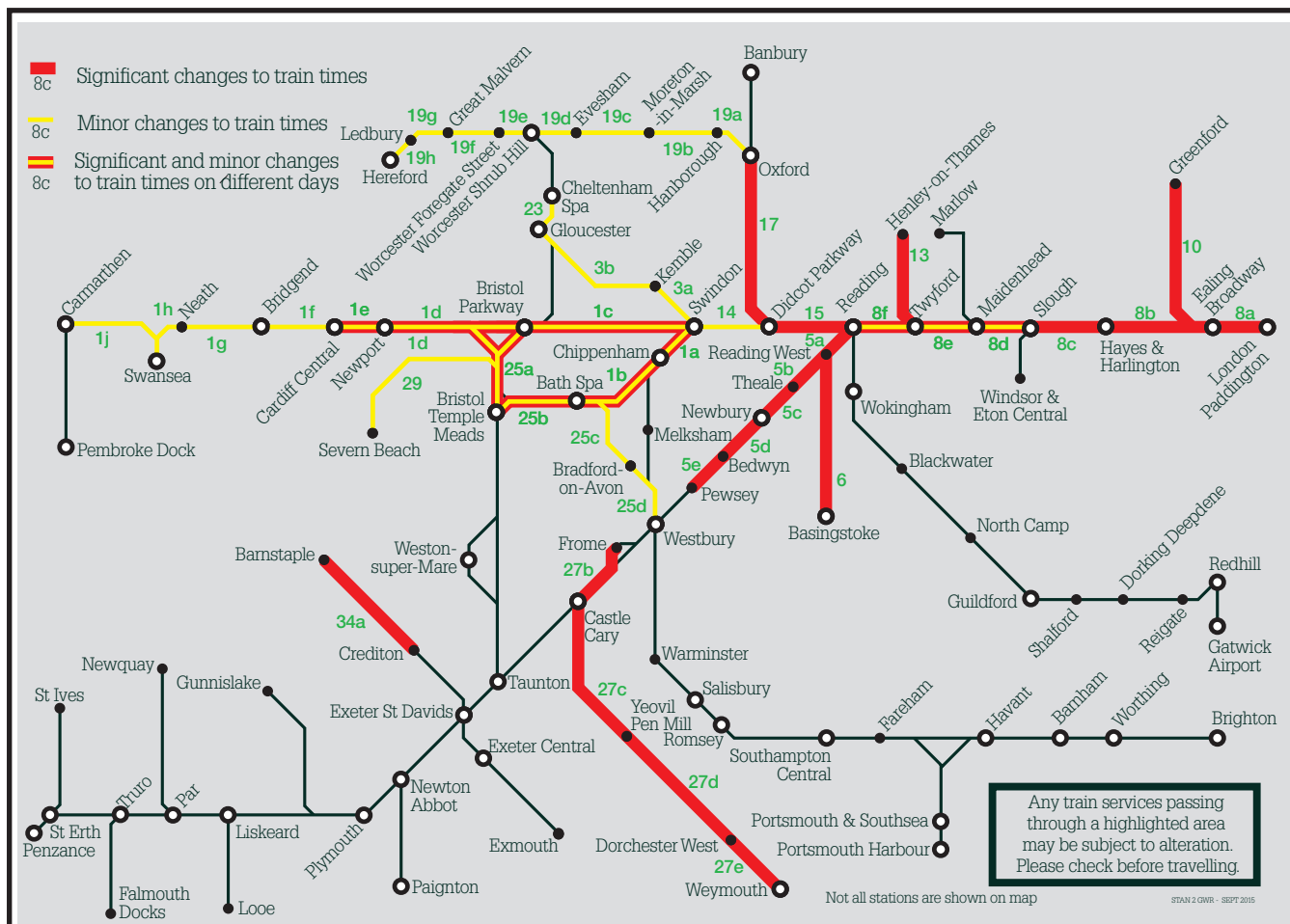


Summary of timetable changes

Area	DETAILS
1a, 1b, 25b ●	Sunday – Until approximately 1230 , trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads will not run between London Paddington and Didcot Parkway. Some trains will be extended to run from/to Oxford. Alternative trains, operated by Chiltern Railways, will run between London Marylebone and Oxford.
1a – 1c, 14 ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2145 until end of service , trains between London Paddington and South Wales/Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted and will not call at Didcot Parkway, Swindon or Chippenham. Replacement buses will serve these stations. The 2029 Swansea to London Paddington service will be diverted after Bristol Parkway to terminate at Bristol Temple Meads.
1c, 1d, 1e, 25a ●	Sunday – Until approximately 1200 , direct trains between London Paddington and South Wales will NOT run. A special service will run between either London Paddington or Oxford and Bristol Parkway/Bristol Temple Meads. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway, Newport and Cardiff Central.
1c, 25a ●	Sunday – The 2237 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads service will terminate at Bristol Parkway, with NO alternative transport to Bristol Temple Meads. Please travel on the 2303 service from London Paddington.
1c, 25a ●	Monday – The 0447 Bristol Temple Meads to London Paddington service will not call at Bristol Parkway. A replacement bus will depart EARLIER from Bristol Parkway to Bristol Temple Meads to connect with the train.
1d, 1e ●	Saturday – The 2200 London Paddington to Cardiff Central service will depart EARLIER at 2157 and will be diverted after Swindon to terminate at Bristol Parkway. A replacement bus will run from Bristol Parkway to Newport and Cardiff Central.
1d, 1e, 25a ●	Sunday – Until approximately 1300 , a revised service will run between Bristol Temple Meads, Bristol Parkway, Newport and Cardiff Central. Services to/from Newport and Cardiff Central will be operated by replacement buses.
1e – 1j ●	Sunday – Until approximately 1300 , a revised GWR service will run between Cardiff Central and Swansea/Carmarthen.
1e ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – All day , a reduced train service will run between Newport and Cardiff Central, and some trains will be retimed.
1f ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – All day , trains from London Paddington to Cardiff Central/South Wales will arrive up to 7 minutes later than usual at Cardiff Central and stations beyond.
3a, 3b, 23 ●	Saturday – All day , trains between London Paddington and Cheltenham Spa will run between Swindon and Cheltenham Spa only.
3a, 3b, 23 ●	Sunday – Until approximately 1230 , trains between London Paddington and Cheltenham Spa will not run between London Paddington and Swindon. Please use alternative road/rail connections to travel to/from London.
5a – 5e ●	Sunday – Until approximately 1230 , buses will replace trains between Reading and Theale. A revised train service will run between Theale and Newbury/Bedwyn, with some trains running EARLIER than usual. Long-distance services between London and the West of England will not run between London Paddington and Newbury. Please use alternative trains between London Paddington and Slough, and replacement buses between Slough and Newbury. The 1133 London Paddington to Paignton service will not run (but will be replaced in part by an 1154 Didcot Parkway to Paignton service, running via Bristol Temple Meads) and the 1157 London Paddington to Penzance service will call at Pewsey instead of Newbury.
