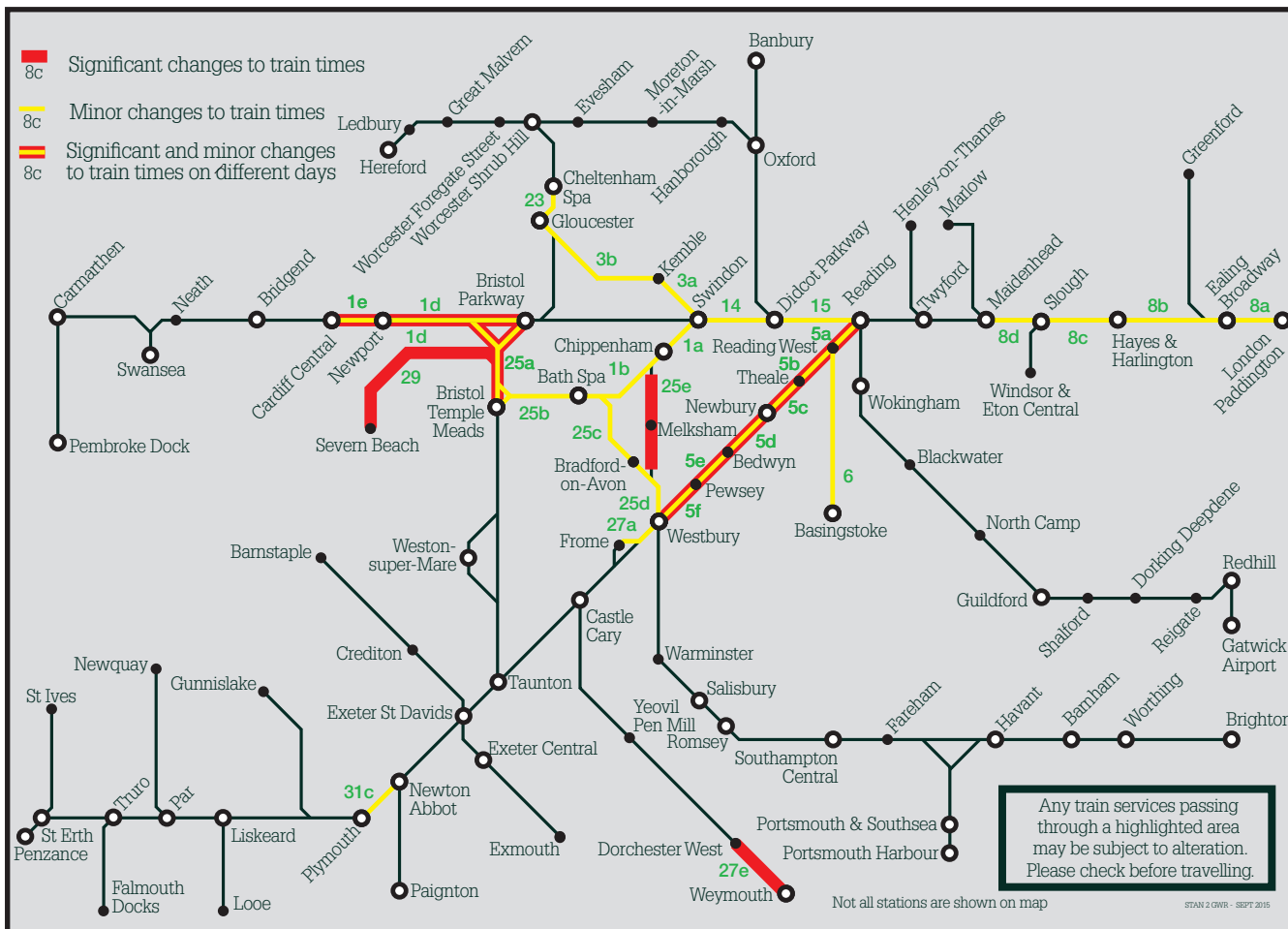


Summary of timetable changes

Area	DETAILS
1a, 1b, 14	<p>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2215 until 05.30 the following morning, trains will be diverted and not call at Chippenham and Bath Spa. Replacement buses will serve these stations.</p>
1d, 1e	<p>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – Each day, trains from Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour will depart Cardiff Central up to 6 minutes EARLIER than usual. Trains from Carmarthen/Swansea/Cardiff Central to London Paddington will depart Cardiff Central up to 9 minutes EARLIER than usual. The 2000 Cardiff Central to Taunton service will not run. The 2100 Cardiff Central to Westbury service will start from Bristol Temple Meads. Some services will terminate earlier in their journey.</p>
1d, 1e, 25a	<p>Friday – The 2330 London Paddington to Cardiff Central service will terminate at Bristol Temple Meads. A replacement bus will run between Bristol Temple Meads and Cardiff Central.</p>
1b, 1d – 1h, 25a, 25b	<p>Saturday – The 0359 Swansea to London Paddington will depart 18 minutes later than usual and not call at Bristol Temple Meads, Bath Spa or Chippenham. A replacement bus will run between Bristol Parkway and Bristol Temple Meads. The 0559 Swansea to London Paddington service will start from Bristol Parkway.</p>
3a, 3b, 23	<p>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – The 2336 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa service will be diverted between Swindon and Gloucester, not calling at Kemble, Stroud and Stonehouse. A replacement bus will serve these stations.</p>
5a – 5f	<p>Sunday – From approximately 2100 until the end of service, buses replace trains between Reading and Newbury/Bedwyn. The 1731 Penzance to London Paddington will be diverted and not call at Pewsey or Newbury. This service will call additionally at Swindon. Change at Swindon for a replacement bus to Pewsey. Change at Reading for a replacement bus to Newbury.</p>
5a – 5f	<p>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – Each day, trains will not run between Reading and Newbury/Bedwyn. A peak time service will operate between London Paddington and Theale only, with replacement buses running for the rest of service between Reading and Newbury/Bedwyn. Trains between London Paddington and the West of England will be diverted, with trains departing London Paddington up to 35 minutes EARLIER than usual. 6	<p>Sunday – From approximately 2100 until the end of service, buses replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke.</p>
8a – 8c	<p>Saturday and Sunday – From approximately 2345 Saturday evening until 0815 Sunday morning, buses will replace trains between Slough and Maidenhead. A revised service will run between Reading and Maidenhead, and Slough and London Paddington.</p>
8d	<p>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2215 until 0515 the following morning, trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.</p>
