and Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.</p>
8d	<p><b>Sunday and Monday – From approximately 2215 Sunday until 0515 Monday</b>, trains will not call at Burnham. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.</p>
8e – 8f	<p><b>Sunday – Until approximately 1230</b>, buses will replace trains between Maidenhead, Twyford and Reading.</p>
8e	<p><b>Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday</b> – If you are travelling on the 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading service, you will need to change trains at Twyford.</p>
10	<p><b>Saturday – All day</b>, trains between London Paddington/West Ealing will NOT run. You will need to use alternative TfL local bus or Tube services to complete your journey.</p>
13	<p><b>Sunday – Until approximately 1300 Sunday</b>, buses will replace trains between Twyford and Henley-on-Thames, at a reduced hourly frequency.</p>
15, 17	<p><b>Saturday – All day</b>, stopping trains between London Paddington/Reading and Didcot Parkway/Oxford will run to a revised timetable. Most trains will run between Maidenhead/Reading and Didcot Parkway/Oxford only, but alternative rail services will be available between London Paddington and Maidenhead.</p>
15, 17	<p><b>Sunday – Until approximately 1230</b>, fast services between London and Oxford will not run. Replacement buses will run between Reading and Didcot Parkway. A revised train service will run between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. Alternative trains, operated by Chiltern Railways, will run between London Marylebone and Oxford.</p>
19a – 19h	<p><b>Sunday – Until approximately 1230</b>, trains to/from London Paddington will not run between Didcot Parkway and London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Didcot Parkway and Maidenhead, with alternative rail connections available between Oxford and London Marylebone (operated by Chiltern Railways) and between Maidenhead and London Paddington.</p>
20b – 20d	<p><b>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday</b> – The 2318 (Monday to Thursday) Gatwick Airport to Reading service will terminate at Guildford. The 0434 (Tuesday to Friday) Reading to Gatwick Airport service will start from Guildford. Replacement buses will run between Guildford and Reading.</p>
25a, 29	<p><b>Saturday and Sunday – From approximately 2230 Saturday until 1045 Sunday</b>, trains between Bristol Parkway / Lawrence Hill and Bristol Temple Meads will be revised, with some trains running EARLIER than usual. On Sunday, the 1023 Bristol Temple Meads to Avonmouth service will depart at 1040 and terminate at Clifton Down. The 1052 Avonmouth to Bristol Temple Meads service will start from Clifton Down at 1104. NO alternative transport will be provided.</p>
25r, 25s	<p><b>Sunday – All day</b>, GWR trains will be replaced by buses between Barnham and Brighton. The 2146 Brighton to Portsmouth Harbour service will not run. Please use alternative services provided by Southern.</p>
29	<p><b>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2130 until end of service each evening</b>, buses will replace trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Avonmouth/Severn Beach.</p>
