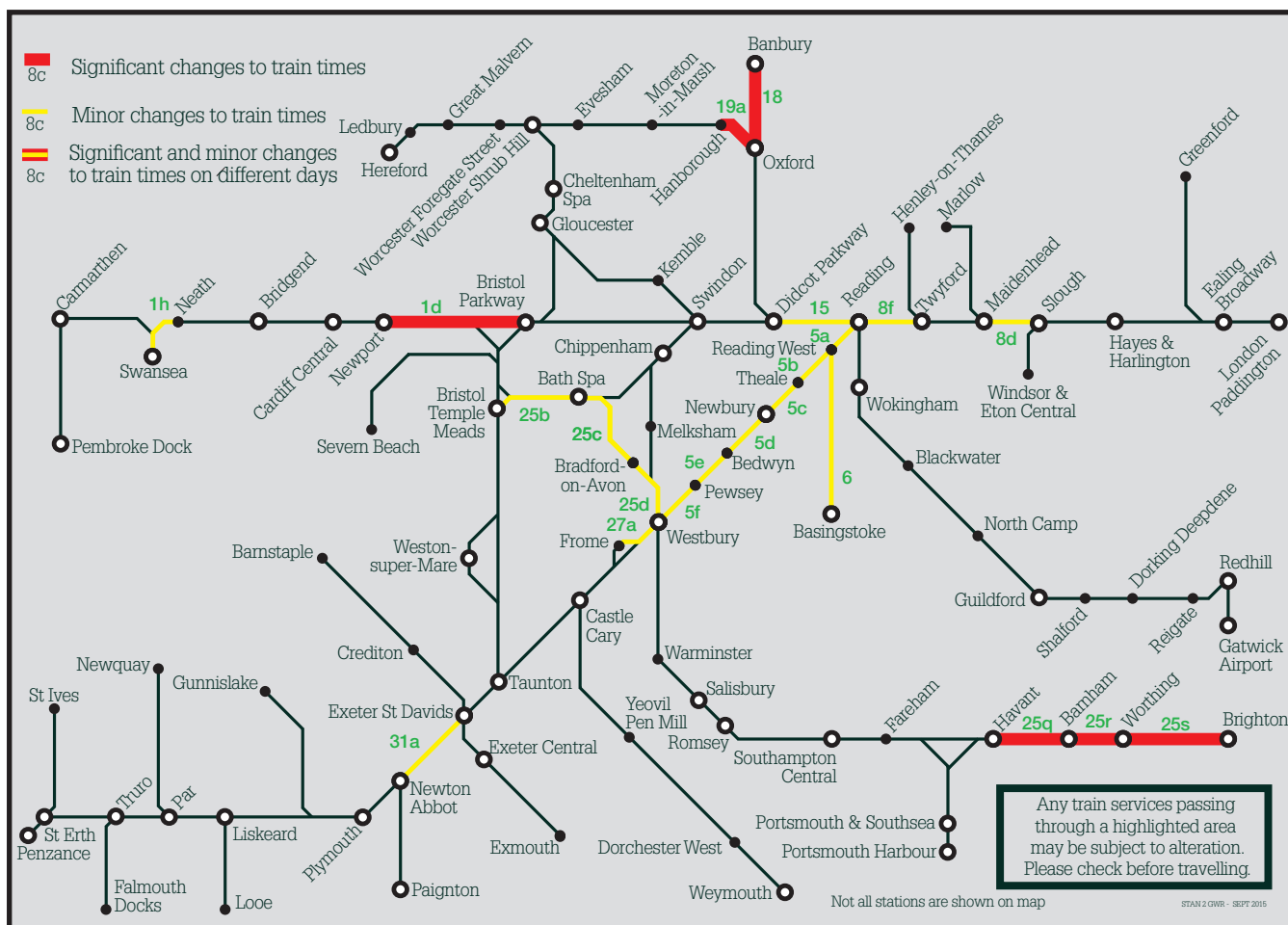


Summary of timetable changes

Area	DETAILS
1d ●	Saturday – All day , buses replace trains between Bristol Parkway and Severn Tunnel Junction/Newport. Trains between South Wales and London Paddington will be diverted and not call at Bristol Parkway. Some services between Bristol Temple Meads and London Paddington will be extended to start/terminate at Bristol Parkway. Trains between Bristol Parkway and Weston-super-Mare will start/terminate at Bristol Temple Meads. For more information, visit GWR.com/SouthWales2018
1d ●	Sunday – All day , buses replace trains between Bristol Parkway and Newport. Trains will run between London Paddington and Bristol Parkway, and Newport and Cardiff Central/Swansea. Some services will start later in their journey. Some services will terminate earlier in their journey. The 0805 Cardiff Central to London Paddington and 0810 Swansea to London Paddington services will depart EARLIER than usual. For more information, visit GWR.com/SouthWales2018
1d ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – All week , buses replace trains between Bristol Parkway and Severn Tunnel Junction/Newport. Some trains between South Wales and London Paddington will be diverted and not call at Bristol Parkway. Some services between Bristol Temple Meads and London Paddington will be extended to start/terminate at Bristol Parkway. Trains between Bristol Parkway and Weston-super-Mare will start/terminate at Filton Abbey Wood. For more information, visit GWR.com/SouthWales2018
1h ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – The 2115 and 2245 London Paddington to Swansea services will terminate at Neath. Replacement buses will run between Neath and Swansea.
1h ●	Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – The 0354 Swansea to London Paddington service will start from Neath. A replacement bus will run between Swansea and Neath to connect with the train.
5a - 5f ●	Saturday and Sunday - From approximately 2115 Saturday evening until 0845 Sunday morning and 2100 Sunday evening until the end of service , buses will replace trains between Bedwyn/Newbury and Reading. Services between the West of England and London Paddington will be diverted.
6 ●	Saturday and Sunday - From approximately 2115 Saturday evening until 0845 Sunday morning and 2100 Sunday evening until the end of service , buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke.
8d ●	Monday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2215 until 0515 the following morning , trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
8d ●	Friday – From approximately 2330 until the end of service , trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
8f ●	Tuesday, Thursday and Friday – The 0017 Henley-on-Thames to Reading service will terminate at Twyford. Change at Twyford for an onwards rail connection to Reading.
15 ●	Sunday – From approximately 2130 until 0515 the following morning , trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.
15 ●	Friday – From approximately 2345 until 0530 Saturday 30 June , trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.
18 ●	Sunday - All day , buses will replace trains between Oxford and Banbury.
19a ●	Sunday – All day , trains between Worcester/The Malverns/Hereford and London Paddington will start/terminate at Oxford. Replacement buses will run between Oxford and Hanborough. A special amended service will run between Hanborough and Worcester/The Malverns. Some services between London Paddington and Cheltenham Spa (via Swindon) will be extended to Worcester and Hereford.
25b – 25d, 27a ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – The 2320 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome service will depart approximately 30 minutes EARLIER than usual. A replacement bus will run between Bristol Temple Meads and Frome, departing at the usual time.
25q - 25s ●	Sunday - All day , trains between Brighton and Havant will not run. Please travel on other operators' services to complete your journey.
31a ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – The 2345 London Paddington to Penzance "The Night Riviera" service will depart Exeter St Davids EARLIER than usual. It will depart Plymouth and beyond at the usual time.
