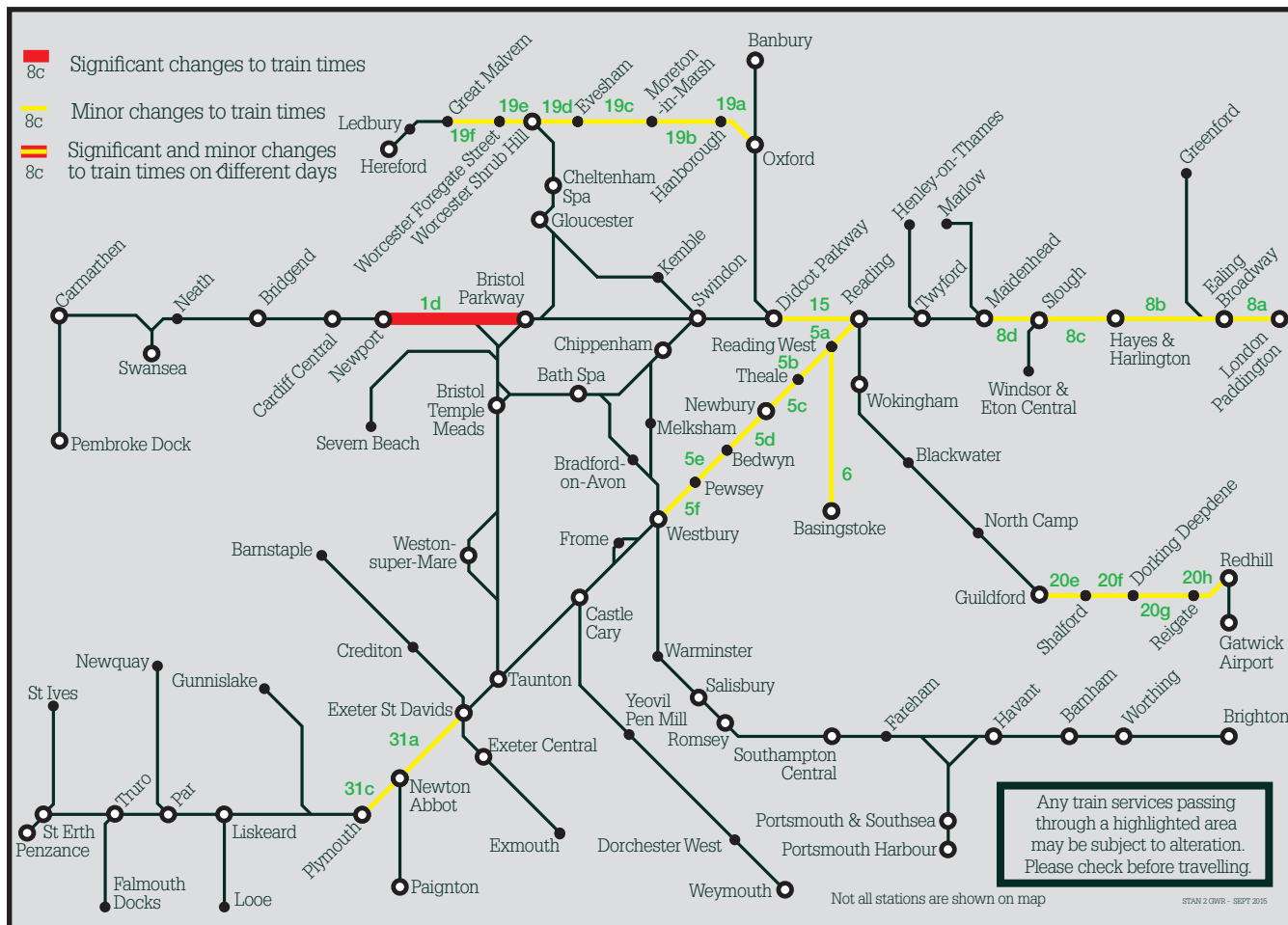


Summary of timetable changes

1d ●	Saturday – All day , buses replace trains between Bristol Parkway and Severn Tunnel Junction/Newport. Trains between South Wales and London Paddington will be diverted and not call at Bristol Parkway. Some services between Bristol Temple Meads and London Paddington will be extended to start/terminate Bristol Parkway. Trains between Bristol Parkway and Weston-super-Mare will start/terminate at Filton Abbey Wood. For more information, visit GWR.com/SouthWales2018
1d ●	Sunday – All day , buses replace trains between Bristol Parkway and Newport. Trains will run between London Paddington and Bristol Parkway, and Newport and Cardiff Central/Swansea. Some services will start later in their journey. Some services will terminate earlier in their journey. For more information, visit GWR.com/SouthWales2018
1d ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – All week , buses replace trains between Bristol Parkway and Severn Tunnel Junction/Newport. Some trains between South Wales and London Paddington will be diverted and not call at Bristol Parkway. Some services between Bristol Temple Meads and London Paddington will be extended to start/terminate Bristol Parkway. 5a – 5f ●	Saturday and Sunday – From approximately 2100 Saturday evening until 0945 Sunday morning , buses replace trains between Reading and Newbury/Bedwyn. Services between London Paddington and the West of England will be diverted and amended. For more information, visit GWR.com/Newbury2018
5a – 5f ●	Sunday – From approximately 2100 until 0430 the following morning , buses replace trains between Reading and Newbury/Bedwyn. Services between London Paddington and the West of England will be diverted and amended. For more information, visit GWR.com/Newbury2018
6 ●	Saturday and Sunday – From approximately 2100 Saturday evening until 0950 Sunday morning , buses replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke.
6 ●	Sunday – From approximately 2100 until the end of service , buses replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke.
8a – 8d ●	Saturday and Sunday – From approximately 2345 Saturday evening until 0815 Sunday morning , buses will replace trains between Slough and Maidenhead. A revised service will run between Reading and Maidenhead, and Slough and London Paddington. The 2349 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington service will terminate at Maidenhead. A replacement bus will run between Maidenhead and London Paddington.
15 ●	Saturday and Sunday – From approximately 2300 until 0945 Sunday morning , trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.
15 ●	Sunday and Monday – From approximately 2130 until 0515 the following morning , trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.
19a – 19f ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – The 2148 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill service will terminate at Oxford. A replacement bus will run between Oxford and Worcester Shrub Hill. The 2151 Hereford to London Paddington service will terminate at Worcester Shrub Hill. Change at Worcester Shrub Hill for a replacement bus to Oxford, where there will be an onwards rail connection to London Paddington.
20e – 20h ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – The 2236 and 2334 Reading to Gatwick Airport services will terminate at Guildford. Replacement buses will run between Guildford and Redhill. Change at Redhill for an onwards rail connection to Gatwick Airport. The 2318 Gatwick Airport to Reading service will terminate at Redhill. A replacement bus will run between Redhill and Guildford. Change at Guildford for an onwards rail connection to Reading.
31a, 31c ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – The 2125 Plymouth to Exeter St Davids service will depart much EARLIER than usual, at 1951 and run earlier throughout. A replacement bus will also run, departing at the usual time of 2125.
