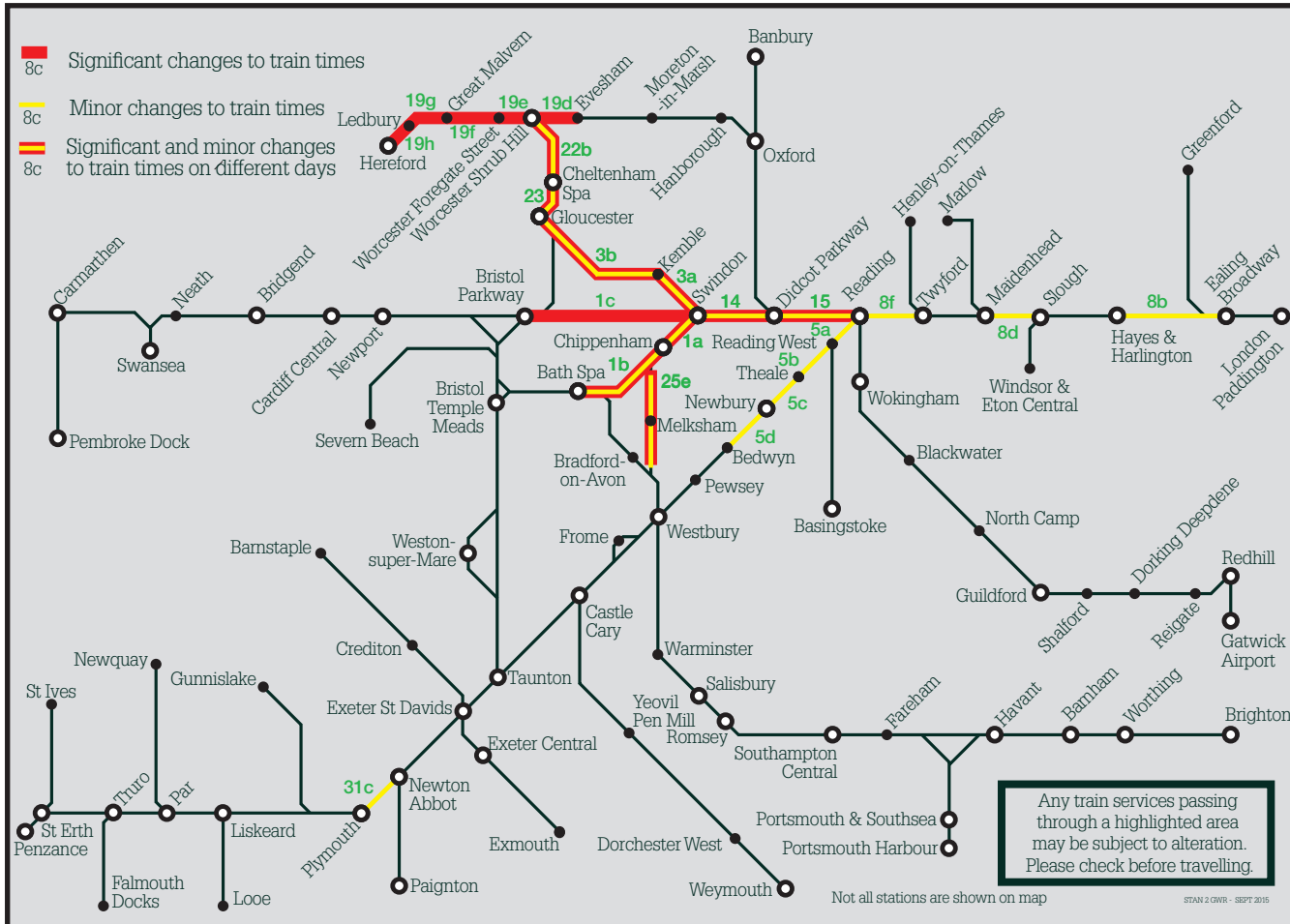


Summary of timetable changes

Area	DETAILS
1a – 1c, 14, 15 ●	Saturday, Sunday and Monday – All Bank Holiday weekend , services trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads/ South Wales will be diverted and not call at Didcot Parkway, Swindon and Chippenham/Bristol Parkway. Replacement buses will serve these stations. Some services may be terminated earlier in their journey, some services will not run and some will depart earlier than usual.
1a, 1b, 14, 15 ●	Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 1930 until 0530 the following morning , trains will be diverted and not call at Didcot Parkway, Swindon and Chippenham. Replacement buses will serve these stations. Some services will depart earlier, some will be cancelled. Some services may be terminated earlier in their journey, some services will not run and some will depart earlier than usual.
1a, 1b, 14, 15 ●	Friday – From approximately 2215 until the end of service , trains will be diverted and not call at Didcot Parkway, Swindon and Chippenham. Replacement buses will serve these stations.
3a, 3b, 23 ●	Saturday, Sunday and Monday – All Bank Holiday weekend , trains between London Paddington/Swindon and Cheltenham Spa will not run. Replacement buses will run between Swindon and Gloucester. Change at Gloucester for an onwards rail connection to Cheltenham Spa.
3a, 3b, 23 ●	Friday – The 2336 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will start from Kemble. A replacement bus will run between Swindon and Kemble.
5a – 5d ●	Saturday, Sunday and Monday – All Bank Holiday weekend , trains between London Paddington/Reading and Newbury/Bedwyn will depart up to 15 minutes EARLIER than usual.
8b ●	Wednesday and Thursday – The 2351 London Paddington to Reading service will not call at West Ealing or Hanwell. Please travel on alternative services for these stations.
8d ●	Monday – From approximately 2215 until the end of service , trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
8d ●	Friday – From approximately 2330 until the end of service , trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow
8f ●	Tuesday – The 0017 Henley-on-Thames to Reading service will terminate at Twyford. Change at Twyford for an onwards rail connection to Reading.
15 ●	Sunday – All day , trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.
15 ●	Friday – From approximately 2345 until the end of service , trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.
19d – 19h ●	Saturday, Sunday, Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday – Each day , buses replace trains between Evesham and Worcester/The Malverns/ Hereford. Change at Evesham for services towards Oxford, Didcot Parkway, Reading and London Paddington. Services from London Paddington towards Oxford/Evesham will depart up to 4 minutes EARLIER than usual and call additionally at Didcot Parkway.
19e, 19f, 22b ●	Saturday, Sunday, Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday – Each day , buses will replace trains between Great Malvern and Cheltenham Spa. Change at Cheltenham Spa for services to Bristol Temple Meads and beyond.
22b ●	Thursday – The 0528 Worcester Shrub Hill to London Paddington service will start from Cheltenham Spa. An EARLIER replacement bus will run between Worcester Shrub Hill and Cheltenham Spa to connect with the train.
25e ●	Saturday and Monday – An amended service will run between Chippenham and Westbury only. Replacement buses will run between Swindon and Chippenham.
25e ●	Sunday – All day , buses replace trains between Swindon/Chippenham and Westbury.
31c ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – The 2125 Plymouth to Exeter St Davids will depart much EARLIER at 1950. A replacement bus will run from Plymouth to Newton Abbot, departing at the usual time. Change at Newton Abbot for an onwards rail connection towards Exeter St Davids.
