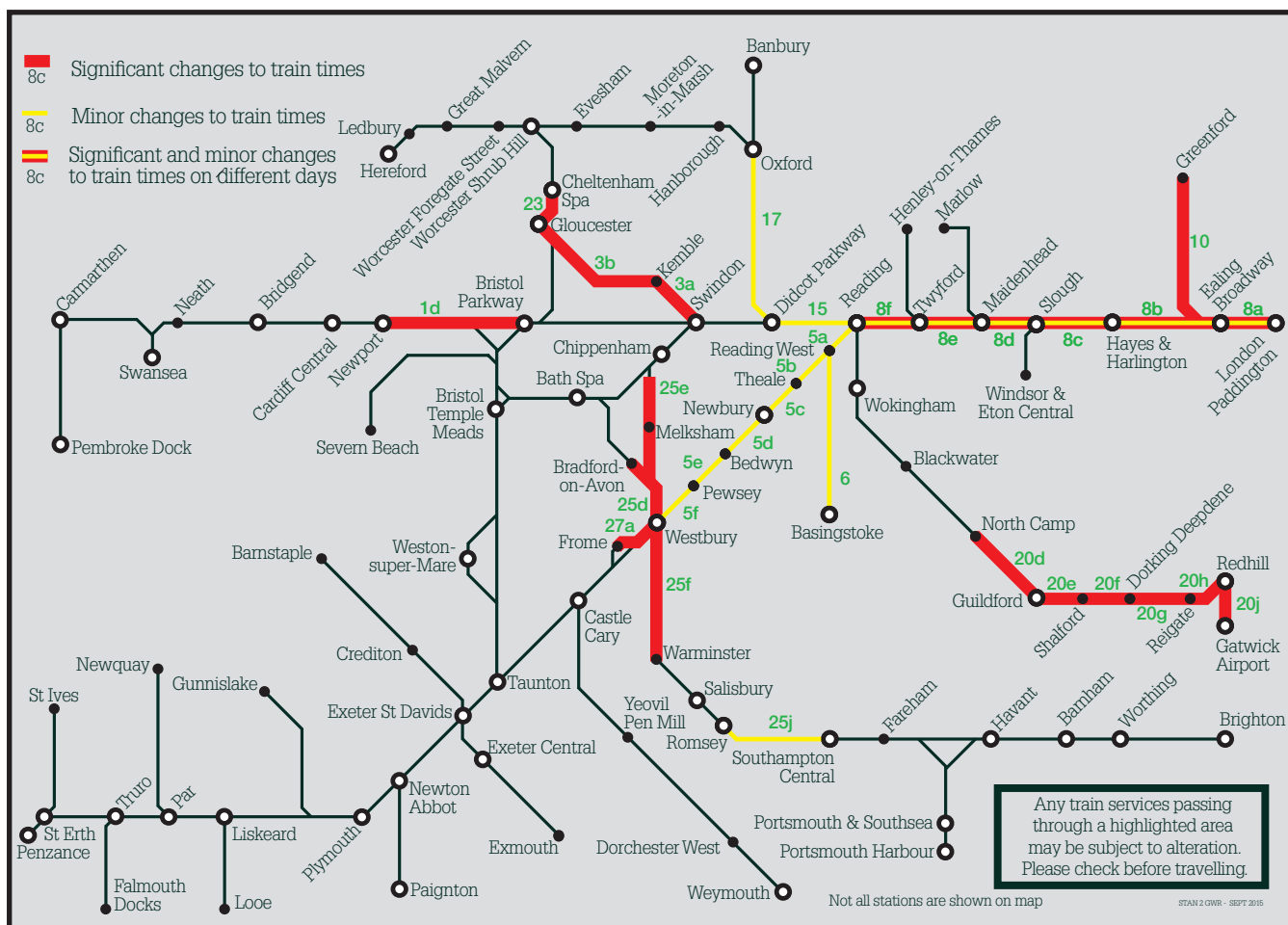


Summary of timetable changes

Area	DETAILS
1d ●	Saturday, Sunday, Monday and Tuesday – Each day , buses will replace trains between Newport and Bristol Parkway.
3a, 3b, 23 ●	Saturday – All day , trains between London Paddington and Cheltenham Spa will start/terminate at Swindon. Saturday and Sunday – All weekend , trains between London Paddington and Newbury/Bedwyn with start/terminate at Reading.
5a – 5f ●	The 2145 Penzance to London Paddington and 2345 London Paddington to Penzance, The Night Riviera, services will not run on Sunday or Monday.
6 ●	Sunday – From the start of service until approximately 0815 , buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke.
8a – 8c ●	Saturday – The 2349 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington service will terminate at Slough. A replacement bus will run from Slough to London Paddington. Sunday – All day , trains will not run between London Paddington and Slough. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Ealing Broadway/Hillingdon, and Maidenhead/Marlow and High Wycombe. 8a – 8c ●	Sunday – All day , trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads/South Wales will start/terminate at Reading. An amended service will run on all routes. For more information visit GWR.com/Christmas2018
8a – 8f ●	Saturday, Monday and Tuesday – All day , a revised service will run between London Paddington and Reading/Didcot Parkway/Oxford.
8a – 8f, 15, 17 ●	Saturday – From approximately 2200 until the end of service , trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
8d ●	Saturday and Monday – All day , the West Ealing to Greenford Branch will not run.
10 ●	Sunday – From approximately 2300 until the end of service , trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.
15 ●	Saturday and Sunday – All weekend , buses will replace trains between North Camp and Redhill/Gatwick Airport. Rail services will run between Reading and Ash.
20d – 20h, 20j ●	Saturday, Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – All day , trains will not call at Westbury. Replacement buses will run between Westbury and Frome/Dilton Marsh/Chippenham, and Trowbridge and Warminster. Trains between London Paddington/Reading and the West of England will be diverted and not call at Westbury. On Sunday, these services will start/terminate at Reading. 25e ●	Monday and Tuesday – The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Westbury service will be diverted and not call at Eastleigh and Southampton Airport Parkway. It will depart Southampton Central EARLIER than usual and terminate at Warminster.