6 ●	Sunday – Until approximately 1300 , buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke.
8a – 8f ●	Saturday – All day , a revised service will run between London Paddington, Maidenhead and Reading. Acton Main Line station will be closed all day. Please use alternative local buses.
8a – 8f ●	Saturday – All day , most long-distance services from London Paddington to Bristol, South Wales and the West of England will depart from London Paddington up to 12 minutes EARLIER than usual. Services towards London Paddington will generally arrive at London Paddington a few minutes later than usual.

8d	●	Sunday and Monday – From approximately 2215 Sunday until 0515 Monday , trains will not call at Burnham. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.
8e – 8f	●	Saturday – From approximately 2330 until end of service , trains from London Paddington to Twyford/Reading will terminate at Maidenhead, with a replacement buses from Maidenhead to Twyford and Reading.
8e – 8f	●	Sunday – Until approximately 1230 , buses will replace trains between Maidenhead, Twyford and Reading.
10	●	Saturday – All day , a reduced hourly service will run between Ealing Broadway, West Ealing and Greenford.
13	●	Sunday – Until approximately 1300 , buses will replace trains between Twyford and Henley-on-Thames, at a reduced hourly frequency.
15, 17	●	Saturday – All day , fast trains between London Paddington and Oxford will run to a revised timetable and will generally call additionally at Twyford. Most trains from London Paddington will depart up to 6 minutes EARLIER than usual. The 2333 London Paddington to Oxford service will be replaced by a bus from Reading to Oxford.
15, 17	●	Sunday – Until approximately 1230 , fast services between London and Oxford will not run. Replacement buses will run between Reading and Didcot Parkway. A revised train service will run between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. Alternative trains, operated by Chiltern Railways, will run between London Marylebone and Oxford.
19a – 19h	●	Saturday – All day , most trains from London Paddington to Worcester, Great Malvern and Hereford will depart from London Paddington up to 6 minutes EARLIER than usual.
19a – 19h	●	Sunday – Until approximately 1230 , trains to/from London Paddington will not run between Didcot Parkway and London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Didcot Parkway and Maidenhead, with alternative rail connections available between Oxford and London Marylebone (operated by Chiltern Railways) and between Maidenhead and London Paddington.
25a, 29	●	Saturday and Sunday – From approximately 2230 Saturday until 1045 Sunday , trains between Bristol Parkway / Lawrence Hill and Bristol Temple Meads will be revised, with some trains running EARLIER than usual. On Sunday , the 1023 Bristol Temple Meads to Avonmouth service will depart at 1040 and terminate at Clifton Down. The 1052 Avonmouth to Bristol Temple Meads service will start from Clifton Down at 1104. NO alternative transport will be provided.
25a – 25d	●	Sunday – The 2008 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Parkway service will call additionally at Avoncliff, Freshford, Oldfield Park and Keynsham. The 2257 Bristol Parkway to Warminster service will run 7 minutes later from Bristol Temple Meads.
27b – 27e	●	Sunday – All day , buses will replace trains between Castle Cary and Yeovil Pen Mill. A revised service will run between Frome, Bruton and Castle Cary and between Castle Cary and Weymouth.
34a	●	Sunday – All day , buses will replace trains between Crediton and Barnstaple. Yeoford will be served by a separate shuttle bus service to/from Crediton. Some late night buses will be extended beyond Crediton to/from Exeter St Davids.
