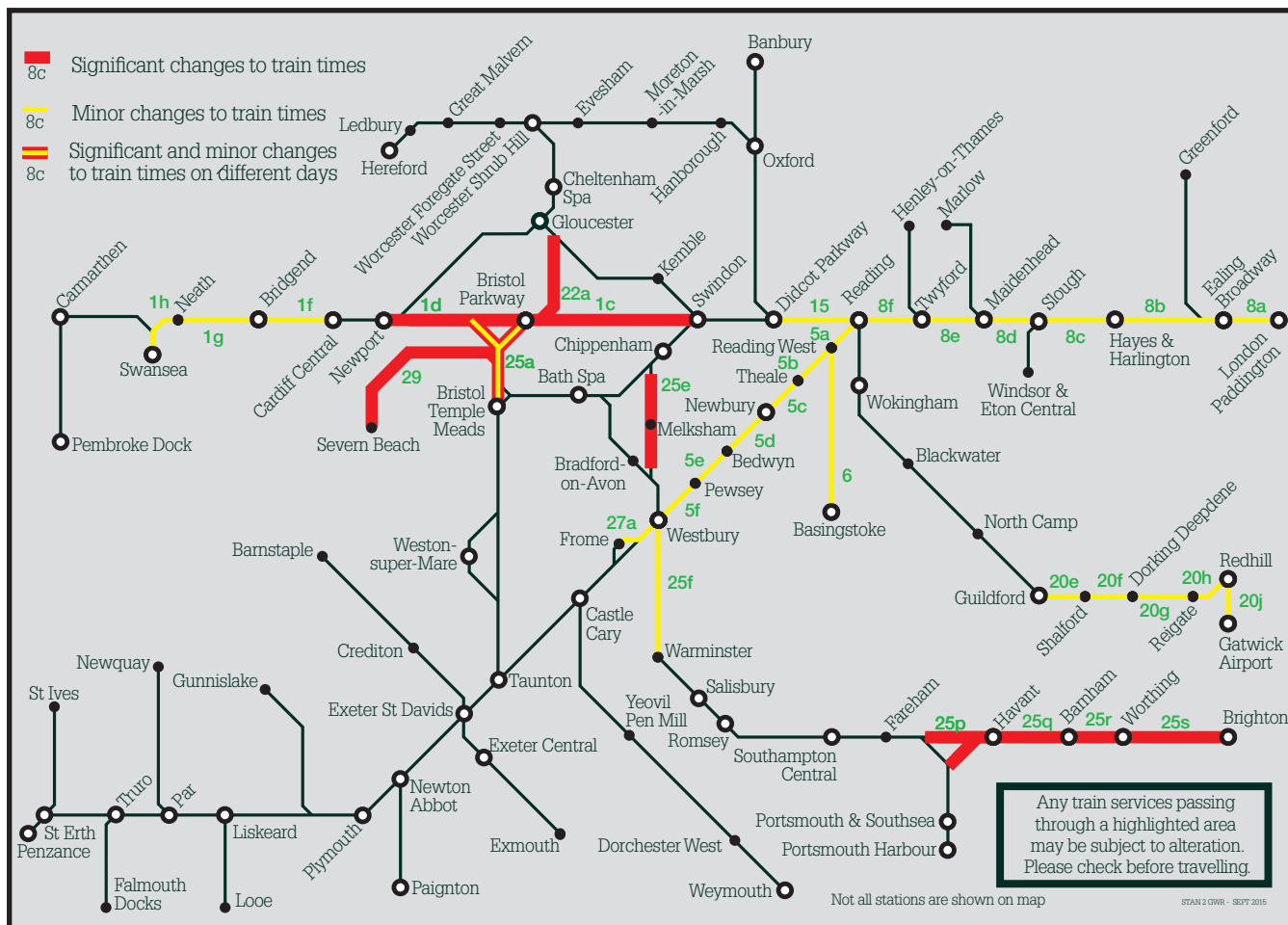


## Summary of timetable changes

1c, 1d	<p><b>Saturday and Sunday – All weekend</b>, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be diverted between Swindon and Newport, not calling at Bristol Parkway. Trains will call at Patchway. Replacement buses will run between Patchway and Bristol Parkway. <b>On Saturday</b>, trains from London Paddington to South Wales will depart up to 15 minutes EARLIER than usual. The 0730 Bristol Temple Meads to London Paddington, 0759 Swansea to London Paddington, 0900 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads and 1915 London Paddington to Swansea services will not run. The 2335 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads service will depart 5 minutes EARLIER than usual. <b>On Sunday</b>, the 1525 Bristol Temple Meads to London Paddington, 1803 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads and 1900 London Paddington to Swansea services will not run.</p> <p>For more information visit <a href="http://GWR.com/SouthWales2018">GWR.com/SouthWales2018</a></p>
1c, 1d	<p><b>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – All week</b>, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be diverted between Swindon and Newport, not calling at Bristol Parkway. 1f – 1h	<p><b>Sunday</b> – The 0800 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central at 0855. Replacement buses will run between Swansea and Cardiff Central to connect with the train.</p>
5a – 5f	<p><b>Saturday – From approximately 2115 until 0845 the following morning</b>, buses will replace trains between Reading and Newbury/Bedwyn.</p>
6	<p><b>Saturday – From approximately 2115 until 0845 the following morning</b>, buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke.</p>
6	<p><b>Sunday – From approximately 2330 until the end of service</b>, buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke.</p>
8a – 8f	<p><b>Sunday</b> – The 0100 London Paddington to Reading service will be replaced by two bus services: a direct London Paddington to Reading and a stopping service. The 0803 London Paddington to Great Malvern service will depart 3 minutes EARLIER than usual. The 0815 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will depart 2 minutes EARLIER than usual. From 1215 until 2015 stopping services between London Paddington and Reading/Didcot Parkway will depart up to 2 minutes EARLIER than usual.</p>
8d	<p><b>Saturday – From the start of service until approximately 0630</b>, trains will not call at Burnham and Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.</p>
15	<p><b>Saturday – From approximately 2315 until the end of service</b>, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.</p>
15	<p><b>Sunday – From approximately 2300 until the end of service</b>, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.</p>
15	<p><b>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2130 until 0515 the following morning</b>, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.</p>
20e – 20j	<p><b>Sunday – All day Sunday until approximately 0445 Monday morning</b>, buses will replace trains between Guildford and Redhill/Gatwick Airport.</p>

22a, 25a	<p><b>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – All week</b>, buses will replace trains between Yate and Filton Abbey Wood. 25a, 29	<p><b>Saturday and Sunday – All weekend</b>, buses will replace trains between Clifton Down and Avonmouth/Severn Beach.</p>
25e	<p><b>Sunday</b> – The 0828 Westbury to Swindon and 0926 Swindon to Westbury services will not run. Replacement buses will run between Westbury and Chippenham for these services. The 1338 Swindon to Weymouth service will depart 10 minutes EARLIER than usual.</p>

25f ●	<b>Sunday</b> – The 0830 Westbury to Warminster service will not run. Please travel on a later train.
25p – 25s ●	<b>Sunday – All day</b> , GWR services will not run between Cosham and Brighton. Some trains will start/terminate earlier in their journey. <u>Change for other operators' onwards rail connections to/from Brighton.</u>
27a ●	<b>Saturday</b> – The 2310 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome service will terminate at Westbury. Change at Westbury for a replacement bus to Frome.
