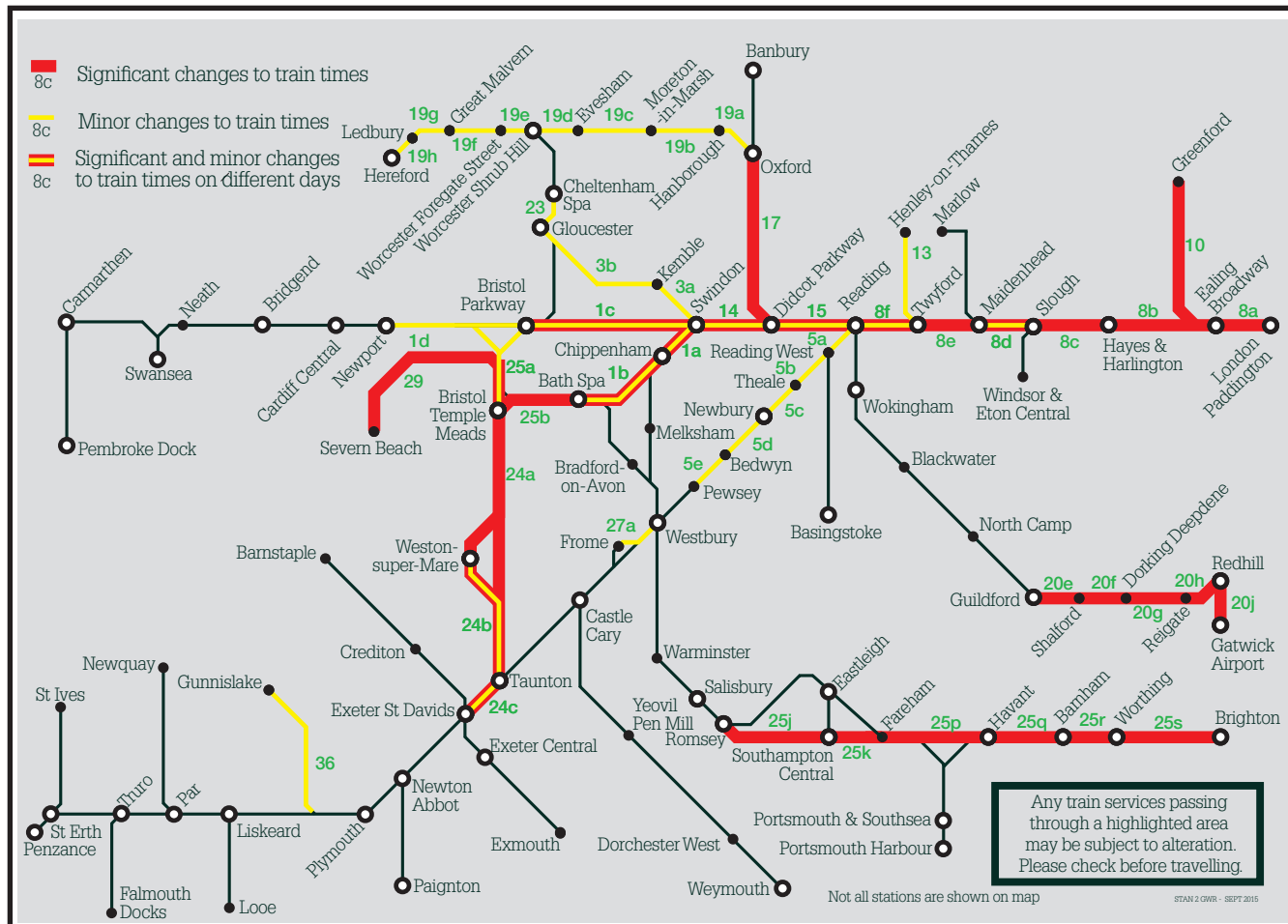


Summary of timetable changes

Area	DETAILS
1a-c, 14, 25b ●	Saturday – All day, London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads/South Wales services will depart up to 3 minutes EARLIER than usual. The 2235 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads service will depart 8 minutes EARLIER.
1a – 1c, 14 ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2145 until end of service, trains between London Paddington and South Wales/Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted and will not call at Didcot Parkway, Swindon or Chippenham. Replacement buses will serve these stations.
1d, 25a ●	Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday – The 2327 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads service will depart Patchway approximately 5 minutes later than usual and run later throughout to Bristol Temple Meads.
3a, 3b, 23 ●	Saturday – All day, London Paddington to Cheltenham Spa services will depart up to 3 minutes EARLIER than usual.
5a – 5e ●	Saturday – All day, trains between London Paddington and Newbury/Bedwyn will not run between London Paddington and Reading. Most trains between Reading and Newbury/Bedwyn will be slightly retimed. London Paddington to West of England services will depart 9 minutes EARLIER. The 1218 London Paddington to Taunton service will call additionally at Twyford.
8a – 8f, 15, 17 ●	Saturday – All day, a revised service will run between London Paddington, Slough, Maidenhead, Reading and Oxford.
8d ●	Saturday – From approximately 2330 until end of service, trains will not call at Burnham and Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
8d ●	Sunday – All day, trains will not call at Burnham. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.
8d ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From 2215 until approximately 0515 the following morning, trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow. A replacement bus will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
8f ●	Sunday – From approximately 0015 until 0800, buses will replace trains between Twyford and Reading. The 0622 and 0722 Reading to London Paddington services will start from Twyford.
8f, 13 ●	Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading service will terminate at Twyford. A replacement bus will run between Twyford and Reading.
10 ●	Saturday – All day, a reduced hourly service will run between West Ealing and Greenford.
15 ●	Sunday and Monday – All day Sunday until approximately 0515 Monday morning, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
