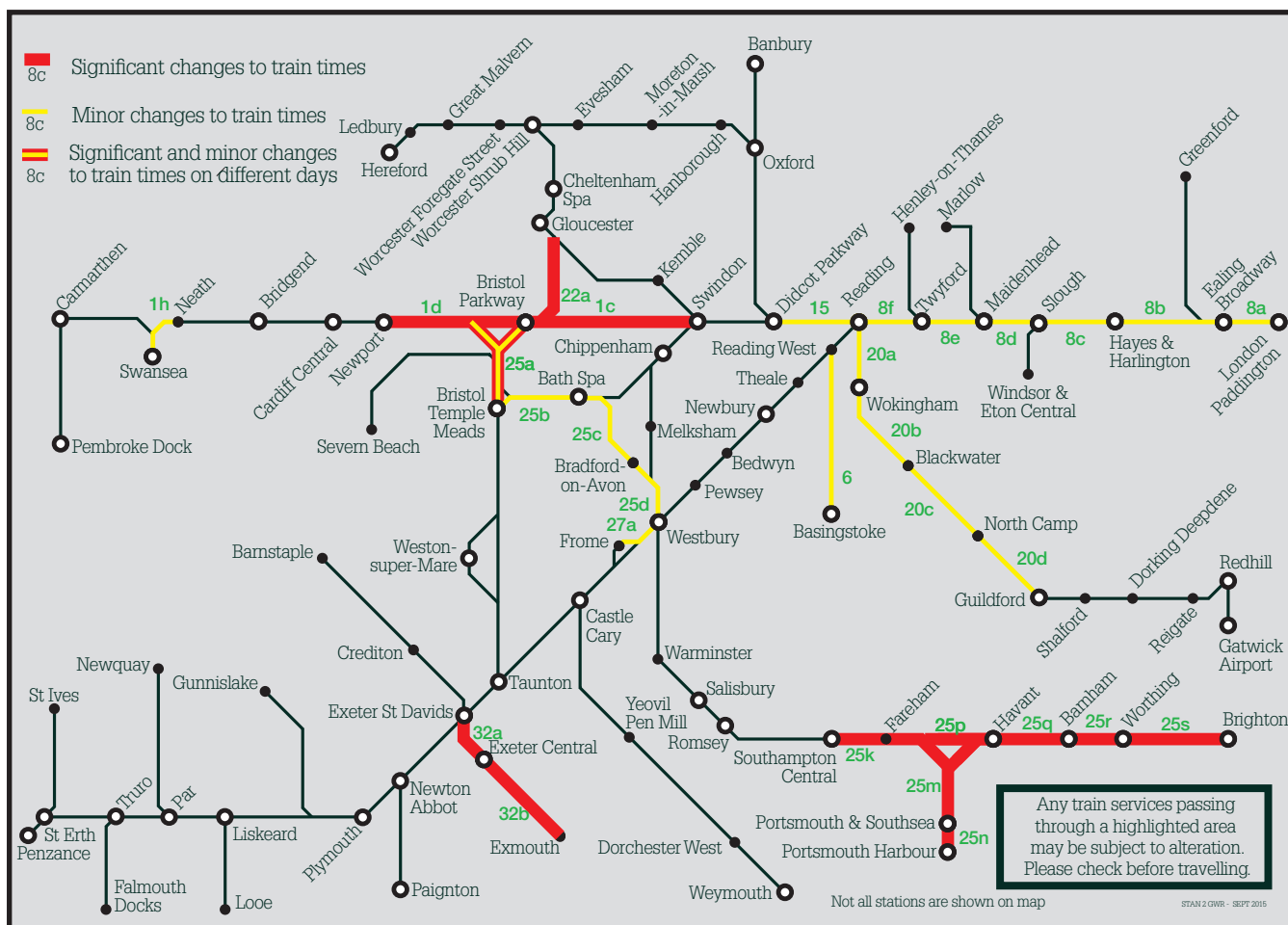


Summary of timetable changes

1c, 1d	<p>Saturday and Sunday – All weekend, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be diverted between Swindon and Newport, not calling at Bristol Parkway. Trains will call at Patchway. Replacement buses will run between Patchway and Bristol Parkway. On Saturday, trains from London Paddington to South Wales will depart up to 15 minutes EARLIER than usual.</p> <p>The 0730 Bristol Temple Meads to London Paddington, 0759 Swansea to London Paddington, 0900 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads and 1915 London Paddington to Swansea services will not run. On Sunday, the 1525 Bristol Temple Meads to London Paddington, 1803 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads and 1900 London Paddington to Swansea services will not run. 1c, 1d	<p>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – All week, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be diverted between Swindon and Newport, not calling at Bristol Parkway. Trains will call at Patchway. Replacement buses will run between Patchway and Bristol Parkway. For more information visit GWR.com/SouthWales2018</p>
1h	<p>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – The 2115 and 2245 London Paddington to Swansea services will terminate at Neath. Replacement buses will run between Neath and Swanaea.</p>
1h	<p>Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – The 0354 Swansea to London Paddington service will start from Neath. A replacement bus will run between Swansea and Neath to connect with the train.</p>
8a – 8f	<p>Sunday – The 0100 London Paddington to Reading service will be replaced by two bus services: a direct London Paddington to Reading and a stopping service.</p>
8d	<p>Monday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2215 until the end of service each evening, trains will not call at Burnham and Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.</p>
8d	<p>Tuesday – The 0502 Reading to London Paddington service will not call at Taplow or Burnham. Please travel on later services.</p>
8f	<p>Tuesday, Thursday and Friday – The 0017 Henley-on-Thames to Reading service will terminate at Twyford. Change at Twyford for an onwards rail connection to Reading.</p>
15	<p>Sunday – From approximately 2300 until the end of service, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.</p>
15	<p>Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday – From approximately 2130 until 0515 the following morning, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.</p>
20a – 20d	<p>Sunday – All day Sunday until approximately 0400 Monday morning, buses will replace trains between Reading and Guildford.</p>
22a, 25a	<p>Saturday and Sunday – All weekend, buses will replace trains between Yate and Filton Abbey Wood. Services between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway will not run. For more information visit GWR.com/SouthWales2018</p>
22a, 25a	<p>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – All week, buses will replace trains between Yate and Filton Abbey Wood. Most trains between Bristol Parkway and Bristol Temple Meads will not run. For more information visit GWR.com/SouthWales2018</p>
25a – 25d, 27a	<p>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – The 2320 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome service will depart 30 minutes EARLIER than usual and run earlier throughout. There will be a replacement bus departing at the usual time, which will terminate at Westbury on Monday and Tuesday, and Frome on Wednesday and Thursday.</p>
25k – 25s	<p>Sunday – All day, buses will replace trains between Southampton Central and Portsmouth Harbour/Brighton. Some trains will start/terminate earlier in their journey.</p>
32a, 32b	<p>Sunday – All day until 0400 Monday morning, buses will replace trains between Exeter St Davids/Exeter Central and Exmouth. Some local services will depart EARLIER than usual.</p>
