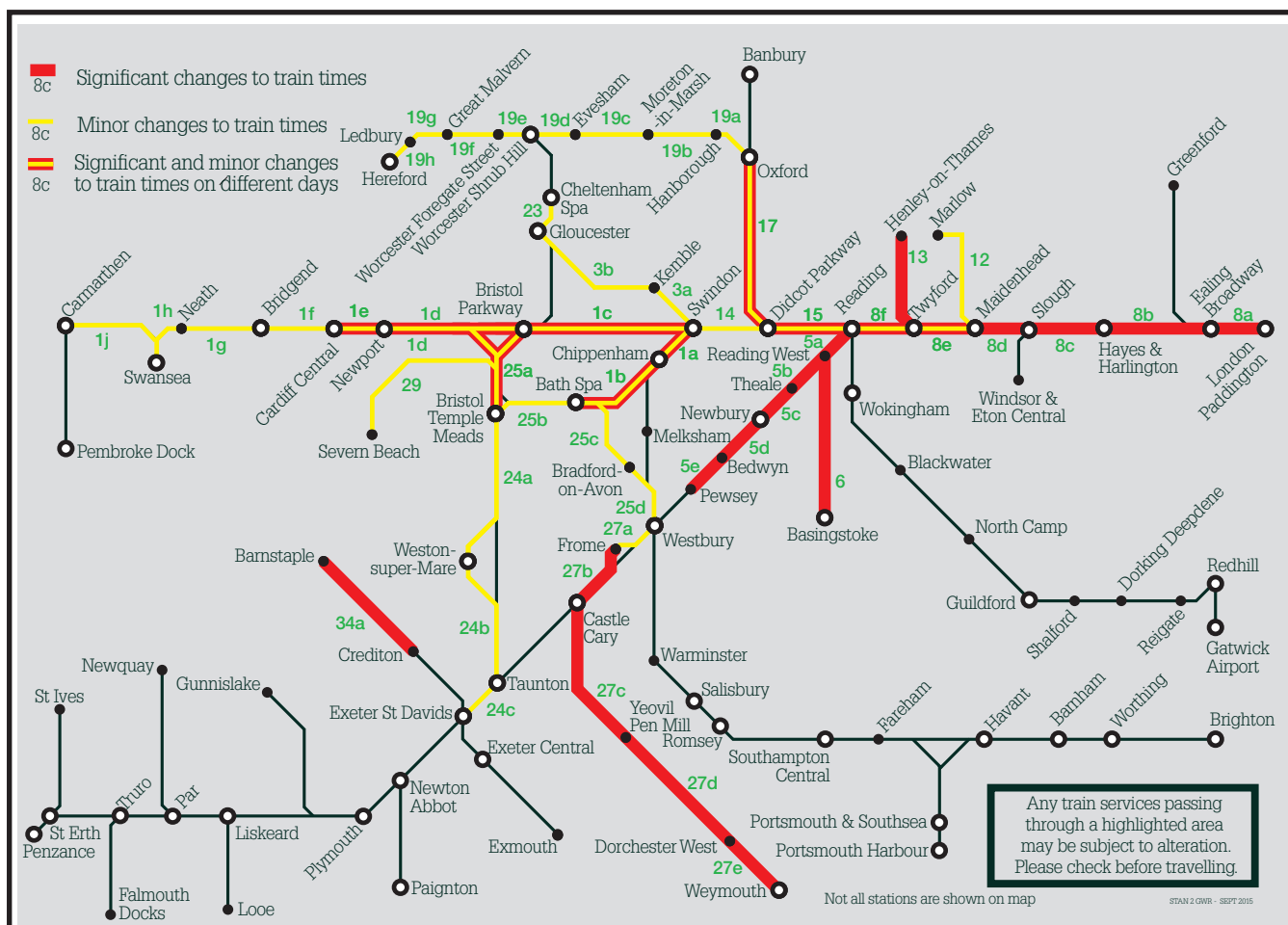


## Summary of timetable changes

Area	DETAILS
1a, 1b, 25a ●	<b>Sunday – Until approximately 1230</b> , trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads will not run between London Paddington and Didcot Parkway. Some trains will be extended to run from/to Oxford. Alternative trains, operated by Chiltern Railways, will run between London Marylebone and Oxford.
1a, 1b, 25b ●	<b>Sunday – From approximately 2200</b> , trains from London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will run later from Swindon to Bristol Temple Meads. The 2237 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads service will terminate at Bristol Parkway, with NO alternative transport to Bristol Temple Meads. Please travel on the 2303 service from London Paddington.
1a – 1c, 14 ●	<b>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2145 until end of service</b> , trains between London Paddington and South Wales/Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted and will not call at Didcot Parkway, Swindon or Chippenham. Replacement buses will serve these stations. The 2029 Swansea to London Paddington service will be diverted after Bristol Parkway to terminate at Bristol Temple Meads.
1c, 1d, 1e, 25a ●	<b>Sunday – Until approximately 1200</b> , direct trains between London Paddington and South Wales will NOT run. A special service will run between either London Paddington or Oxford and Bristol Parkway/Bristol Temple Meads. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway, Newport and Cardiff Central.
1c, 25a ●	<b>Monday</b> – The 0447 Bristol Temple Meads to London Paddington service will not call at Bristol Parkway. A replacement bus will depart EARLIER from Bristol Parkway to Bristol Temple Meads to connect with the train.
1d, 1e ●	<b>Saturday</b> – The 2200 London Paddington to Cardiff Central service will be diverted after Swindon to terminate at Bristol Parkway. A replacement bus will run from Bristol Parkway to Newport and Cardiff Central.
1d, 1e, 25a ●	<b>Sunday – Until approximately 1300</b> , a revised service will run between Bristol Temple Meads, Bristol Parkway, Newport and Cardiff Central. Services to/from Newport and Cardiff Central will be operated by replacement buses.
1d, 25a ●	<b>Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday</b> – The 2327 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads service will run approximately 5 minutes later from Patchway onwards.
1e – 1j ●	<b>Sunday – Until approximately 1300</b> , a revised GWR service will run between Cardiff Central and Swansea/Carmarthen.
1e ●	<b>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – All day</b> , a reduced train service will run between Newport and Cardiff Central.
1f ●	<b>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – All day</b> , trains from London Paddington to Cardiff Central/South Wales will arrive up to 7 minutes later than usual at Cardiff Central and stations beyond.
3a, 3b, 23 ●	<b>Sunday – Until approximately 1230</b> , trains between London Paddington and Cheltenham Spa will not run between London Paddington and Swindon. Please use alternative road/rail connections to travel to/from London.
5a – 5e ●	<b>Sunday – Until approximately 1230</b> , buses will replace trains between Reading and Theale. A revised train service will run between Theale and Newbury/Bedwyn, with some trains running EARLIER than usual. Long-distance services between London and the West of England will not run between London Paddington and Newbury. Please use alternative trains between London Paddington and Slough, and replacement buses between Slough and Newbury. The 1133 London Paddington to Paignton service will not run (but will be replaced in part by an 1154 Didcot Parkway to Paignton service, running via Bristol Temple Meads) and the 1157 London Paddington to Penzance service will call at Pewsey instead of Newbury.