15 ●	Friday and Saturday – From approximately 2345 Friday night until 0530 Saturday 16 December, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.
19a – 19h ●	Saturday – All day, London Paddington to Worcester/Great Malvern/Hereford services will depart up to 7 minutes EARLIER. These services will call additionally at Twyford.
20h, 20j ●	Saturday – All day, buses will replace trains between Reigate, Redhill and Gatwick Airport. There will also be an hourly replacement bus service running directly between Reigate and Gatwick Airport.
20e – 20h, 20j ●	Sunday – All day, buses will replace trains between Guildford and Redhill/Gatwick Airport. Some trains between Reading and Guildford will depart up to 17 minutes EARLIER.
24a – 24c ●	Sunday – All day, buses will replace trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Weston-super-Mare/Taunton. The 1545 Paignton to London Paddington and 2004 Plymouth to London Paddington services will be diverted between Taunton and Chippenham.

Area	DETAILS
24b, 24c ●	Saturday – The 2030 London Paddington to Exeter St Davids service will terminate at Weston-super-Mare. A replacement bus will run from Weston-super-Mare to Exeter St Davids, calling at all intermediate stations. The 2100 Cardiff Central to Exeter St Davids service will terminate at Bristol Temple Meads and connect with the 2030 London Paddington to Exeter St Davids service.
25a, 29 ●	Saturday and Sunday – All weekend, buses will replace trains between Clifton Down and Avonmouth/Severn Beach.
25j, 25k ●	Sunday – All day, Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour services will be diverted between Romsey and Fareham, not calling at Southampton Central. They will call additionally at Chandlers Ford and Eastleigh. A replacement bus service will run between Southampton Central and Eastleigh. The 1740 Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour service will terminate at Westbury.
25p – 25s ●	Sunday – All day, services to/from Brighton will not run. The 0819 Romsey to Brighton service will depart approximately 40 minutes later than usual and be diverted between Romsey and Fareham, not calling at Southampton Central and diverted again after Cosham to Portsmouth Harbour. The 1110 Brighton to Cardiff Central service will start from Portsmouth Harbour. The 1546 and 1746 Brighton to Cardiff Central services will start from Westbury.
27a ●	Monday – The 2320 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome service will terminate at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Frome.
36 ●	Saturday and Sunday – All weekend, buses will replace trains between Calstock and Gunnislake.