15	<p>Saturday – From approximately 2300 until 0945 Sunday morning, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.</p>
15	<p>Sunday – From approximately 2130 until 0500 Monday morning, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.</p>
15	<p>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2130 until 0515 the following morning, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.</p>
15	<p>Friday – From approximately 2345 until 0530 Saturday 19 May, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.</p>
25a	<p>Saturday and Sunday – All weekend, buses will replace trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway. Trains between Cardiff Central/Bristol Parkway and Weston-super-Mare/Taunton/Portsmouth Harbour/Brighton will start/terminate at Bristol Temple Meads. Trains from Great Malvern/Worcester/Cheltenham Spa/Gloucester will be diverted after Bristol Parkway and terminate/start at Cardiff Central.</p>
25a	<p>Saturday – The 0645 Bristol Temple Meads to Swansea service will start from Bristol Parkway. An EARLIER replacement bus will run between Bristol Temple Meads to Bristol Parkway to connect with the train.</p>

25a ●	Sunday – The 1305 Bristol Temple Meads to London Paddington and 1527 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads services will not run. The 0815 Bristol Temple Meads to London Paddington service will start from Bristol Parkway and be diverted, not calling at Bath Spa or Chippenham. The 2333 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads service will terminate at Bristol Parkway. Please travel on <u>alternative services to Bristol Temple Meads</u> .
25a ●	Monday – The 0445 Bristol Temple Meads to London Paddington service will start from Bristol Parkway at 0455. An EARLIER replacement bus will run between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway to connect with the train.
25a, 29 ●	Saturday and Sunday – All weekend , buses replace trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Avonmouth/Severn Beach.
25b – 25d, 27a, 27b ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – The 2320 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome service will depart 28 minutes EARLIER than usual and will terminate at Westbury. A replacement bus will run between Bristol Temple Meads and Westbury at the usual departure time.
25e ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – Each day , services between Swindon and Westbury/Frome will be significantly altered, with some services being cancelled. Replacement buses will run between Chippenham and Westbury for affected services. For more information, visit GWR.com/Newbury2018
27e ●	Saturday and Sunday – All weekend , buses replace trains between Dorchester West and Weymouth.
31c ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – The 2125 Plymouth to Exeter St Davids will depart much EARLIER at 1955. A replacement bus will run from Plymouth to Newton Abbot, departing at the usual time. Change at Newton Abbot for an onwards rail connection towards Exeter St Davids.