6 ●	<b>Sunday – Until approximately 1300</b> , buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke.
8a – 8d ●	<b>Saturday – All day (until approximately 2200)</b> , additional trains will run between London Paddington and Maidenhead, calling at Ealing Broadway, Hayes & Harlington, West Drayton and Slough.
8e – 8f ●	<b>Saturday – From approximately 2330 until end of service</b> , trains from London Paddington to Twyford/Reading will terminate at Maidenhead, with a replacement buses from Maidenhead to Twyford and Reading.

8e – 8f ●	<b>Sunday – Until approximately 1230</b> , buses will replace trains between Maidenhead, Twyford and Reading.
12 ●	<b>Sunday – Until approximately 1200</b> , a revised service will run between Maidenhead, Bourne End and Marlow, with trains departing up to 10 minutes EARLIER than usual.
13 ●	<b>Sunday – Until approximately 1300 Sunday</b> , buses will replace trains between Twyford and Henley-on-Thames, at a reduced hourly frequency.
15, 17 ●	<b>Saturday</b> – The 2333 London Paddington to Oxford service will be replaced by a bus from Reading to Oxford.
15, 17 ●	<b>Sunday – Until approximately 1230</b> , fast services between London and Oxford will not run. Replacement buses will run between Reading and Didcot Parkway. A revised train service will run between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. Alternative trains, operated by Chiltern Railways, will run between London Marylebone and Oxford.
15 ●	<b>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2130 each evening until 0515 next day</b> , services will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
15 ●	<b>Friday – From approximately 2345 (and until 0515 Saturday 7 October)</b> , services will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
19a – 19h ●	<b>Sunday – Until approximately 1230</b> , trains to/from London Paddington will not run between Didcot Parkway and London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Didcot Parkway and Maidenhead, with alternative rail connections available between Oxford and London Marylebone (operated by Chiltern Railways) and between Maidenhead and London Paddington.
24a – 24c ●	<b>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2145 until end of service each evening</b> , a revised service will run between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare, Taunton and Exeter St Davids. Some trains will be replaced by buses between Bristol Temple Meads and Weston-super-Mare/Taunton.
25a, 29 ●	<b>Saturday and Sunday – From approximately 2230 Saturday until 1045 Sunday</b> , trains between Bristol Parkway / Lawrence Hill and Bristol Temple Meads will be revised, with some trains running EARLIER than usual. <b>On Sunday</b> , the 1023 Bristol Temple Meads to Avonmouth service will depart at 1040 and terminate at Clifton Down. The 1052 Avonmouth to Bristol Temple Meads service will start from Clifton Down at 1104. NO alternative transport will be provided.
25a – 25d ●	<b>Sunday</b> – The 0905 Westbury to Bristol Temple Meads service will depart at 0910. The 2008 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Parkway service will call additionally at Avoncliff, Freshford, Oldfield Park and Keynsham. The 2257 Bristol Parkway to Warminster service will run 7 minutes later from Bristol Temple Meads.
27a ●	<b>Saturday</b> – The 2309 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome service will be replaced by a bus from Westbury to Frome.
27b – 27e ●	<b>Sunday – All day</b> , buses will replace trains between Castle Cary and Yeovil Pen Mill. A revised service will run between Frome, Bruton and Castle Cary and between Yeovil Pen Mill and Weymouth.
34a ●	<b>Saturday and Sunday – All day</b> , buses will replace trains between Crediton and Barnstaple. Yeoford will be served by a separate shuttle bus service to/from Crediton. Some late night buses will be extended beyond Crediton to/from Exeter St Davids.
